There is no charitable read available for WillieBeaaaaman, who sits 12th in the Contra division and in the bottom 10 percent of the field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. The reach count is brutal: zero steals, zero values, and six players taken before their ADP, including three major ones. Josh Jacobs at RB16 got grabbed nearly two rounds early, which is defensible if you love the player, but Bhayshul Tuten at RB25 went 2.6 rounds ahead of schedule, and Emanuel Wilson, a projected RB69, was somehow worth a 17th-round pick in this manager's head when the rest of the field wasn't touching him until round 24. The net effect is a roster that paid premium prices for middling production and left the late rounds with nothing to show for the overspending. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Joe Burrow at QB4 are genuine assets, but even Dallas Goedert's quietly dependable production, including a four-touchdown stretch that saved fantasy rosters down the stretch last year, cannot paper over the damage done by a draft that gave away round equity at every turn.

There is no version of this draft that ages well. m8b91989 burned a second-round pick on Jaxson Dart, a QB11 taken 2.6 rounds ahead of his ADP, while Patrick Mahomes, a QB12, was still sitting on the board and eventually fell a full round past his ADP before someone else grabbed him. That sequencing alone tells you everything about the decision-making process here. The reaches did not stop at quarterback: Trey Benson, projected RB64, was claimed 4.3 rounds early, and Ty Simpson, a QB36, went in round 14 despite an ADP that said round 19. Five major reaches across a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and the philosophy is costing this team. Christian McCaffrey and Nico Collins give the roster a legitimate foundation, but the back end is a monument to impatience. m8b91989 sits 11th in the Contra division and in the 11th percentile of the field, which is precisely the kind of outcome you earn when you spend your ammunition chasing names instead of value.

tekn0w drafted with discipline. Eleven chalk picks, patient hands at the table, and a philosophy of letting value come to the manager rather than chasing it. Tyler Shough fell more than three rounds past his ADP and landed in the sixteenth round for free. Brock Purdy arrived as a projected QB13 starter at a similar discount, and the stacks with Mike Evans and George Kittle give the roster a legitimate multiplier effect when San Francisco has a good week. The problem is that discipline and value are not the same thing as upside, and this roster is living proof of the gap. The projected starters are fine: Drake Maye is QB2, A.J. Brown is WR8, Derrick Henry is RB12. Fine. And yet the team sits at 13th percentile in the field, tenth in the Contra division, with Jadarian Price projected as the weakest starter. tekn0w did almost everything right on draft day and still ended up here, which is not a strategy failure so much as it is a reminder that the draft is only the beginning of the argument.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes from drafting hard and still landing near the bottom, and Knicks in 5 knows it well. The team sits ninth in the Contra division and in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the draft board does not offer much comfort: four major reaches against zero steals is a ledger that trends one direction. The most damaging line item is Deebo Samuel, taken nearly six rounds before his WR70 projection warranted it, a price that could have bought something useful elsewhere. Matthew Stafford at QB14 cost a second-round pick, stacking neatly with projected starter Puka Nacua at WR1 and Davante Adams at WR25, which is a real foundation, but foundations do not win leagues by themselves. The supporting cast thins out quickly, with Jacory Croskey-Merritt projecting as the weakest projected starter at RB40 and T.J. Hockenson sitting at TE23. There is no obvious move left to make, no hidden asset waiting to flip. Knicks in 5 drafted, landed here, and now has to play the hand.

Toejam and Scorers enter 2026 sitting eighth in the Contra division, and the roster grades out right around the tournament median in a way that should concern anyone rostering this team. The foundation looks appealing on paper: Jayden Daniels at QB5, Trey McBride at TE2, and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give the lineup genuine upside at the top. The problem is that the supporting cast thins out quickly, and the draft process did not help matters. The team burned a second-round pick on Daniels nearly a full round before his ADP warranted it, and RJ Harvey, projected as the weakest starter at RB28, cost a second-major reach at pick 8.02 despite an ADP closer to the tenth round. Meanwhile, Trevor Lawrence's context is genuinely murky: his career year came with the Jaguars' skill-position hierarchy scrambled in ways that make a repeat difficult to price in. Three values and zero steals across the draft is a floor you can survive, but paired with two major reaches and a thin wide receiver group headlined by Chris Olave at WR11, there is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Cavo sits at 56th percentile in the field, which is exactly as comfortable and as precarious as it sounds. The ceiling here is real: Lamar Jackson at QB3 paired with a Jared Goff stack through Amon-Ra St. Brown and Jameson Williams gives this roster genuine upside on the right week, and St. Brown at WR4 is the kind of anchor most managers would build around without hesitation. The floor, though, has its own opinions. Thirteen chalk picks out of a seventeen-round draft means cavo paid market rate for almost everything, leaving almost no margin for error when projections miss. The one significant draft gamble, Keenan Allen taken 6.4 rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting out at WR99, is the kind of reach that only looks smart if everything else goes right first. This is a roster that finishes where it starts, somewhere in the middle of the Contra division, not threatening the top, not gifting wins to anyone either. The margins will decide it, and right now those margins are razor thin.

