As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, Team Vtroha faces a daunting uphill battle. Stuck at the bottom of the divisional ranks and languishing in the lowest percentile overall, prospects appear dim. Despite having a solid foundation with tight ends Tyler Warren and Sam LaPorta, their strategic missteps elsewhere have created a flawed roster. The running back position is particularly concerning, with Isaac Guerendo, a questionable starter at best, leading the charge. Wide receiver depth is equally unsettling; A.J. Brown and Marvin Harrison Jr. provide some spark, but the overall unit struggles with inconsistency, highlighted by reaching for Brandon Aiyuk well ahead of his value. Decisions to draft Kyler Murray and Tank Bigsby prematurely have only exacerbated the team's woes, leaving little room for error. Even the slight synergy gained from pairing Murray with Harrison Jr. seems inadequate to offset the pervasive mediocrity. As the new season approaches, Vtroha's

path forward appears fraught with challenges, requiring nothing short of a miracle to climb out of the cellar.
