mjakers1 drafted like a monk, patient and disciplined, finishing with 19 chalk picks, zero major reaches, and a single minor one on Patrick Mahomes. The process was correct. The result is a team sitting in the bottom fifth of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole religion. The starters read well on paper: Lamar Jackson at QB3, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Chris Olave at WR11. But the depth behind them is where the math quietly stops working. Marvin Harrison Jr. arrives at WR33 carrying two seasons of injury and a quarterback situation in Arizona that is, generously speaking, unresolved, with Jacoby Brissett the apparent answer to questions no one was excited to ask. Wan'Dale Robinson, projected as the weakest starter, sits at WR47. mjakers1 trusted the market and the market handed back a roster that looks organized right up until you try to count on it. Doing everything right and landing 18th percentile is not a draft failure. It is just a particularly honest draft.

HmanKman enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Oregon Trail division and in just the 26th percentile of the field, and the roster grades offer little reason for optimism. The draft tells the story cleanly: zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk picks, and a major reach on Ja'Kobi Lane, taken nearly four full rounds before his ADP suggested anyone else wanted him. The top of the roster is real, Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Justin Jefferson at WR6, and Jalen Hurts at QB9 all project as starters, and a Hurts/Dallas Goedert stack adds a wrinkle worth watching given that Goedert quietly strung together four touchdowns over a three-week stretch during last season's fantasy playoffs. But the depth falls off sharply, with Jordan Addison projecting as the weakest starter at WR43, and nothing on the back end of the board inspires confidence that a wave of injuries could be absorbed. Last year's 56th-percentile scoring was respectable enough, but this roster grades out as a step backward, and there is no obvious move left to change that trajectory.

StopPooping sits 11th in the Oregon Trail division and checks in at just the 26th percentile of the field, and the roster construction does little to argue against that grim math. The backfield is a genuine bright spot, with Jahmyr Gibbs projecting as the RB1 and Breece Hall and Bucky Irving offering real depth behind him, but the supporting cast fades fast. Baker Mayfield grades out as a QB18 after a 2025 season where he barely cleared QB1 territory, and with Mike Evans gone to free agency, the case for a bounce-back gets harder to make, not easier. Then there is the draft log, which reads like a eulogy: 15 chalk picks, two minor reaches, and two major ones, including Jaxson Dart taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP at QB11. Dart may justify that faith eventually, but betting two-plus rounds on eventually is exactly the kind of optimism the rest of this roster cannot afford to carry. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, just a long, quiet trudge down the trail.

There is no spin available for Okanogan61, sitting ninth in the Oregon Trail division and projecting at just the 27th percentile of the field. The draft tells the story plainly: zero steals, zero true values, and three major reaches that do real damage. Jalen McMillan, taken two full rounds before his ADP, is a WR59 who does not deserve that kind of draft capital. Jaylin Noel was yanked off the board nearly three rounds early and projects at WR83. Elijah Arroyo was the worst of it, taken almost five rounds ahead of schedule at TE40, a pick that makes even less sense when Colston Loveland and Tyler Warren, a TE3 and TE4, are already on the roster doing perfectly capable work. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 is legitimately excellent, and Loveland and Warren are a genuine strength, but the back end of this roster reads like a draft-day spiral that nobody stopped. Matthew Golden is the projected weakest starter at WR52, which feels about right for a team that spent its ammunition chasing players the market had already correctly priced down.

Sbpp enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Oregon Trail Division and projecting at just the 33rd percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not inspire much confidence that those numbers will move. The foundation looks fine on paper, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give the team legitimate stars, but the drop-off after those two is steep and unforgiving. Justin Herbert projects as only QB8, and the fact that the team reached a full round early to get him suggests the manager is paying a premium for a player who is not quite a difference-maker at that slot. Meanwhile, the late-round dart board produced Malachi Fields at WR90 and Skyler Bell at WR103, both taken well ahead of their ADPs, which means sbpp spent draft capital expecting upside that the projections simply do not validate. Isaiah Likely made a move to the New York Giants with John Harbaugh and carries some legitimate optimism, but at TE13 he is a depth piece, not a savior. This roster needed a late-round coup to flip the script, and it did not get one.

Last year ginasportsball finished in the 91st percentile, and that reputation is doing a lot of heavy lifting heading into 2026, because this roster is sitting at just the 38th percentile and seventh in the Oregon Trail division. The foundation is real: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 are legitimate building blocks, and Jayden Daniels at QB5 gives the team a credible top-end arm. But the draft suggests a manager who trusted feel over data, logging twelve chalk picks, five minor reaches, and two major reaches against zero steals. The most glaring of those is Ty Simpson, taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting all the way down at QB36, which is a lot of draft capital committed to a player who may never see a meaningful snap. The gap between what ginasportsball was and what this roster actually projects to be is real, and coasting on a great 2025 is not a fantasy football strategy that survives contact with a new season.

