There is no pretty way to say this: astud01 is sitting 12th in the Super Mario Galaxy division and in just the 18th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer an obvious path out. Drake Maye is the genuine bright spot, a QB2 projection coming off a season that nearly earned him an MVP, and the real-world addition of AJ Brown to New England's offense only sweetens the outlook there. But one elite quarterback can only do so much in a positionless format when the rest of the roster grades out as merely average across the board. Drake London checks in as a WR7, Breece Hall as an RB14, and those are the kinds of players you build around, not the kind that make you feel safe in a deep field. Perhaps most telling is the draft itself: no steals, no values, fourteen chalk picks and four minor reaches, a sheet that reads less like a strategy and more like a hope. Jayden Reed, the projected weakest starter at WR48, is the ceiling of that hope on any given week things go sideways.

Filt08 sits 11th in the Super Mario Galaxy division and in just the 28th percentile of the field, and the path back to relevance is genuinely hard to trace. The receiver corps has real names at the top, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and A.J. Brown at WR8 giving the roster a legitimate first tier, but Brown came at a price, taken 0.7 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 2.02, meaning Filt08 paid a small premium for a player the market already had priced high. That kind of draft left little margin for error elsewhere, and the errors showed up anyway: Elijah Sarratt, a WR98 projection, was taken 6.1 rounds before his ADP, a breathtaking overpay for a player who grades out near the bottom of usable receivers. Meanwhile the quarterback room leans on Brock Purdy and Kyler Murray, a QB13 and a QB19 respectively, which is fine, not great. This roster looks like a house built on a solid foundation with a leaky roof and no budget left for repairs.

There is no polite way to say this: data4thewinz is in trouble, and the draft did not make it better. The roster checks in at the 29th percentile of the field, good for tenth in the Super Mario Galaxy division, and the path back to relevance is genuinely hard to trace. The draft was defined less by what went right than by what went sideways, and two decisions loom largest. Michael Pittman, a WR44, was taken nearly three and a half rounds before his ADP suggested he would go, and Kenyon Sadiq, a TE21, came off the board more than two rounds early. In a format where every pick carries opportunity cost, those rounds bought players who grade out near the bottom of their positions among projected starters. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is a real asset and James Cook at RB5 is legitimate company, but when KC Concepcion projects as WR50 and grades as the weakest starter on the roster, the ceiling gets low fast. This team went 13-23 a year ago. Nothing in this draft suggests the math changes.

ryco1234 enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Super Mario Galaxy division and in just the 29th tournament percentile, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The backfield is genuinely strong, with Jonathan Taylor (RB4), Jeremiyah Love (RB13), and Josh Jacobs (RB16) all projected as starters, but the passers behind them are where the floor starts to crack. Baker Mayfield (QB18) is the top option at quarterback, and even being generous, that is a ceiling most contenders treat as a backup plan. The draft did not provide a way out either: 17 chalk picks and a major reach on Tyler Allgeier (RB46), pulled three-plus rounds ahead of his ADP, suggest a room that ran out of ideas before it ran out of picks. Last season's 13-23 record and 31st-percentile scoring are recent history, not ancient context, and nothing in this build signals a clean break from that trajectory. The running back depth is real, but in a positionless format, strong depth only matters when the top of the roster gives you something to lean on.

millerk87 sits eighth in the Super Mario Galaxy division and in the 31st percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much hope that things will turn around. The backfield is genuinely good, Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) headlining a group that stays useful deep into the roster, but the receiver corps thins out fast past Davante Adams (WR25) and Michael Wilson (WR39), and the draft did little to shore it up. Two major reaches defined the board: Travis Etienne was grabbed 1.7 rounds ahead of his ADP and Theo Johnson a full 3.1 rounds early, capital spent ahead of the market on players who are projected RB18 and TE37 respectively. That is not the asset allocation of a team building toward contention. Justin Herbert fell a round and a half into millerk87's lap, which is nice, but one genuine value does not fix a roster that grades out near the bottom and has no obvious lever left to pull heading into 2026.

Sitting seventh in the Super Mario Galaxy division and projecting out at just the 34th percentile of the field, aces424 is staring at a season with very little runway. The one genuine bright spot is the receiver group, where Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and Jameson Williams comes in at WR21, both propped up by usable stacks with Matthew Stafford and Jared Goff respectively. But beyond that top end, the roster thins out fast, and the draft board offers little comfort: three major reaches, including Stafford pulled nearly a round and a half early and Emeka Egbuka grabbed at WR18 before his ADP caught up, with zero steals to offset the overpayments. Brian Thomas Jr. lands at WR31 but brings real baggage, having followed a promising debut season with injuries and a shakier connection with Trevor Lawrence in 2025. That kind of uncertainty in a projected starter is exactly what a bottom-tier roster cannot afford to absorb. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, and the math is not being shy about saying so.

