As GMPGPod gears up for the 2025 season, expectations are tempered by a series of grim realities. Despite last year's near-top percentile finish and an impressive winning percentage that had fans hopeful, this year's outlook is decidedly bleaker. The team's quarterback situation is uninspiring at best, with Geno Smith struggling in the QB26 slot, offering little in terms of leadership or consistent performance. Rachaad White, a projected starter at RB43, only adds to the team's woes, casting doubt on their ability to sustain drives or find the end zone regularly. While the wide receiving corps, led by Justin Jefferson and Puka Nacua, remains a bright spot with a respectable division rank of 4, it is unlikely to compensate for the deficiencies elsewhere on the roster. Their draft strategy seemed promising, securing good value picks like Tony Pollard and Dalton Kincaid, but questionable decisions

such as reaching for Geno Smith and Austin Ekeler have left analysts scratching their heads. The Nevada Wolf Pack division appears unforgiving this year, and with GMPGPod languishing at a rank of 10, it's difficult to envision them climbing out of the lower percentile tier without some miraculous turnaround. Overall, the season looms dauntingly over a team once filled with promise, now teetering on the brink of irrelevance.