RoxieShepherd finished 85th percentile in scoring last year and the 2026 draft suggests that floor was no accident. The clearest illustration of the methodology: five players came in as good values against ADP, including Justin Herbert at QB8, taken a full round and change after his market price. Herbert carries real uncertainty, the Chargers' ball-control identity under Jim Harbaugh has already trimmed his attempts, and new coordinator Mike McDaniels makes him more interesting without fully unlocking the ceiling, but landing a QB8 projection at a late fourth-round pick is exactly the kind of quiet win that accumulates into a good roster. The same logic applies at tight end, where Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tyler Warren at TE4 anchor a group that would be the envy of most managers in the Contra division. The one blemish is Bucky Irving, reached 2.2 rounds early at RB21, which is a real overpay. But one reach does not define a draft built on consistent, unflashy execution, and at 57th percentile projected, this team is right on the bubble of something better.

ScottyDubs didn't build this roster on a single blockbuster moment. They built it pick by pick, quietly coming out ahead at nearly every turn. The clearest example is the wide receiver group, where CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Justin Jefferson (WR6), and Rashee Rice (WR13) give this team a ceiling most managers in the field would envy, and Ladd McConkey (WR20) arrived a full round and a half after his ADP suggested he would, meaning ScottyDubs got that production at a genuine discount. Tucker Kraft (TE5) fell a full round past his price tag too, quietly strengthening a position that separates contenders from pretenders in deep formats. The floor concerns are real, Malik Willis (QB24) and Bryce Young (QB26) project as fringe starters at best, and the projected starter list bottoms out at Jayden Reed (WR48), but a 63rd-percentile tournament standing and a roster dripping with upside suggests this team earns its cautious optimism. Fifth in Contra right now feels like a placeholder.

There is not a lot of mystery to what jkaplanwinning is doing in 2026, and that is exactly the point. The foundation is Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5, a pair of projected starters that would anchor most contenders in this field, and the draft discipline to build around them without bleeding value. The front office did not stop there. C.J. Stroud fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP before jkaplanwinning grabbed him at 12.07, a steal that quietly upgrades the quarterback room alongside Bo Nix at QB15. Zay Flowers slipping a full round to land at WR16 is the kind of quiet win that separates careful drafters from lucky ones. Thirteen chalk picks tell you this manager was not gambling, and the steal-to-reach ratio confirms it: one steal, one minor reach, and a roster that projects near the 72nd percentile of the field. Chase Brown at RB11 provides the kind of depth that turns an injury into a speed bump rather than a season. jkaplanwinning drafted with intent and landed the talent to back it up.

SoldierSieg13 finished 2025 in the 26th percentile and came back to the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with something to prove, apparently including the willingness to ignore consensus boards entirely. The reaches tell the real story: Jaydon Blue pulled in at pick 17.03 with an ADP sitting nearly seven and a half rounds later, and Mike Washington Jr. came off the board almost three full rounds ahead of schedule. By conventional draft-room logic, those are the kinds of moves that haunt you. Instead, the rest of the roster rewrote the narrative. Drake London landed at WR7, Malik Nabers at WR12, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Brock Bowers at TE1, all projected starters, all contributing to a team that sits at the 75th tournament percentile and third in the division. The conviction required to burn late picks chasing upside at running back only lands this well if the earlier selections hold up, and this group of projected starters suggests they will. Whether SoldierSieg13 was right for the right reasons is an open question. The roster, for now, does not particularly care.

WLombardi1 sits second in the Contra division and in the 87th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headliner is Jonathan Taylor, a steal at RB4 taken nearly a full round after his ADP, paired with De'Von Achane at RB6, another value pick. That is not luck, that is patience at the board, and it gives this team a floor that most managers would trade their whole bench to have. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the receiving corps, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 came a round late as well. Three steals, two values, and only one major reach in sixteen rounds is about as clean a draft audit as you will find in this tournament. That reach, Darnell Mooney at WR82, is the one wrinkle, pulled more than five rounds early. Jordan Love is the other footnote, a QB17 who wins real games but has never cracked 35 passing touchdowns in a season and has finished outside the fantasy top ten two years running. Neither flaw is fatal to a roster built this well everywhere else.

Aanianofantasy enters 2026 looking less like a tournament entry and more like a masterclass in draft discipline, and the numbers back that up completely. The foundation is built on Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Saquon Barkley at RB8, three projected starters who give this roster a ceiling most managers in the field simply cannot match. But what separates a good draft from a great one is what happens in the middle and late rounds, and that is where Aanianofantasy made its money. Harold Fannin fell more than two rounds past his ADP and landed here as a TE6 projected starter, a steal of the quiet variety that quietly warps the entire roster's floor upward. Jalen Hurts, taken nearly a round and a half after his ADP, adds QB9 production at a discount that borders on embarrassing for the managers who passed. One major reach in Tyler Allgeier is the lone blemish on an otherwise surgical sheet, and with a division rank of first and a 92nd-percentile tournament standing, even that caveat barely registers.
