Six major reaches in a single draft is not a stylistic quirk, it is a confession, and Maul's board reads like one long apology. The two most damning decisions came early: Jameson Williams, a WR21, pulled in at pick 3.04 when the field was happy to wait until round five, and Matthew Stafford, a QB14, yanked off the board at 4.09 with no meaningful upgrade over options that would have been sitting there rounds later. Those two moves alone warped everything downstream, and the ripple effect is visible in a starting group headlined by Chuba Hubbard as the weakest projected starter, a player ranked RB29 who is essentially a placeholder for a roster that never found the running back room it needed. Brock Bowers at TE1 is genuinely excellent, and Nico Collins at WR9 gives this team a pulse, but two strong pieces cannot paper over a draft that produced zero steals, six major reaches, and a 2025 season that finished in the 29th percentile of scoring. Dead last in the Star Wars Battlefront II division feels less like a projection than a promise.

Black Label Society sits 11th in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in the 7th percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not suggest a dramatic reversal is coming. The receiver group looks impressive on paper, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Zay Flowers (WR16), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and Ladd McConkey (WR20) projecting as starters, but the Goff/St. Brown stack is essentially the engine of this whole operation, and if that pairing sputters, there is no obvious Plan B. The QB situation behind Jared Goff (QB16) is a quiet disaster, with Sam Darnold (QB21) and Bryce Young (QB26) serving as the kind of insurance you hope never pays out. The draft offered no steals and six reaches, including McConkey pulled more than two rounds early. Parker Washington (WR35) is genuinely interesting as a depth piece, but whether the Jaguars organization even wants him in his current role is a real question, and building around a player whose own team seems ambivalent about him is no way to climb out of the basement.

Anakin enters 2026 ranked tenth in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in just the 14th percentile of the full field, and the roster makes it easy to understand why. The foundation is genuinely strong: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as the RB1, Saquon Barkley checks in at RB8, and Tyler Warren slots in at TE4. But the moment you scroll past those names, the air gets thin in a hurry. The receiver group is the real drag, with Chris Godwin at WR38 and Xavier Worthy at WR49 as the projected starters, and the QB situation carries its own uncertainty. Patrick Mahomes, coming off a torn ACL and LCL suffered in Week 15 of 2025, is reportedly ahead of schedule in his recovery, but whether he takes the field in Week 1 remains genuinely unclear. And the draft board offered little relief, producing zero steals alongside five reaches, including a major one on Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31. Gibbs and Barkley are real, but Anakin needs a lot to go right elsewhere just to climb to average.

JayKile1 sits ninth in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in just the 16th percentile of the field, and the construction of this roster makes it hard to see where the turnaround comes from. The RB group is genuinely deep, with James Cook (RB5), Kenneth Walker III (RB10), and Kyren Williams (RB15) all projecting as starters, but the draft process that built it leaned heavily on reaches, four of them major, and that bill is coming due at the margins. Bucky Irving came off the board nearly three rounds early, and RJ Harvey and Kyle Monangai followed the same pattern, which means JayKile1 paid top-dollar prices in a currency that never refunds. Meanwhile, the receiver group is a fog of WR55s and WR81s, and the quarterback situation quietly carries its own risk: Baker Mayfield is a projected starter, but Mike Evans is gone in Tampa now, and consensus isn't convinced Mayfield climbs back to his 2024 form without him. This roster looks like a team that made all its big swings before the season started and discovered the ceiling on the way down.

OtownSteveO played the draft almost exactly right on paper. The value column is long, nearly every pick came at or after ADP, and the team still sits at 35th percentile and eighth in the Star Wars Battlefront II division, which is the cruelest verdict fantasy football can deliver. The problem is structural: the receiver group is legitimately excellent, with Puka Nacua at WR1, George Pickens at WR10, and Rashee Rice at WR13 all projecting as starters, but Rice cost a reach of 1.2 rounds and George Kittle cost an even steeper 2.4 rounds early, meaning the team overpaid at two of its marquee spots while the rest of the roster thinned out. Aaron Jones at RB38 and Kimani Vidal at RB60 are the running backs, and no amount of receiver depth rescues a lineup when the players filling those remaining starting spots are projecting that far down the board. OtownSteveO collected the right names in the wrong order, and the scoreboard will not care how disciplined most of those picks looked on draft night.

StmtrooperThatHitsHisHead sits at the 57th percentile and seventh in the Star Wars Battlefront II division, which tells you everything about the knife's-edge nature of this season. The core is genuinely exciting: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in this field cannot match, and the Kyler Murray and Jefferson stack adds the kind of correlated upside that can swing a week by itself. The problem is that the margins cut both ways. Murray is a QB19 projection, meaning he works as a stack piece but leans on Jefferson to carry the relationship. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 was a real value at 3.12, a pick that quietly steadies the floor. The draft itself was mostly chalk, with the Brown reach at 2.01 standing out as a move that cost flexibility early. Nothing here screams contender, nothing screams also-ran. This is a team that goes as far as its best players stay healthy and its middling depth never has to be tested.

