advantage with A.J. Brown and Jalen Hurts, the path forward seems fraught with challenges, leaving rmcclroy staring down a long season of potential struggle and disappointment.

draft position. Meanwhile, veterans like Davante Adams and D.J. Moore will need to deliver consistently, while players like Jaylen Waddle and George Pickens must step up as reliable options. The team's fate may ultimately hinge on the careful balancing act between overcoming positional weaknesses and capitalizing on their quarterback strength, with the goal of edging past their middling standings.