Dysentery Sandwiches didn't mortgage anything to build this roster, and the result is a team sitting at the 58th percentile that could quietly climb. The foundation starts with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, two projected starters who give this team a high floor before a single other pick is considered. From there, the draft was almost entirely chalk, which sounds boring until you realize chalk means getting the player you wanted at the price you expected, seventeen times over. The most interesting piece may be the Caleb Williams and Luther Burden stack. Burden spent the first half of 2025 buried on the depth chart, then averaged a 53 percent snap share over the back stretch and paced a 1,000 yard pace in that span. Ben Johnson is now comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown, and Williams is the one throwing him the ball. If Burden delivers on that hype, this stack elevates the whole roster. Dysentery Sandwiches didn't force anything. They just kept winning the pick.

markhill321 didn't win the draft in one flashy moment, they just kept winning small battles until the ledger tilted clearly in their favor. The foundation is undeniable: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and James Cook at RB5 give this roster a top-end that most managers would build an entire strategy around, and Derrick Henry at RB12 behind them keeps the quality from thinning out quickly. What separates a good draft from a great one, though, is finding value in the middle rounds, and markhill321 did exactly that. RJ Harvey came at pick 11.11 against an ADP closer to the tenth round, Courtland Sutton landed at 9.11 with similar surplus, and Chris Godwin followed in round 10 at a discount. None of those are lottery tickets, they're reliable contributors acquired cheaply, and that consistency compounds. The 2025 result, a 78 percent win rate and 93rd-percentile scoring, suggests this manager knows how to convert roster quality into actual points. The 63rd-percentile projection feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

Scottinthe503 is making a straightforward argument in the Oregon Trail division: when you have this much elite talent concentrated at the top of your roster, the math tends to work itself out. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, and the fact that he slipped to pick 1.09 despite an ADP of 1.05 is the kind of small gift that compounds over a season. Pair him with Harold Fannin at TE6 and Dalton Kincaid at TE11, both projected starters, and you have a genuine stack with Allen and Kincaid layered on top of that. The receiver group is where this roster starts to feel almost unfair: Drake London at WR7, Zay Flowers at WR16, Jameson Williams at WR21, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 are all projected starters, with Jordyn Tyson at WR34 waiting in the wings. In a positionless format, quality is the only currency that matters, and Scottinthe503 is flush. The 2025 season posted a 96th percentile scoring mark, and this roster is built to remind the Oregon Trail division why that was not a fluke.

tootsiepop6 didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft in one moment, they won it in eighteen of them. The clearest example is the tight end group, where Drake Maye at QB2 anchors the passing game while Trey McBride at TE2, Sam LaPorta at TE8, and Travis Kelce at TE10 give this roster an upper-tier advantage at a position that routinely separates winning teams from also-rans. Then consider Chase Brown, a projected RB11 who fell nearly a full round past his ADP, landing at 4.05 when his price tag said 3.08. That kind of quiet patience compounded across the draft board is exactly how a roster lands in the 70th percentile without a single highlight-reel moment to point to. The Jared Goff and LaPorta stack adds a layer of correlated upside that could spike a week when it matters most. There are softer spots on the roster, but this team sitting third in the Oregon Trail division feels like an understatement waiting to be corrected.

EdWill300 lands at 79th percentile in the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl field, and the draft tells you exactly why: 17 chalk picks and zero major reaches, a quiet accumulation of correct decisions that added up to something real. The foundation is genuinely elite, with Joe Burrow at QB4 and Brock Bowers at TE1 giving this roster a ceiling that most managers in the Oregon Trail division cannot match. The running game reinforces that case, as Kenneth Walker III (RB10), Kyren Williams (RB15), and TreVeyon Henderson (RB19) project as starters alongside David Montgomery, who slid to RB23 and was still sitting there in the ninth round despite an ADP that put him in the eighth. That kind of patience compounds over a full draft. DeVonta Smith and Emeka Egbuka round out a starting group where even the weakest projected starter, Jayden Reed at WR48, is a serviceable floor rather than a liability. EdWill300 did not force anything. The board just kept cooperating.

HATFRY enters 2026 sitting first in the Oregon Trail Division and in the 91st percentile of the field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: this was a roster built through consistent execution, not lottery tickets. The headliner is Puka Nacua at WR1, a genuinely elite anchor, paired with A.J. Brown at WR8 and Tee Higgins at WR19 rounding out a receiving group that would make most managers envious. But the move that quietly defines this roster came in round 12, when HATFRY landed Jadarian Price at RB26 after the market had him pegged as a round-nine pick, a value that materialized simply because everyone else was looking elsewhere. That kind of patient accumulation shows up in the overall shape of the draft: 14 chalk picks surrounding a true steal in Price, with De'Von Achane at RB6 and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 giving the backfield real teeth. Coming off an 84th-percentile scoring season in 2025, HATFRY has the look of a team that just keeps drafting well until the wins take care of themselves.
