There is no charitable read available for Igoo in 2026, and the draft log is the receipts. Five major reaches across the board tell the whole story, but the quarterback haul is where the damage is most legible: Jalen Hurts was taken a round and a half before his ADP, Brock Purdy went two-plus rounds early, Bo Nix cost nearly two rounds of premium, and Daniel Jones, a QB25, was drafted nearly five rounds ahead of where the market had him. That is not a quarterback strategy, that is a panic attack spread across six hours. Meanwhile, the rest of the roster reflects what happens when you mortgage your draft capital chasing signal-callers: Tyjae Spears, the projected weakest starter at RB47, is a player who needs favorable conditions to be relevant, and Terrance Ferguson projects as TE28. Puka Nacua at WR1 is real, and the draft did land him with some value, but one elite pass-catcher cannot paper over a roster built by a manager who reached early and often and ran out of board before running out of rounds. Dead last in the division feels about right.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that sets in when you look at a roster and realize the ceiling and the floor are essentially the same room. MHo enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting 11th in the Master Chief division and in just the 10th percentile of the field, and nothing about the roster construction suggests a reversal is coming. Jaxson Smith-Njigba projects as a genuine WR3, which is a real asset, but the supporting cast fades quickly, with Xavier Worthy checking in as the projected weakest starter at WR49. The draft offers little comfort either. Of 19 picks tracked, there were zero steals, and the most aggressive move of the board was reaching 2.7 rounds early on Jaxson Dart, a QB11 projection that is fine but hardly the kind of swing that reshapes a roster's trajectory. Jakobi Meyers slipping a round past his ADP counts as the lone moment of opportunism in an otherwise chalk-heavy exercise. MHo is not a disaster, just quietly, stubbornly ordinary in a tournament where ordinary finishes last.

The Omaha Nighthawks entered the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with legitimate options and somehow turned them into a cautionary tale. The receiver group has real top-end juice, CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and George Pickens at WR10 anchoring a corps that looks the part on paper, but the draft board tells a grimmer story underneath. Pickens himself was a reach, taken nearly a full round early, and the manager burned four additional picks on players taken well before their ADP, including Javonte Williams at RB17 hauled in two rounds ahead of schedule and Keenan Allen, a WR99 projection, somehow claimed four and a half rounds before the market would have priced him. Zero steals. Zero values. Thirteen chalk picks and four major reaches across a single draft is not a rough patch, it is a philosophy, and that philosophy has the Nighthawks sitting tenth in the Master Chief division and in just the 12th percentile of the field. Lamb is good enough that this team is not hopeless, but he cannot carry a draft that spent its surplus entirely on wishful thinking.

Swails24 finished at 63rd percentile last year and has somehow managed to slide to 34th this season, which is the wrong direction by any reasonable measure. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Justin Jefferson (WR6), DeVonta Smith (WR14), Zay Flowers (WR16), and Jameson Williams (WR21) all projecting as starters, and that collection would be the envy of most rosters in the Master Chief division. But the quarterback situation is a slow-motion disaster: Aaron Rodgers (QB29), Geno Smith (QB30), Deshaun Watson (QB34), and Carson Beck (QB40) represent a quartet of uncertainty that no amount of receiver talent can fully offset, and Swails24 reached for three of them before their ADPs anyway. Parker Washington adds intrigue as a flex option, but his path to consistent production depends on outrunning teammates the Jaguars invested heavily in, and that ceiling concern is real. The lever that would fix this team, a trustworthy starting quarterback, is exactly the lever that does not exist on this roster.

jsnyder86 lands at eighth in the Master Chief division and the 45th percentile of the field, and the roster explains why without much argument. The top-end talent is real in spots: Tyler Warren (TE4), Travis Kelce (TE10), and Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) give the lineup genuine star power, and Drake Maye (QB2) looks like a value after falling to 2.06. But the draft sheet shows 14 chalk picks, three minor reaches, and a major reach on Jared Goff (QB16) two rounds before the market agreed, and when you burn that kind of capital early, the middle rounds have to bail you out. They did not. Jadarian Price (RB26) projects as the weakest starter on the roster, and the names behind him, Rico Dowdle (RB32) and Chris Rodriguez (RB48), do not inspire a turnaround. The high-end pieces at the top of the lineup keep this team from being a complete write-off, but there is no obvious move left to make, and 45th percentile may be the ceiling rather than the floor.

Pizzabyalfredo sits at 60th percentile in the field and seventh in the Master Chief division, which tells you everything: this is a team built to be competitive, not dominant, and the difference between a deep run and an early exit comes down to a handful of close weeks. The foundation is genuinely strong. Brock Bowers projects as TE1, Joe Burrow as QB4, and a starting backfield featuring Chase Brown (RB11), Kyren Williams (RB15), and Travis Etienne (RB18) gives this roster real week-to-week floor. The problem is that margins punish reaches, and the Cam Ward gamble, taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his QB23 projection, cost capital that could have shored up the back end of the roster. Four values in the draft, including Josh Downs and D.J. Moore falling past their ADPs, show a manager who can identify opportunity, but the weakest projected starter being Downs at WR46 is a reminder that the opportunity only goes so far. When Pizzabyalfredo wins, it will be because the studs hit and the variance breaks right. When they lose, it will be by single digits.

