Adam1590 sits at the bottom of the Marvel Rivals division and in the 4th percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly how that happened. The reaches start early and never stop: Tee Higgins at WR19 burned a second-round pick on a player consensus had available in round four, then Ladd McConkey came off the board one pick later at a similar premium, meaning two consecutive selections went toward a pair of receivers the market collectively valued nearly two rounds later. That might be forgiven if the rest of the draft tightened up, but it did not. Malik Willis, a QB24, got drafted in round seven, nearly four rounds ahead of where the market had him, which is the kind of move that makes sense only if you have already secured your upside elsewhere and are panic-buying depth you do not need. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is the one genuine anchor here, but a single elite player propping up four major reaches and a projected weakest starter in Kyle Monangai at RB33 is less a roster than a cautionary tale in spreadsheet form.

There is no charitable read available for ronrigney in the Marvel Rivals division, and the draft board confirms it in writing. The headline number is four major reaches across the roster, and two of them are quarterbacks: Justin Fields, taken 6.1 rounds ahead of his ADP, and Mac Jones, taken 4.6 rounds early, both projecting outside the QB30. That is an enormous premium paid for a position that projects as the team's weakest group, with no projected starter among the four quarterbacks on the roster. Meanwhile, Tyler Warren, taken nearly a full round early at pick 2.08, is a legitimate TE4, but Warren was not the problem with this draft and he cannot fix what surrounds him. The team sits 11th in the division and in the 13th percentile of the field, and with zero steals and four major reaches shaping the roster's skeleton, the math behind those numbers is easy to follow. Ronrigney came to the table, reached repeatedly, and built a team that reflects every one of those decisions.

GeorgeReedFF drafted like someone who had a plan, executed it badly, and kept doubling down. The most damning evidence is Jared Goff, taken two full rounds ahead of his ADP to land a QB16, a price that would be uncomfortable for a QB5. That is the kind of decision that sends ripples through an entire draft, and sure enough, four major reaches total cratered any chance of accumulating real value. Kyren Williams, taken 2.1 rounds early, comes in projected at RB15, which is fine on its own terms but not fine when you burned a third-round pick to get there. Meanwhile, CeeDee Lamb is the one genuinely elite piece on the board, but his supporting cast tops out at DK Metcalf at WR36, the weakest projected starter on the team. A 2025 finish at the 25th percentile in scoring was not a fluke to be corrected. It was a preview. This roster sits 10th in the Marvel Rivals division and in the bottom 15 percent of the field, and nothing in the draft history suggests the rebuild is coming.

There is no sugarcoating the situation in the Marvel Rivals division: susaneisenberg sits ninth in the division and in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the roster offers very little reason for optimism. The RB group looks like the engine, with James Cook (RB5), Jeremiyah Love (RB13), Quinshon Judkins (RB22), and D'Andre Swift (RB24) all projected as starters, but that firepower gets quietly undermined at the top of the draft. Cook was a minor reach at 1.10, and George Pickens (WR10) was the major reach of the board, taken at 2.03 against an ADP of 3.01, which means susaneisenberg paid a premium for players who then graded out exactly where the market expected them to land. When your draft capital is spent leaning into consensus rather than finding edges, you need projection upgrades to bail you out, and the quarterback situation, anchored by Jaxson Dart (QB11) and C.J. Stroud (QB22), is not going to do that. The ceiling is visible. The floor feels closer.

Stacyp83 sits at 31st percentile and eighth in the Marvel Rivals division, and the draft record explains exactly how things got there: three major reaches and three minor reaches against zero steals. That is a draft that consistently paid a premium for players it wanted rather than letting value come to it. Kyler Murray at QB19 was taken more than two rounds early, and the quarterback position grades out weak overall, which means stacyp83 burned a mid-round pick on a ceiling that does not exist. The one genuine bright spot is the tight end group, where Brock Bowers projects as TE1 and Colston Loveland sits at TE3, giving this roster a legitimate top-end anchor. But elite tight end production can only carry so much weight when the receiver group leans on projected starters like Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 and Josh Downs at WR46, and Kenneth Gainwell at RB34 grades out as the weakest projected starter on the board. Bowers and Loveland are real, but the rest of this roster looks like a team that drafted with hope rather than discipline.

JohnDank played this draft about as well as a drafter can without actually winning anything. The value column is full: Travis Kelce at TE10 fell a full round, Jordyn Tyson and Courtland Sutton both slid past their ADPs, and Fernando Mendoza came nearly three rounds late. Patience, discipline, the whole sermon. And yet here is the cruel math: this roster projects 37th percentile, seventh in the Marvel Rivals division, with a weakest projected starter in Sutton at WR37. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give the team a legitimate top-end, and the Mahomes-Kelce stack adds the kind of ceiling that wins tournaments. But Sam LaPorta, the one significant reach of the draft, cost JohnDank a third-round pick to land a TE8, and the rest of the roster never quite builds to something dangerous. The picks were right. The player pool just did not cooperate. Sometimes the process earns a B-plus and the outcome hands you a C-minus anyway.

