There is no polite way to frame a 6th-percentile projection, so Kfloyd108, let's not try. The roster's ceiling rests almost entirely on Amon-Ra St. Brown, a WR4 who somehow slipped to pick 2.05 when his ADP was 1.10, and that lucky grab deserves real credit. But one good value in a draft defined by 14 chalk picks and three major reaches is not a foundation, it's a life raft. The reaches tell the ugliest story: Jayden Daniels cost a first-round pick at the 1.08 slot despite an ADP of 2.12, and Patrick Mahomes came off the board at 3.08, a full two rounds ahead of his market. Those are expensive bets on quarterbacks in a positionless format where quarterback premium is genuinely hard to justify. The 2025 campaign already posted an 11-25 record and 31st-percentile scoring, and nothing in this draft suggests the trajectory bends upward. Kfloyd108 is last in the Ninja Gaiden division and projecting into the bottom of the field, with no obvious lever left to pull.

There is no polite way to dress this up: jazzlynn626 sits 11th in the Ninja Gaiden division and projects in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the draft did not create many escape hatches. The one genuine bright spot is the receiver group, where CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Nico Collins (WR9) give the team a legitimate top-end foundation, and both arrived at reasonable cost relative to their ADP. But below that the picture dims quickly. The backfield starters grade out as a collective RB18-through-RB42 blur, and Blake Corum (RB35), projected as the weakest starter on the roster, was taken more than four rounds ahead of where the market had him, which means jazzlynn626 paid premium capital for a player who may not even be worth roster space on stronger teams. The draft leaned chalk in the middle rounds and reached more often than it found value. At this point the team is not waiting for one injury or one breakout to change the calculus. It is waiting for several, and hoping they all break the right way.

Ghost of the Uchiha is sitting tenth in the Ninja Gaiden division and in just the 18th percentile of the field, and the roster offers little reason to expect a climb. The foundation is genuinely impressive, Christian McCaffrey, James Cook, Chase Brown, Kyren Williams, and Cam Skattebo projecting as starters alongside a Harold Fannin at TE6, but every other layer of this roster collapses fast. The receiver group tops out at Romeo Doubs at WR53 and Tyreek Hill at WR77, and in a positionless format those are the players filling out the starting lineup on weeks when someone needs a rest. Baker Mayfield at QB18 and Sam Darnold at QB21 were both reaches, and Mac Jones at QB39 was taken more than five full rounds ahead of his ADP, which is a costly way to add a QB39. The draft chart shows three major reaches and zero steals, meaning this team paid premium prices to land what it landed. The stars are real, but there is no depth behind them worth believing in, and the standings may reflect that all season.

OGJH enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Ninja Gaiden division and in just the 20th percentile of the field, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over a thin roster. The two clearest problems are at the top and bottom of the depth chart. Trevor Lawrence, a QB10 projection, cost a second-round pick, a full two rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of draft-capital misfire that echoes through every subsequent round. Meanwhile, the projected final starter is KC Concepcion at WR50, which tells you everything about how the back end of this roster grades out. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is genuinely excellent and Rashee Rice at WR13 gives the team a second credible weapon, but two good players cannot carry a lineup when the supporting cast bottoms out at WR50. Michael Pittman, now in Pittsburgh pairing with a 43-year-old Aaron Rodgers on an offense still searching for an identity, does not inspire confidence as a depth piece either. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

There is no kind way to frame where dajob2000 stands heading into 2026: sitting eighth in the Ninja Gaiden division and projecting out at just the 23rd percentile of the field, the roster has very little margin for error and very few levers left to pull. The draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over a thin projection, with two major reaches headlining a board that skewed toward paying early rather than finding late. Taking Omarion Hampton at RB9 nearly a full round before his ADP is defensible, but burning a 14th-round pick on Michael Penix Jr., a QB33, is the kind of move that haunts a roster when the counting stats come due. Drake Maye is a legitimate anchor at QB2, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 gives the team a real edge at that position, but the projected starters beyond those two, including RJ Harvey at RB28 as the weakest projected starter, suggest a ceiling that is frustratingly near. A 44 percent win rate in 2025 was a warning. This roster, as currently built, does not scream correction.

Tatted Up Fanatsy Guy finished 23-13 last year and scored in the 78th percentile, so the floor is established, but 2026 feels like a season where a few coin flips determine whether this team finishes in the money or just outside it. Josh Allen anchors everything as a QB1, and the receiver group has real upside with Malik Nabers (WR12) and Luther Burden (WR22) projecting as starters alongside him. The margins, though, come from the murky middle. Jordan Love is the classic good-NFL-quarterback-bad-fantasy problem, a QB17 projection who wins games in Green Bay without generating the volume that fantasy scoring demands, and whether a reported shift toward his arm changes that calculus is genuinely unknown. On the draft side, this roster was built almost entirely on chalk, with 16 of 20 picks landing right at consensus, plus a major reach on Christian Kirk, a WR100 taken nearly four

and a half rounds early. Seventh in the Ninja Gaiden division and sitting at the 46th percentile, Tatted Up Fanatsy Guy is not the room's ceiling and not its floor, which means every close week matters more than it probably should.