Horsedaddy17 didn't build this roster with one flashy move, just a steady string of decisions that kept coming out ahead. The clearest example is James Cook, a projected RB5 who slipped to pick 2.09 despite an ADP of 2.04, a small gap that still counts as a win at that price. Pair him with Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Josh Jacobs at RB16 and you have a backfield core that most managers in the Master Chief division would envy. Tetairoa McMillan fell a full round past his ADP before Horsedaddy17 snapped him up at WR15, which is exactly the kind of quiet draft competence that separates 61st-percentile rosters from the ones crowding the bottom of the standings. The minor reaches on Jacobs and Courtland Sutton were modest and defensible, not the reckless swings that haunt teams in December. The tight end situation is thin by projection, but this is a positionless format and the top of this roster is good enough to carry some weight. Cautiously optimistic is the right temperature here.

There are no secret tricks hiding in this roster, no lottery-ticket swings that either pay off spectacularly or blow up in your face. grumpies333 simply drafted well, round after round, and the cumulative effect is a team that lands in the 72nd percentile of the field with a case to climb higher. The foundation is genuinely elite: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the Master Chief division cannot match. Achane, notably, came to grumpies333 two rounds later than his ADP suggested he would, which is the quiet kind of draft win that separates competent managers from sharp ones. Chris Olave at WR11 arrived on a similar discount, sliding a full round past where he was expected to go. None of this is glamorous. There was no moment in the draft room where grumpies333 zigged while the field zagged. There was just a consistent pattern of coming out ahead, and after 26 wins and an 88th-percentile scoring season in 2025, that pattern deserves to be taken seriously.

Fish out of Water finished last season at exactly .500, a coin-flip team sitting at 75th percentile in scoring, and then walked into the 2026 draft and built something that looks considerably more dangerous. The board says they reached, and reached often, two major reaches against zero steals, which is not typically the blueprint for roster envy. Yet here we are: Drake London at WR7, Nico Collins at WR9, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Trey McBride at TE2, a starting core that sits at 72nd percentile tournament-wide and earns it. The most honest question mark is Khalil Shakir, the weakest projected starter on the roster, who cost a WR51 price tag after being pulled nearly two rounds before his ADP suggested he would last. That is either foresight or stubbornness depending on how September goes. Then there is Brian Thomas Jr., a projected starter with a connection to Trevor Lawrence that has reportedly cooled since his early breakout, which is the kind of thing that does not show up in projections until

suddenly it does. Fish out of Water earned this roster the hard way. Whether the conviction behind those early triggers was wisdom or fortune is exactly what 2026 will sort out.

Kirky enters 2026 sitting third in the Master Chief division and in the top 20 percent of the entire field, and the draft tells you exactly why: no single breathtaking moment, just a consistent pattern of coming out ahead. Four picks landed as genuine values, and the most telling ones cluster at receiver, where Carnell Tate, Jayden Reed, Jayden Higgins, and Travis Hunter all fell between one and two rounds past their ADPs before kirky quietly scooped them up. None of those names individually reshapes a season, but four of them together, absorbed at a discount, is how a draft quietly compounds into an edge. The quarterback and tight end groups are strong on paper, with Lamar Jackson at QB3 paired alongside Justin Herbert, and Harold Fannin and Kyle Pitts projecting as a TE6-TE7 tandem that most rosters would envy. The two early running back reaches in Emmett Johnson and Demond Claiborne are real, but they land in the later rounds where the cost of being wrong is manageable. Kirky did not luck into 82nd percentile standing. The draft built it, one small advantage at a time.

There are flashy drafts and there are good drafts, and 144honeybadgers quietly put together the latter. The foundation is exceptional: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 give this roster two players who project as genuinely elite at their positions, and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) and Jeremiyah Love (RB13) keep the ceiling high well past the top of the depth chart. What makes the draft especially clean, though, is how consistently the manager came out ahead on value. Malik Nabers fell nearly three full rounds past his ADP before landing here at WR12, the kind of slip that wins drafts by itself. Trevor Lawrence, quietly coming off a career year with over 4,000 yards and a career-high nine rushing touchdowns, projects as QB10 and looks like exactly the sort of player whose value the market has still not fully priced in. Chalk where chalk made sense, value where it appeared. The result is a team sitting second in the Master Chief division and in the 89th percentile of the field, and it got there without a single dramatic swing.

CrawlBackwardsOutOfHeaven sits first in the Master Chief Division and in the 94th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The headline move is Caleb Williams, snagged at 4.12 when his average draft position was 3.06, a steal of a round and a half on a QB6 projection who connects directly with Colston Loveland, a TE3 projection grabbed at 2.12 with similar late-round-for-his-tier timing. That stack alone gives this roster a structural advantage most managers have to manufacture. Around those two, the projected starters read like a curator's checklist: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, A.J. Brown at WR8, George Kittle at TE9, Tucker Kraft at TE5. The rest of the board was played almost entirely at or near consensus, with only one minor reach across the whole draft, Kirk Cousins going slightly early late in the draft. In a format that rewards discipline and punishes panic, CrawlBackwardsOutOfHeaven drafted like someone who had done their homework twice and still showed up early.
