Once soaring high at an enviable 87th percentile with a strong 75% win rate, the team now finds itself languishing in the bottom 9th percentile overall, a fall from grace that reflects its last-place standing in the North Carolina Tar Heels division. The once-dominant squad now struggles with glaring weaknesses, particularly at tight end, where Zach Ertz's TE20 ranking underscores a precarious situation. The wide receiver lineup is a mixed bag; while Puka Nacua's WR5 status offers a glimmer of hope, relying on Darnell Mooney as a starter with his WR51 ranking signals trouble ahead. Although sfly managed to snag Mason Taylor at a notable value pick, other drafting decisions, such as reaching for Jalen Hurts and D'Andre Swift earlier than projected,

reveal cracks in their strategic foundation. Fans are left hoping for resilience and a spark of the past year's magic as the team embarks on what promises to be an uphill battle.

All this combines to leave bwood33 situated firmly in the 24th percentile overall, a true testament to their commitment to defying expectations by not surpassing them.
