Cubbybear214 finished 35th percentile in scoring last year and responded by drafting like someone who needed to prove something. The evidence is damning: three major reaches on the first nine picks alone, starting with Ashton Jeanty at 1.09 when the board would have delivered him a full round later, then Malik Nabers at 2.04 despite an ADP sitting closer to the fourth round, and then, as if those two weren't enough, T.J. Hockenson at 9.09 for a player projected as TE23, a reach of 2.4 rounds on a streamer-tier tight end. That's the draft in miniature: premium picks burned early to land players who either would have been there anyway or weren't worth the slot regardless. The one genuine steal, Jadarian Price falling two rounds past his ADP, barely registers against that backdrop. Sitting dead last in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division with a 1st percentile tournament projection, Cubbybear214 didn't just have a bad draft, they had to work at it.

There is a specific kind of fantasy fatigue that sets in when you look at a roster and realize the ceiling and the floor are basically the same room. scofeelinit sits 11th in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and projects in just the 17th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to change the math, producing zero steals and zero values against nine chalk picks and three reaches. The one real bright spot is the Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb stack, a legitimate WR5 anchoring a receiving corps that looks fine on the surface until you notice Quentin Johnston, a WR41, is the projected weakest starter. The A.J. Brown situation carries intrigue, a WR8 projection powered by a new chapter in New England alongside Drake Maye, but Brown has missed time in five of seven seasons and betting on his availability is not a strategy so much as a prayer. The bones of this roster are not bad enough to be interesting and not good enough to be dangerous, which is somehow the worst place to be.

RodGod21 finished last year at the 5th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 outlook offers little reason to exhale. Sitting 10th in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and projected in just the 27th percentile of the field, this roster looks like a team running out of runway. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and James Cook at RB5 give the lineup genuine upside at the top, but outside that tandem the picture dims fast, and a draft that produced zero steals and went chalk on 10 of 12 picks was never going to paper over the gaps. The Herbert/McConkey stack adds a small bonus, but Justin Herbert projects as only QB8, and Ladd McConkey grades out at WR20, so the stack multiplies modest rather than elite production. The most alarming single decision was spending a pick on Bryce Young at QB26, taken more than two rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of reach that poisons a roster when every selection needs to count. RodGod21 needed a draft that swung for the fences. This one barely left the dugout.

JGallina drafted four major reaches across the board, and the results speak for themselves: a 28th-percentile roster sitting ninth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division before a single game is played. The most damaging of those decisions was Jacory Croskey-Merritt, taken 4.1 rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as an RB40, a rank that makes him the weakest projected starter on this roster by a considerable margin. Sam LaPorta, pulled 1.3 rounds early, projects at TE8, meaning JGallina paid a premium for a player who is fine but not extraordinary. Wan'Dale Robinson, another major reach at 3.3 rounds early, checks in at WR47. The Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack is genuinely good, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 gives this team a real foundation. But a draft that produced zero steals and four major reaches does not get graded on a curve because two players came out well. Last year's 44 percent win rate suggested a manager capable of improvement. This draft suggests something else entirely.

BKav415 finished in the 79th percentile last season and sits at the 53rd this year, which tells you everything about where this team lives: solidly functional, quietly at risk. The ceiling is real. Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Drake London slots in at WR7, and Rashee Rice at WR13 gives this roster a top tier that can carry a week on its own. London even came as a mild value, slipping to 2.11 against an ADP of 2.06, the kind of small edge that matters when everything else is even. But margins cut both ways. Trevor Lawrence projects at QB10 and Brock Purdy at QB13, which is fine without being great, and Tony Pollard at RB30 is the projected starter most likely to cost BKav415 a close matchup. The draft was almost entirely chalk, nine of eleven picks landing right where the board said they would, so there is no hidden upside baked in. Division rank of eighth is the honest summary: not a pushover, not a threat, just a team where the good weeks and the bad weeks look almost identical until suddenly they do not.

Nova516 sits at the 61st percentile and seventh in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division, which tells you everything: this is a team that has real weapons but no margin for slippage. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 are legitimate difference-makers, and Tyler Warren at TE4 is the kind of positional advantage that quietly tilts close matchups. The problem is that close matchups are exactly what Nova516 will be living in all season, which means Bo Nix matters more than managers would like. Nix has delivered top-10 fantasy production in both years in the league, and with Jaylen Waddle now added to Denver's offense alongside Courtland Sutton, there is a credible path to him lifting his ceiling beyond the back end of the top 10. But a credible path is not a guarantee. The roster was drafted almost entirely at chalk, with nine of twelve picks landing right at ADP, so there is little hidden upside baked in. Gibbs and Achane can carry weeks, but this team wins or loses on whether Nix takes a step forward.

