Last year acandrews12 went 34-2 and finished in the 95th percentile, which is the kind of season that rewires a manager's self-image heading into a draft. The problem is that the 2026 roster doesn't look like a 95th-percentile team, and the projection sitting at the 15th percentile isn't a rounding error. The foundation is genuinely strong: Josh Allen at QB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give the lineup a real ceiling, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 alongside D'Andre Swift at RB24 means the backfield depth is legitimate. But the receiving corps trails off quickly, with Marvin Harrison Jr. projecting at WR33 and DK Metcalf at WR36 as projected starters, and Khalil Shakir, the weakest projected starter on the roster, sitting at WR51. The draft didn't help much either: reaching nearly three full rounds for Harrison and over four for Mike Washington Jr. at RB59 spent draft capital on outcomes that projections aren't currently rewarding. The reputation is last year's. The roster is this year's problem.

Last year MadJester finished in the 97th percentile, and that reputation is now doing a lot of heavy lifting. The 2026 roster projects 11th in the Wario division and in just the 18th percentile of the field, a collapse in standing that the draft did not do much to cushion. The receiver group is genuinely strong, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Drake London at WR7, and Rashee Rice at WR13, but in a positionless format your ceiling is only as high as your weakest projected starters, and the supporting cast thins out fast. Bucky Irving at RB21 arrived as a steal, taken more than two rounds past his ADP, but the depth behind him is thin enough to be alarming. Meanwhile, the quarterback situation looks like someone drafted a committee and called it a plan, with Kyler Murray at QB19 leading a group where the next option is Cam Ward at QB23. This team won 78 percent of its games a year ago. It is going to spend 2026 explaining that to people who have already stopped listening.

Last year, barrettjm1 went 31-5 and finished in the 94th percentile, the kind of season that buys goodwill and raises expectations simultaneously. The 2026 roster is here to collect on neither. The tight end group is genuinely elite, with Brock Bowers at TE1, Colston Loveland at TE3, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 all projected to start, and that depth is real. But the rest of the roster reads like a different team entirely, one that never won 86 percent of its games. The quarterback situation tops out at Jared Goff, a QB16, and the running back group is anchored by Jonathon Brooks at RB37 and Chris Rodriguez at RB48, with the weakest projected starter being Josh Downs at WR46. A 30th percentile projection and a 10th-place division rank tell the same story the player rankings do. The gap between what barrettjm1 was in 2025 and what the projections say this roster is in 2026 is not a slump. It looks, at least on paper, like a different team wearing a championship's reputation.

thatmattkelley sits ninth in the Wario division and at the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The quarterback room is the clearest drag: Brock Purdy checks in at QB13 and C.J. Stroud at QB22, which means the projected floor on any given week is a guy who is barely a starter-caliber signal-caller in this format. The Purdy/George Kittle stack is a genuine bright spot, and Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is the kind of top-end anchor most managers would take, but the drop-off from those two pillars is steep and comes quickly. Quinshon Judkins, snagged two-plus rounds past his ADP, projects as RB22 and is reportedly on track to return healthy for Cleveland's training camp after a late-season fractured fibula, which makes him a reasonable lottery ticket, not a safety net. Six minor reaches and a major one in Michael Mayer suggest a draft that kept pressing for answers that

never fully arrived. This roster has ceiling, it just does not have the depth to survive the variance of a long tournament run.

andysalads enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Wario division and in just the 36th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The headline move was taking Dak Prescott at 1.12, a full round and a half before his ADP, burning a first-round pick on a QB7 projection when that slot could have landed a difference-maker. Prescott lands behind projected starter Drake Maye anyway, making the early spend feel even more punishing in hindsight. Justin Jefferson is a genuine bright spot at WR6, but the rest of the projected starters grade out in the middling range, and the roster as a whole projects as average at best. Last year's 9-27 record and a finish in the bottom tenth of the field in scoring is not ancient history, it is a recent data point about how this roster performs under pressure. With three major reaches already baked into the draft and no obvious high-upside asset left to leverage, andysalads looks less like a team ready to climb and more like one hoping the projections are wrong.

IAMFFLegend is a team that will win or lose on the thinnest of margins, and the margins are where this roster actually gets interesting. The foundation is legitimate: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 give this team a ceiling that most managers in the Wario division cannot match, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 arriving a round late in the draft means the depth behind Taylor is real. The receiver group is functional without being dangerous, anchored by Malik Nabers at WR12 and buttressed by a Jaxson Dart stack that could spike a week if the Dart-Nabers connection clicks. The wild card is Bhayshul Tuten. With Travis Etienne gone to New Orleans and Jacksonville's backfield genuinely open, Tuten's athletic profile stops being a projection and starts being a legitimate argument for starter-level production. At RB25, he is priced like a depth piece. If he earns a featured role, this roster climbs quietly out of 7th. If he doesn't, IAMFFLegend finishes exactly where it looks right now: hovering around the 45th percentile, close to everything and decisive about nothing.

