Despite getting exceptional value in drafting Mike Evans and Zay Flowers, questionable early picks and overvalued choices like Shedeur Sanders and

Tyreek Hill cast a long shadow over the team's strategy. As the season looms, tdmcclellan317 appears set for another year of struggles, trapped in a cycle of missed opportunities and strategic missteps that could make competing in any meaningful capacity a distant dream.

As the season unfolds, the Sheriffs must rally behind their strengths and compensate for their vulnerabilities to rise in the ranks.