brophizzle did not win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by accumulating small edges across the board, and that quiet consistency is exactly why this roster belongs in the conversation. The clearest example is Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection taken nearly a full round after his average draft position. Pair that with Brock Bowers at TE1, and brophizzle is running two genuinely elite players at positions where the gap between the top and the middle of the field is enormous. Kenneth Walker III slipping a full round past his ADP added a projected RB10 at a discount, and Dalton Kincaid landing nearly two rounds late gave the roster a capable TE11 without sacrificing value elsewhere. The one minor blemish is Josh Downs, taken almost two rounds early, but one reach across an entire draft is a rounding error. Sitting 61st percentile in the tournament field with a starting lineup that includes Lamar Jackson alongside Daniels and Bowers, brophizzle looks like a team that did the boring, disciplined work that actually wins leagues.

There was no single splashy move that defines rnc62's 2026 roster, just round after round of quiet competence that added up to something worth watching. The foundation is legitimate: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 are the kind of projected starters who show up in winning lineups all season, and the Jalen Hurts / DeVonta Smith stack gives rnc62 a built-in multiplier whenever Hurts has a big game. What separates a good draft from a great one, though, is what happens in the later rounds, and that's where rnc62 pulled ahead. Alec Pierce fell more than two rounds past his ADP before rnc62 took him at WR32, and Jake Ferguson came off the board nearly two rounds late at TE12. Neither move looks like a gamble, just a manager paying attention while others weren't. Coming off a 2025 season that landed in the 95th percentile in scoring, rnc62 enters the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division at 68th percentile overall looking like a team that built the right way.

Kravit didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't chase upside at the expense of the present, just drafted a roster that kept winning the individual exchanges. The clearest evidence is Trey McBride, a TE2 projection taken at 2.02 when his ADP sat nearly half a round later, a quiet piece of timing that compounds across a season. Omarion Hampton, projected RB9, similarly fell past his number and landed in Kravit's lap at 3.11. Those aren't flashy moves, they're the draft equivalent of getting your change back and pocketing it every single time. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 anchors the skill group, and a backfield featuring Chase Brown at RB11 and Josh Jacobs at RB16 alongside Hampton gives this roster genuine redundancy at the positions that decide weeks. The 2025 campaign was a rough one, 31st percentile in scoring, but the construction here is measurably sharper. Sitting fourth in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and at the 73rd percentile tournament-wide, Kravit looks like a team that did the boring work correctly and is now positioned to collect.

Last year was ugly. RoyalMike24 finished in the 16th percentile in scoring, a number that is less a disappointment and more a formal complaint filed with the universe. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the kind of anchor that makes a rebuild feel less like hope and more like a plan, and Nico Collins at WR9 and George Pickens at WR10 give this lineup a top-end that most managers in the field would envy. Breece Hall at RB14 slots in as a reliable piece behind that group, and Terry McLaurin, quietly snagged a full round past his ADP, is exactly the kind of late-draft value that separates careful builders from lucky ones. The quarterback situation is thin by the numbers, but in a positionless format, a deep, high-quality group of projected starters can carry a team past that kind of disadvantage. RoyalMike24 currently sits third in the division and at the 74th percentile overall. The floor here is dramatically higher than last year. The rebound is already underway.

liljoep lands at second in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and the 75th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains why: ten chalk picks, one good value, and almost nothing to apologize for. That kind of consistency is harder to pull off than it looks. The foundation is Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Colston Loveland at TE3, two projected top-tier players who anchor the lineup before liljoep even gets to the supporting cast. Then there is Jaylen Waddle, projected WR23, who quietly upgrades his situation considerably, moving out of a dysfunctional Miami passing game and into Denver, where Bo Nix threw the ball more than anyone in the league last year and Waddle joins a suddenly credible receiver room. Caleb Williams stacks with Loveland for a bonus that adds connective tissue to the whole thing. The one blemish is Tua Tagovailoa, a reach of 2.2 rounds at QB31, but in a positionless format where Williams projects at QB6, that cost is manageable. This roster did not get lucky. It just kept making reasonable decisions.

CosyMink sits first in the Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles division and in the 87th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. There are no reaches anywhere on this roster, five players taken at genuine value, and the whole thing reads like a clinic in letting the board come to you. Josh Allen at QB1 is the kind of anchor that makes every downstream decision easier, and Drake Maye landing at QB2 is the cherry on top, a player who finished second in MVP voting last season and who now gets Zay Flowers adds AJ Brown to his arsenal in New England, giving him an alpha wideout for the first time. Maye himself came at a discount, slipping past his ADP, as did Flowers at WR16 and Oronde Gadsden at TE16. When your value picks are projected starters rather than handcuff stashes, that is not luck, that is discipline. The weakest projected starter here is Jaylen Warren at RB27, which tells you everything about how the top of this roster is constructed. CosyMink did not just draft well. CosyMink drafted clean.