4thnfantasy-Rocco! sits at the tournament's exact midpoint, 49th percentile, which is either a launching pad or a ceiling depending on how a handful of close calls break. The roster has genuine upside at the top: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Jeremiyah Love as RB13, and Kyren Williams as RB15, a starting core that can hang with anyone in the Wario division. The problem is that the margins Rocco needs to win are precisely where the draft got sloppy. Tony Pollard was taken nearly two rounds early and projects only RB30, and Travis Etienne, reached on slightly, sits at RB18, meaning two roster spots carry real opportunity cost. Jordan Love is the clearest draft win, a QB17 who fell to pick 10.07, and he gives Rocco a viable pivot if Justin Herbert struggles. Coming off a 79th-percentile scoring season in 2025, the talent base is real. But this is a team built on thin margins, and thin margins cut both ways.

Clif13 didn't just draft a stack, he drafted a philosophy. Joe Burrow at QB4 and Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 are the engine of this entire roster, and when those two are humming, clif13's ceiling climbs into a tier most managers in the Wario Division can only watch from below. The draft backed the philosophy up, too: Burrow fell nearly a full round past his ADP, meaning clif13 got the cornerstone of his correlation play at a discount. Chase cost him a first-round pick at fair market value, but pairing a QB4 with a WR2 who literally plays for that QB is not a luxury, it's a multiplier. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 adds a second credible receiver stack candidate should clif13 want to layer correlations further, and Tyler Warren at TE4 gives the lineup a weekly anchor regardless of what else is happening. Sitting at 66th percentile in the field, this team is one big Burrow-Chase week away from looking like a genius operation, and the roster is built specifically to manufacture that outcome.

thedraftgenius lands in the 66th percentile of the field, and the draft itself explains why. There was no lottery-ticket swing, no moment where the room went quiet and everyone wondered what just happened. Instead, this is a roster built on accumulation, the kind where you look up after eighteen rounds and realize the floor never dipped. The centerpiece is Bijan Robinson at RB2, a top-two running back who anchors everything. Around him, thedraftgenius constructed a starting corps that includes A.J. Brown at WR8, Jameson Williams at WR21, Luther Burden at WR22, and D.J. Moore at WR26, four projected starters who were all drafted within a reasonable band of their value. Trevor Lawrence, the clearest bargain on the board, fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP and landed at pick 7.07 despite projecting as the QB10. That single find did not transform the roster, but it reinforced the pattern: consistent, forward-leaning decisions that compounded into a lineup that is quietly difficult to beat. After a 98th-percentile scoring season in 2025, the expectation is more of the same.

Puka Troopa didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it pick by pick, round by round, and the cumulative effect is a roster that lands at the 75th percentile of the field. The receiving corps is where the quiet dominance shows most clearly: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Chris Olave as WR11, and Garrett Wilson as WR17, all projected starters, all drafted before this group started looking like anything special. Olave was the one moment where the manager blinked and reached a full round early, but when the return is a WR11, that's a reach worth defending. Then came the values. De'Von Achane slipped nearly a full round past his ADP and Puka Troopa was there to collect him at RB6. Matthew Stafford fell a round and change, and he lands in a two-quarterback stack with Nacua that adds a real floor to both investments. Third in the Wario Division is where the projections have this team, but nothing about this roster suggests it has to stay there.

Will See Happiness landed at 83rd percentile in this field and second in the Wario division, and the draft log makes that achievement feel almost accidental, except it really does not. This roster was built on conviction disguised as recklessness. Keon Coleman was taken nearly five full rounds before his ADP, Stefon Diggs almost four rounds early, and yet the manager still walked away with Caleb Williams at QB6 more than a round after Williams should have been gone, and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 nearly a round and a half after that. The reaches did not blow up the draft because the values were real, not cosmetic. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Saquon Barkley as RB8, and Nico Collins as WR9, a top tier that would make any manager in this tournament comfortable. The honest question is whether Coleman and Diggs justify the early capital spent on them, or whether this team is quietly carrying dead weight in the back half of the roster while the stars up front make it look fine either way.

RunDFF didn't stumble into the 87th percentile. This roster was constructed with the kind of deliberate patience that separates students of the draft from everyone else guessing at a keyboard. The centerpiece is James Cook, a projected RB5 who anchors the backfield, but the true craftsmanship shows in how the supporting cast was assembled around him. Chase Brown lands as a projected RB11 and a locked-in starter, taken a full two rounds after his ADP, and Bo Nix arrives as a projected QB15 grabbed more than two rounds late. When a manager collects that caliber of production at that kind of discount, the math starts working in their favor before a single game is played. Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Trey McBride at TE2 give this team genuine elite-tier anchors, and the draft sheet as a whole shows two steals, three values, and zero major reaches. Division-leading in Wario and already top 15 percent of the field, RunDFF didn't find value on the margins. They built the whole roster out of it.