The Dark Dragon sits at 53rd percentile, which is another way of saying it beats slightly more than half the field while frightening none of it. That position feels earned rather than accidental. The receiver group is genuinely good, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), A.J. Brown (WR8), and George Pickens (WR10) forming a top-shelf core that gives this roster a real ceiling, and Zay Flowers (WR16) and Ladd McConkey (WR20) keep the depth honest. But the quarterback situation is where the margin evaporates. Cam Ward (QB23) leads a group where no one projects better than QB23, and in a positionless format where everyone is leaning on their best players, a weak signal-caller costs points every week in small, compounding ways. The draft tendencies reinforce the median story: 16 chalk picks, zero steals, one solid value in Rashid Shaheed (WR57) slipping a round and a half, and a two-round reach on Pat Freiermuth (TE30) as the most aggressive move made. This is a roster built carefully enough to stay relevant and not boldly enough to win it all.

Ryu Hayabusa sits at 70th percentile in the field and fifth in the Ninja Gaiden division, numbers that feel a little low the moment you actually look at the roster. The case for optimism starts at the top: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 are the kind of foundational pieces that make a lineup hard to beat on any given week, and Jameson Williams at WR21 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 give the manager genuine firepower behind them. The case for skepticism starts in the draft room, where Hayabusa posted two major reaches, pulling Emanuel Wilson a staggering 6.1 rounds ahead of consensus and Kimani Vidal nearly four rounds early. Neither player is a projected starter, which means those picks functioned as deep-roster convictions rather than lineup gambles, and the projected starters largely justified the approach. Kyle Pitts at TE7 and Dallas Goedert at TE15 anchor a position group that many managers neglect early. The board said Hayabusa was wrong repeatedly. The roster, sitting in the field's top third, has a reasonable argument back.

Kicker Fanatic built this roster the quiet way, round after round of sensible decisions that added up to something genuinely dangerous. The foundation is easy to see: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is a legitimate difference-maker, and Caleb Williams at QB6 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a projected starter tier that most managers in this field would trade for. But the draft story is really in the margins. Justin Herbert fell nearly a full round past his ADP before Kicker Fanatic scooped him up at QB8, and Davante Adams slid over a round to land at WR25, a value that looks even better when you consider how comfortably he projects into the starting lineup. The one name worth watching is Alec Pierce, a WR32 projection who brings genuine big-play upside but is currently on the PUP list after offseason ankle surgery. If Pierce clears by late August, this roster gets a meaningful boost. The 2025 squad finished at the 82nd percentile in scoring, and this version looks built to match that ceiling, if not exceed it.

Vlad-o-matic didn't need a lottery ticket to build a winner in the Ninja Gaiden division, just a draft that kept finding the right player at the right price. The cornerstone was Brock Bowers, a TE1 who slid nearly a full round past his ADP to pick 2.03, the kind of gift that quietly tilts a roster. Kenneth Walker III arrived in similar fashion, landing at 4.03 despite a TE3.05 market price, giving the team a RB10 at a discount that most managers left on the table. Layer in Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Trey McBride at TE2 as additional projected starters, and the picture becomes clear: this roster was built through consistent execution, not one flashy gamble. The draft sheet shows 14 chalk picks against zero major reaches, meaning Vlad-o-matic simply refused to panic or overpay. The result is a team that sits third in the division but projects into the 82nd percentile of the full field, a gap that says everything about who drafted with discipline and who did not.

JaEisenberg did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to scramble for scraps. Sitting at 87th percentile and second in the Ninja Gaiden division, this roster was built with the kind of quiet confidence that does not need to announce itself. The centerpiece is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a projected starter who gives this team a genuine week-winning weapon at the top of the lineup. But the draft craft is what separates this build from a lucky one: six values across the roster, headlined by Drake London falling nearly a full round past his ADP to land at WR7, and Malik Washington slipping over two rounds to fill out the depth. The Jared Goff and Sam LaPorta stack adds a structural bonus on top of already sound individual projections. Josh Downs is the one minor reach, and even that is a quibble, not a concern. JaEisenberg came in with a plan, executed it round by round, and leaves with a roster that is genuinely difficult to argue with.

The Loafmen are sitting at 96th percentile in the field and first in the Ninja Gaiden division, and when you look at the draft, the reasoning is obvious. Eight values across the board with zero reaches is not luck, it is discipline, and it compounds quickly when the players involved are Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Puka Nacua at WR1. Taylor slipped to pick 2.08 despite an ADP of 2.01, Nacua fell to 1.05 despite being the top receiver in the field, and both project as starters. That kind of quiet efficiency is what separates a good SFB draft from a great one. The Stafford-Nacua stack adds a layer of correlated upside that could turn a good week into a dominant one. Jalen Hurts grabbed at 4.08 despite a QB9 projection gives the lineup real scoring equity at the position. Even the weakest projected starter is Tony Pollard at RB30, which tells you everything about the talent floor here. This roster is clean, disciplined, and built to win.