Gonk Droid didn't make a splash, they just made good decisions over and over, and that adds up. The crown jewel is De'Von Achane, projected RB6 and snagged more than a round past where he should have gone, a genuine major value in a draft where most managers were paying full price. Jonathan Taylor landed right at his number as an RB4, but pairing a player that good with Achane at a discount is how a roster quietly becomes formidable. Then there's Trevor Lawrence, projected QB10 and taken a full round late, slotting into a starting lineup that already features Drake Maye at QB2. The pattern holds all the way down the board: 16 chalk picks, three values, one steal, and zero reaches of any kind. That's not a team built around a single bold swing that either pays off or blows up. That's a team built on steady execution, round after round, and at 57th percentile in a competitive field, Gonk Droid has the foundation to climb.

OakRidgeOrks didn't win the draft with one flashy swing, they just kept cashing in small edges until the board told a story. The clearest example is CeeDee Lamb, a WR5 projection who somehow slid to 2.03 despite an ADP of 1.11, landing in OakRidge hands at a price that would have felt like a typo in most leagues. From there the pattern held: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Omarion Hampton at RB9, and Javonte Williams at RB17 give this roster a projected starting group that can carry a lineup on any given week. The minor reaches on Dallas Goedert and Fernando Mendoza were small concessions, not wounds, and the major reach on Michael Mayer is a footnote at a position where OakRidge already has Dalton Kincaid at TE11. The 2025 campaign came in at the 56th percentile, which is fine but not the ceiling here. A 67th-percentile projection suggests this roster is already an upgrade on that result, built not on luck but on a draft that consistently came out ahead.

Darth Jar Jar didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by repeatedly coming out ahead, pick after pick, round after round. Jalen Hurts landing at QB9 when his ADP sat nearly a full round earlier is the kind of quiet win that compounds over a season, and pairing him alongside Caleb Williams gives this team a starting quarterback situation that most managers would envy. At the other end of the field, Colston Loveland at TE3 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 form a top-end anchor that looks genuinely difficult to beat in any given week. The Pitts case is worth lingering on: after years of unfulfilled promise, he broke through as a top-five TE in 2025, and the quarterback situation in Atlanta, however it sorts out between Michael Penix and Tua Tagovailoa, seems unlikely to slow him down. A 69th percentile projection and a fourth-place divisional standing are the results of a draft built the right way, not on luck, just on discipline.

There was no single moment in this draft where bftgdrmil swung for the fences and connected. There was just round after round of quiet competence, and the cumulative effect is a roster that lands at the 80th percentile of the field. The foundation is a genuine stack: Joe Burrow at QB4 paired with Tee Higgins at WR19, two players who tend to make each other better. Around them, the manager layered Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and DeVonta Smith at WR14 at the top of the receiving group, then picked up Derrick Henry at RB12 a full round and a half after his ADP suggested he'd be gone. Michael Wilson at WR39 arrived similarly late. None of those are heist-level coups, but each one represents the draft moving in bftgdrmil's direction, and that pattern compounds. The one blemish is Keenan Allen, taken more than seven rounds ahead of his ADP, a puzzling overpay that cost real capital. Coming off a 22nd-percentile scoring season in 2025, this roster looks built to do considerably better.

The High Ground sits second in the Star Wars Battlefront II division and in the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This is a roster built with conviction and patience, six values scattered across the board with zero reaches anywhere on it. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the kind of foundational piece that makes the rest of the decisions easier, and the manager built outward from that anchor with discipline. Drake London fell to pick 2.10 despite projecting as WR7, Chris Olave slid a full round to land at 4.10 as WR11, and Chigoziem Okonkwo dropped nearly two rounds before The High Ground scooped him at 12.10. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew his board, trusted it, and refused to panic. The Jordan Love and Christian Watson stack adds a ceiling layer on top of what is already a deep, well-structured core. If there is a weakness here, someone is going to have to squint very hard to find it.

There are rosters built for balance, and then there is swf0780, a team that looked at the concept of spreading talent evenly across positions and laughed. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 give this roster two of the most dynamic quarterbacks in the field, and in a positionless format, that kind of elite duplication does not collect dust, it starts. Then come the running backs: Chase Brown at RB11, Jeremiyah Love at RB13, and Breece Hall at RB14, three projected starters stacked so close in the rankings they look like a verdict. Trey McBride at TE2 and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 anchor the tight end group with the same quiet menace. What makes it richer still is how the manager acquired it, with Brown, Love, Hall, and Daniels all falling past their ADP, each one a value taken by a drafter who simply stayed patient while others looked elsewhere. Division-best, 97th percentile in the field, swf0780 is not an argument about roster construction. It is the conclusion.