Marko0497 sits at 45th percentile and sixth in the Marvel Rivals division, which means every week feels like it could tip either way. The case for optimism starts with the receivers: Puka Nacua (WR1), Nico Collins (WR9), and Luther Burden (WR22) give this roster genuine top-end talent, and Burden arriving as a value at pick 6.12 after slipping nearly two rounds past his ADP suggests the draft did not go entirely to plan for the rest of the room. The concern is what surrounds that ceiling. Drake Maye (QB2) is a legitimate asset, but four major reaches in the draft, including Hunter Henry at TE18 taken three and a half rounds early and Jordan Love at QB17 burned at pick 4.12, indicate a manager who kept drafting ahead of the market and paying premium prices for players the consensus did not value nearly as highly. Whether those bets land determines everything. This roster has the top-line talent to beat anyone in the division on a good week and the draft-capital inefficiency to lose to anyone on a bad one.

Brooks51773 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by staying patient and letting the board come to them, round after round. Trey McBride at TE2 sliding past his ADP by four picks set the tone early, and then Jayden Daniels, a full round later than expected, gave this roster a QB5 at a steep discount. Those two picks alone would make most managers sleep well, but what holds this team together is the quiet consistency of the WR group: Drake London at WR7 anchors it, and while the reaches on Xavier Worthy and a couple of late-round fliers are fair to note, none of them represent the kind of aggressive gambling that blows up rosters in March and leaves managers scrambling by August. The draft sheet shows four values, twelve chalk picks, and zero major reaches, which is less a bold statement than a steady argument, the kind that tends to hold up when the season actually starts. Sitting fifth in the Marvel Rivals division at the 60th percentile, Brooks51773 isn't the favorite, but they're firmly in the conversation.

yahboyAlan did not win this draft on one thunderclap pick. He won it the way a good poker player wins a long session: steadily, hand after hand, never needing the miracle card. Malik Nabers fell a full 1.6 rounds past his ADP and landed as a WR12 starter. Dalton Kincaid slipped even further in relative terms, dropping 1.6 rounds to become a TE11 contributor, though the honest caveat is that Kincaid's knee has been an ongoing concern and Bills GM Brandon Beane has already hedged publicly about whether it will be resolved by 2026. Justin Herbert, projected QB8, came off the board nearly a full round late. Seven values across the roster, almost no steals required, just a manager who kept finding the market slightly wrong and kept cashing in. The one blemish, a 2.2-round reach on Tyler Shough, is softened by the Shough and Chris Olave stack that gives it genuine upside logic. The result is a team sitting at 75th percentile tournament-wide, fourth in the Marvel Rivals division, and very much in the conversation.

Thanos was right! didn't snap half the field out of existence, but this draft quietly made the right calls often enough to land in the top 15 percent of the tournament. The foundation is genuinely elite: Josh Allen at QB1 slid six picks past his ADP at 1.11, a modest fall that still amounts to getting the best quarterback in fantasy at a slight discount. Then the manager built out one of the more impressive receiver groups in the field, starring Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Rashee Rice at WR13 as projected starters, with Jameson Williams, Terry McLaurin, and Davante Adams also in the mix. Adams himself was a value, falling nearly two rounds past his ADP. The draft wasn't flawless, Geno Smith and Matthew Golden were both reached on by roughly two rounds apiece, but those are late-roster gambles, not core mistakes. Twelve chalk picks and four genuine values against just two major reaches is a draft profile that says less about aggression and more about discipline, and in a field this competitive, discipline compounds.

KitchenSink didn't build this roster by swinging for the fences on one marquee move. They built it by consistently being the smartest person at the table. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 are the kind of foundation most managers would kill for, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 rounds out a backfield group that looks almost unfair until you remember that a 29-year-old Barkley, coming off a down 2025 in Philadelphia, carries real questions about workload and efficiency going forward. That concern is baked into the projections, and KitchenSink still has him as a starter. Where this draft really earns its reputation, though, is in the value column: Caleb Williams fell more than a round past his ADP, TreVeyon Henderson fell nearly two, and Makai Lemon slipped almost two full rounds before this team quietly scooped him at WR40. Six values against a single major reach is not luck, it is a draft plan that worked. The result is a roster sitting second in the Marvel Rivals division and in the 96th percentile of the field, and it got there the honest way.

CrazyBats didn't stumble into a 99th-percentile roster. They built it, brick by brick, with the kind of draft discipline that makes the rest of the Marvel Rivals division look like they were working from a different sheet. The foundation is immaculate: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 paired with Joe Burrow at QB4 in a live stack, and Lamar Jackson at QB3 stacked with Mark Andrews, which means two of this team's best players are actively feeding two others. Beyond the architecture, the value extraction is what separates good drafts from great ones, and CrazyBats had six players come off the board later than their ADP warranted, including Kenneth Walker III landing at RB10 a full round and a half after he should have been gone. The weakest projected starter is Michael Wilson at WR39, which tells you everything you need to know about the floor here. Clean stacks, disciplined picks, and a positional rank at the bottom of the lineup that most teams would take at the top.
