While Kenneth Walker III offers a glimmer of hope, his slightly late draft pick is not enough to lift spirits. Meanwhile, the tight end situation offers little solace, with even fewer

reasons to be hopeful. The reach on Justin Herbert, taken well ahead of his value, exemplifies the questionable decisions that leave Red Zone Rudy ranked disappointingly low at 9th in the division and a dismal 26th percentile overall in the tournament. It feels as though the lessons of last season are being cruelly reiterated, casting a long shadow over the campaign ahead.

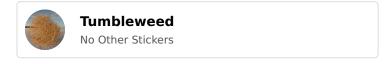
