There is no charitable interpretation of what tazzmazz built in Epic Mickey, and the draft log makes that case without needing any help. Six major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and the philosophy failed. The most damning example is Jordan Addison, a WR43 projection taken 4.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of aggressive bet that needs to hit to be forgiven and almost certainly will not be. Meanwhile, the quarterback situation reads like a cry for help: Kyler Murray, coming off a lisfranc injury that ended his Arizona tenure and landed him in a "true competition" with JJ McCarthy in Minnesota, was taken 2.3 rounds early as a QB19. Then, apparently unsatisfied with one shaky gamble at the position, tazzmazz went back in round seven for Bryce Young, a QB26, another 3.8 rounds ahead of schedule. CeeDee Lamb is real, but one legitimate anchor cannot rescue a roster assembled like a series of impulsive double-downs. The 1st percentile ranking in the tournament is not a surprise, it is a verdict.

There is no spin available for vevalachris, and the numbers do not ask for any. Sitting at the 5th percentile of the field and ranked 11th in the Epic Mickey division, this roster is the draft-board equivalent of a controlled demolition, except nothing was controlled. The reach on Trey Benson stands as the signature moment, pulled six-plus rounds ahead of his ADP to land a player projected as RB64, the kind of swing that costs a manager every round that follows. The rest of the board tells the same story: five major reaches in a single draft, zero steals, and a receiving corps headlined by Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 with almost nothing behind him. The one genuine bright spot is Drake Maye, a QB2 projection who added AJ Brown this offseason and arrives with legitimate upside, but even Maye cannot rescue what the rest of the roster looks like. When your most consequential draft decisions were pulling Jaylen Warren nearly three rounds early and spending a mid-round pick on Fernando Mendoza at QB27, your season does not need a preview so much as a postmortem.

There is no charitable read available for DyNastyMoFo, sitting at the bottom of the Epic Mickey division and projected in the 10th percentile of the entire field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. The manager reached on four players by more than three rounds each, a collection of optimism so untethered from consensus that it borders on performance art. Daniel Jones, a QB25, was taken 3.5 rounds early. Tory Horton, a WR93, was taken 4.3 rounds early. Jordan James, an RB67, was taken four full rounds ahead of his ADP. Not one steal appears anywhere on this roster, and the single player who qualified as genuine value, Bhayshul Tuten, was a modest underpay that does nothing to offset the carnage elsewhere. Christian McCaffrey is a legitimate star at RB3, and the tight end group is genuinely strong, but reaching compulsively for players like Jones and Horton means those anchors are surrounded by players the rest of the field correctly passed on. DyNastyMoFo did not get unlucky. They out-drafted themselves in the wrong direction.

BioHazard13 sits 9th in the Epic Mickey division and in just the 13th percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The backfield is legitimately excellent, with De'Von Achane (RB6), Kenneth Walker III (RB10), and Kyren Williams (RB15) anchoring a group that could carry a contender. The problem is that the receiver corps is where that contender dissolves. Davante Adams (WR25) is the top option at the position and Jakobi Meyers (WR45) projects as a starter, which is the kind of sentence you type and then stare at for a while. The draft didn't help matters. Reaching 1.5 rounds early for Williams was an aggressive bet that compressed draft capital, and taking Keenan Allen (WR99) nearly five rounds before his ADP in the back half suggests a manager hoping for lightning rather than engineering it. With the weakest projected starter in the lineup grading out as Meyers, BioHazard13 is essentially running premium fuel through an engine with a cracked block.

Barry Griffiths Go Bucs sits at the 65th percentile in the field and eighth in the Epic Mickey division, which is exactly where a team like this lives: good enough to beat anyone on a given week, not scary enough to make anyone sweat the matchup. The backbone is real. Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1), Ashton Jeanty (RB7), and Saquon Barkley (RB8) give this roster a run of projected starters that can carry a week outright, and Patrick Mahomes (QB12) stacking with Rashee Rice (WR13) adds a ceiling-game component that keeps the scoring floor from becoming the story. But the margins cut both ways. At the bottom of the projected lineup sits Rico Dowdle (RB32), a capable back who surpassed 1,000 yards in 2025 and still couldn't secure his job in Carolina, now entering Pittsburgh behind Jaylen Warren with a role that is genuinely unclear. When Gibbs, Jeanty, and Barkley are humming, none of that matters. When even one of them stumbles, the difference between a playoff run and a middle-of-the-pack finish probably has Dowdle's name on it.

FrickShrimp lands at 66th percentile in the field, which sounds modest until you look at how they built it. The standout move is Jalen McMillan, taken at 9.01 when the consensus said he wouldn't go until round 13. That is nearly five rounds early, which is the kind of reach that either looks visionary in October or haunts you all season. McMillan projects as a WR59, so the numbers are not exactly screaming vindication yet, but the conviction is undeniable. Meanwhile, the foundation they built around that gamble is genuinely strong: Puka Nacua at WR1 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a top-of-roster quality that most managers in the Epic Mickey division cannot match, and Nabers himself was a legitimate value, sliding a full round past his ADP. The Caleb Williams and Rome Odunze stack adds another layer of ceiling. FrickShrimp did not draft a perfect board, they drafted their board, and the roster that came out the other side is better than the process probably deserved.

