As the 2025 season looms, ThatUKGatorGuy faces a dismal outlook in both their division and broader competition. With a ranking dead last in their division and languishing amongst the bottom percentile overall, the team grapples with glaring weaknesses that could undermine their season. The quarterback position, headlined by Cam Ward (QB23) and Sam Darnold (QB28), lacks the firepower necessary to lead this team to success. While the wide receiver corps boasts depth and potential game-changers like Nico Collins (WR7) and Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR13), even the strongest unit can't carry an entire team. The running back situation is troubling, with Ashton Jeanty offering some hope, but J.K. Dobbins is a projected starter at RB39, which could be a recipe for disaster. Despite the initial excitement of securing Dobbins after his average draft position, the value is overshadowed by questionable draft choices elsewhere, such as overreaching on Sam Darnold, Jalen

Royals, and Harold Fannin. This pattern of drafting could hinder their ability to compete effectively. Without significant improvements, ThatUKGatorGuy seems poised for a rocky season at best.

Drafting Austin Ekeler later than expected was perhaps the team's sole stroke of genius, a rare oasis in a desert of questionable

decisions like reaching for Rashid Shaheed and the illusionary value of Tyler Shough. But hey, at least they're consistent—consistently reaching for mediocrity across the board.

The draft strategy was a mixed bag, securing excellent value on some picks while

reaching too early on others, leaving the team to navigate an uphill battle to improve their standing. As the season unfolds, all eyes will be on how these calculated risks play out on the field, with hopes of surpassing last year's meager win percentage and elevating their stature among the competition.
