As mphelps2 gears up for the 2025 season, there's a palpable air of resignation among the team and its beleaguered fans. Coming off a dismal 2024 campaign, where they found themselves languishing in the 10th percentile for scoring efficiency and managing to scrape together victories in just 28% of their games, hopes for a miraculous turnaround seem misguided at best. With a ranking of 12 in the New York Red Bulls division and sitting uncomfortably in the 3rd percentile overall, the prospects are bleak. The roster's vulnerabilities are glaring, not least with Jaydon Blue poised as a starting RB42, a position that underscores the team's precarious lack of depth. Their wide receiver corps, featuring Malik Nabers WR4, Chris Godwin WR33, and Khalil Shakir WR40, offers a glimmer of optimism, yet it feels insufficient to change their fortunes. Despite securing some late-round value picks like Rachaad White and Kareem Hunt, baffling draft decisions—like reaching significantly on

players such as Geno Smith and Kendre Miller—have left the team mired in a quagmire of missed opportunities. As the season looms, mphelps2 seems destined for another year of languishing at the bottom, their aspirations overshadowed by the weight of last year's failures and questionable drafting choices.

The draft strategy further compounded these issues, as ill-timed reaches on Jerome Ford and Rashid Shaheed severely undermined their value propositions. While Jalen McMillan and Isaiah Likely could offer some hope as late-round steals, the overall outlook remains bleak. Misguided draft decisions and an unbalanced roster threaten to consign "Chasing

Points" to a season of struggles and unmet expectations as they navigate both divisional challenges and broader competition.