BurdistheWord sits at the 81st percentile in the field, and the draft record explains exactly why: seven values, nine chalk, and only two minor reaches against two major ones. That's not a team built on one thunderbolt pick, it's a team built by consistently being right. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 anchors the receiving corps, and Trey McBride at TE2 gives this roster a top-end tight end most managers would trade a mid-round pick to acquire. The value accumulation continued deep into the draft, with Chris Godwin falling a full round past his ADP and Josh Downs slipping nearly two rounds to land at WR46. Even Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19 arrived roughly a round late to BurdistheWord's roster. The two major reaches both came at quarterback, with Malik Willis and Kirk Cousins each taken nearly three rounds ahead of schedule, which is the one area where the otherwise disciplined approach got a little sentimental. Still, sixth in the Epic Mickey division and a top-20-percent tournament projection is a reasonable reward for a draft that kept outpacing the room.

Shaulin Monks didn't swing for fences and whiff, didn't gamble on upside and pray. They just drafted well, round after round, and the ledger shows it. Justin Jefferson at WR6 slipping to pick 2.05 when his ADP sat at 1.12 is the kind of gift that sets a tone, and Sam LaPorta falling more than two full rounds past his ADP to become a projected TE8 starter is the kind of find that separates good drafts from great ones. Stack those two against a projected TE1 in Brock Bowers and a WR10 in George Pickens, and the top of this roster is genuinely hard to argue with. The Tyreek Hill reach at three-plus rounds early is real, but on a roster sitting 84th percentile in the field, it reads more like a minor blemish than a structural flaw. This is what steady looks like: no single heroic pick, just a draft that consistently came out ahead and built something worth watching in the Epic Mickey division.

Stopa didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by not losing it anywhere. The foundation is legitimately elite: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 give this roster a top-end that most managers in the Epic Mickey division simply cannot match, and both arrived at or near fair value, Chase sliding a few spots past his ADP and Taylor coming four picks later than the market expected. That kind of quiet accumulation compounds quickly in a positionless format where depth at the top translates directly into lineup flexibility. DeVonta Smith (WR14), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and Christian Watson (WR28) round out a receiving corps that projects to deliver week after week, and Jadarian Price at RB26 gives stopa a legitimate secondary option behind Taylor rather than a placeholder. The draft featured fifteen chalk picks and only two minor reaches, which sounds boring until you realize that boring drafts with Chase and Taylor at the top land you in the 89th percentile of the field. Stopa came out ahead almost every time the clock ran out.

LegalTortoise lands third in the Epic Mickey Division and sits in the top 10 percent of the field, and the draft sheet will tell you they got lucky to be there. Three major reaches, zero steals, the board apparently abandoned for personal conviction somewhere around the middle rounds. But look at what that conviction bought: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5 anchoring the backfield, Tyler Warren at TE4 paired with a Jaxson Dart stack that gives this roster a genuine points-correlation bonus, and Chris Olave at WR11 who fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed like a gift. Ray Davis was the most aggressive gamble, taken more than five rounds before consensus had him going, and he projects as RB62, so that one is still on trial. But the hits outweigh the misses by enough that the skepticism feels academic. LegalTortoise did not build this roster by waiting patiently for value to come to them. They went and got what they wanted, and the roster mostly justified the stubbornness.

hashtagMARIO lands at 91st percentile in the field and second in the Epic Mickey division, and the draft board tells you exactly why: disciplined, patient, and rewarding when the board cooperated. The wide receiver group is the crown jewel here. Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Nico Collins sits at WR9, and Luther Burden comes in at WR22 after falling more than two full rounds past his ADP, a gift hashtagMARIO had the presence of mind to collect. Terry McLaurin at WR24, Alec Pierce at WR32, and Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47 round out a receiver corps that gives this lineup real week-to-week flexibility. Quarterback is equally clean: Justin Herbert at QB8 and Jalen Hurts at QB9 were both taken at value, with Hurts sliding nearly a full round past his ADP before hashtagMARIO scooped him up. The one blemish is Braelon Allen, reached on by nearly four rounds, but one impulsive pick does not define a draft this tidy. This is what it looks like when a manager trusts the process and lets value come to them.

MOXY5280 sits atop the Epic Mickey division and in the 91st percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why: no lottery tickets cashed, no single transformative pick, just a steady accumulation of advantage. Josh Allen anchors the whole operation as QB1, and pairing him with D.J. Moore while stacking Baker Mayfield with Emeka Egbuka gives this roster two functional quarterback bridges, meaning Allen's bye week or a bad matchup never becomes a crisis. The receiver group is where the consistency really compounds: Drake London came in as WR7 and fell nearly a full round past his ADP, A.J. Brown arrived as WR8, and George Kittle materialized at TE9 despite sliding a round and a half past where he was supposed to go. Four players graded as values, zero reaches. That is not luck and it is not one brilliant swing, it is a manager who let the board come to them on pick after pick and walked away holding something genuinely dangerous.