foxjared is the kind of team that wins 60 percent of its weeks and finishes one game out of a playoff spot, and that uncomfortable truth starts with the roster's push-pull dynamic. The top end is genuinely good: De'Von Achane at RB6 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 are the kind of projected starters that make opponents uncomfortable, and Derrick Henry at RB12 gives this team a second gear most rosters at the 37th percentile cannot claim. But the margins foxjared asked for come at a cost. Reaching two full rounds for Quinshon Judkins, currently projected RB22, is the draft's defining gamble, a bet that upside justifies the price when the going-rate alternatives were still on the board. The supporting cast, Patrick Mahomes projecting QB12 alongside Patrick Mahomes' backups and Chuba Hubbard sitting as the weakest projected starter at RB29, leaves precious little cushion when the injury ticker starts scrolling. Sixth in the Super Mario Galaxy division feels about right: not punching up, not falling behind, just threading a needle that requires everything to break correctly.

HeeroJay went into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft and repeatedly ignored the board, and the wild part is that it mostly worked. The two most glaring examples sit at opposite ends of the ledger: Jordan James, taken nearly eight full rounds before his ADP, and Jayden Daniels, who fell almost three rounds past his and landed in HeeroJay's lap as a genuine steal. Daniels projected at QB5 is a legitimate weapon in a positionless format, and pairing him with Lamar Jackson at QB3 gives this roster a ceiling that most managers in the Super Mario Galaxy division cannot match. The James gamble is the question mark, projected at RB67 and selected with the confidence of someone who had seen something the rest of the room had not. Maybe they had. HeeroJay posted a 90th-percentile scoring season in 2025, so there is a track record of conviction paying off. Whether the aggressive early selections on James and Christian McCaffrey anchor this roster or expose it is what makes HeeroJay one of the more genuinely interesting teams to watch this year.

confederate1987 didn't win the draft with one thunderclap pick. They won it the way compound interest works, five values sprinkled across the board, zero major reaches, and a lineup that quietly stacks up. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 falling into the second round is the headliner, but the supporting cast is what makes this roster hum: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give confederate1987 an elite edge at a position where most managers are settling, and Ladd McConkey, Carnell Tate, and Rome Odunze all project as starters behind Lamb. Tate is the wildcard worth watching, drafted fourth overall in the NFL Draft and now lined up in Tennessee alongside Cam Ward in a pairing that could pay out big for fantasy managers who trusted it early. The 2025 campaign was a forgettable 33rd percentile slog, but this roster looks structurally different. Fourth in the Super Mario Galaxy division and 63rd percentile tournament-wide are fair starting points for a team that drafted like it expected more.

There is no single moment where ccharles324 outsmarted the room, no audacious gamble that either defines or condemns this roster. What you find instead is a draft that simply kept winning the small exchanges, and those pile up. Trevor Lawrence falling more than two rounds past his ADP to the 7.01 pick is the clearest example: a QB10 projection acquired at a price that reflected none of it. Tyler Shough landing at 11.01 with similar surplus only reinforces the pattern. Meanwhile, the receiver group quietly assembled itself into something genuinely formidable, with George Pickens (WR10), Luther Burden (WR22), Jaylen Waddle (WR23), Christian Watson (WR28), and Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) all projecting as starters, with Harrison representing another round of value captured at a discount. The result is a team sitting third in the division and at the 76th percentile of the field, not because ccharles324 swung for fences, but because nearly every pick landed at or above its asking price, and that kind of quiet discipline compounds.

Swiftydou4s didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it with consistency, and the numbers back that up: three values against zero steals and just one major reach across the entire board. The foundation is a tight end group that reads like a fever dream, with Trey McBride (TE2), Kyle Pitts (TE7), and Sam LaPorta (TE8) all projecting as starters, and Pitts himself arriving as a good value after sliding a full round past his ADP. Omarion Hampton (RB9) was the one moment Swiftydou4s got a little eager, taken slightly ahead of schedule at RB9, but that is a mild sin when the player projects as a top-10 back. Chase Brown (RB11) arriving nearly a round late only softens the blow further. A 75 percent win rate and 85th-percentile scoring in 2025 is not a fluke profile, and a 77th-percentile projection heading into 2026 suggests this roster is exactly what it looks like: a team built to grind opponents down week after week.

CodyReutz didn't stumble into correlation, he built toward it with intention. The Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase stack is the obvious centerpiece, pairing a QB4 with a WR2, and the Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack beneath it functions almost as a mirror image, with Dart landing as a value after falling nearly two rounds past his ADP. When both stacks fire, the ceiling on this roster is genuinely difficult to calculate. The supporting cast reinforces the philosophy rather than diluting it: Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 give the lineup elite production at a position that routinely separates tournament contenders. The one thread worth watching is Wan'Dale Robinson, who moved to Tennessee and now competes for targets alongside a newly drafted receiver in an offense still finding its identity under Cam Ward. Robinson doesn't sink the roster, but he is the place where the correlation bet has the least backup. Division-leading and sitting at the 98th percentile, CodyReutz looks like a team that came to the Scott Fish Bowl with a plan, not a prayer.
