As the Gretna Possums brace themselves for what promises to be a grueling 2025 season, their prospects look bleak. Settling at the very bottom of the divisional standings and languishing in the lowest percentile overall, they face an uphill battle that seems insurmountable. Despite the modest gains from snagging Kyler Murray and Dylan Sampson later than expected, the team's draft strategy was marred by reaching significantly for players like Tony Pollard and Puka Nacua, which robbed them of crucial value and depth. The decision to rely on Brandon Aiyuk, currently ranked WR50, highlights the weaknesses in their wide receiver corps, despite having a standout in Puka Nacua. Moreover, the unusual early selections of Trevor Lawrence and Dallas Goedert raise further questions about the team's strategic coherence. With their current makeup, the Possums seem

destined to struggle against stronger competition, both within the division and beyond, unless they can defy expectations—though, realistically, hope is in short supply this season.
