Despite boasting strong performances from wide receivers like Justin Jefferson and Nico Collins, the supporting cast lacks depth, notably with Brandon Aiyuk as a projected starter. Running backs TreVeyon Henderson and Cam Skattebo fall short of inspiring confidence, while the tight end duo of George Kittle and Jake Ferguson may not be enough to carry the team. Although the draft yielded some value picks like Brock Purdy, who was secured much later than his ADP, there were

also questionable decisions, such as reaching early for C.J. Stroud and Nico Collins. Overall, for MrAxe, the upcoming season appears to be an uphill battle against both the formidable competitors in their division and the broader field.

If the Sharks manage this balancing act, they could rise through the ranks; otherwise, they may find themselves treading water in a competitive playing field.
