As TheRevengeOfDopey heads into the 2025 season, there's little cause for optimism. Coming off a subpar 2024 campaign where they languished in the 21st percentile and managed to win just 28% of their games, the outlook remains bleak. Despite having a solid receiver lineup with Justin Jefferson, Tyreek Hill, and DK Metcalf, their overall team strength is undermined by glaring weaknesses elsewhere, particularly at tight end where Dallas Goedert, sitting at TE16, could be a major liability. This deficiency leaves them vulnerable in crucial matchups. While they snagged some players like Jared Goff and Trey Benson below their average draft positions, these minor victories might not be enough to bolster a squad that reached too early for players like Josh Jacobs. The team's current standing in both the division and tournament is disappointing, with little evidence

suggesting a turnaround. Even with a small stack bonus from pairing Justin Jefferson with J.J. McCarthy, it's hard to see how they'll climb out of the lower ranks without significant improvement across the board. As it stands, TheRevengeOfDopey seems bound for another lackluster season.
