There is no polite way to say this: JonLuda is sitting 12th in the Outer Wilds division, projecting in the 19th percentile of the field, and the draft did not generate the kind of upside that typically rescues a team in that position. The roster logged zero steals and two major reaches, including Kyler Murray taken a full three rounds before his ADP. Murray does stack with Justin Jefferson, which is something, but Jefferson himself was a minor reach at 1.07, and a stack built on two players taken ahead of schedule is a foundation with cracks already in it. The headliners, Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Jefferson at WR6, are legitimately good, and Harold Fannin at TE6 was one of the few genuine bargains on the board. But the supporting cast grades out thin and the team's projected weakest starter is Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19, which tells you how quickly the quality falls off after the top names. JonLuda needed a bold draft to overcome a difficult situation and instead got a cautious one.

Gedaliah sits 11th in the Outer Wilds division and at the 31st percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The brightest light here is CeeDee Lamb, a projected WR5, and Tyler Warren grades out as a genuine TE4 asset, but those two peaks do not elevate a roster where the weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43 and the running back core tops out at David Montgomery (RB23) and D'Andre Swift (RB24). The draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over those limitations: zero steals, just two values, and six reaches across the board, including a major early commitment to Travis Hunter that placed him at WR62. The Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack is a legitimate plus, but Burrow himself was a minor reach taken before his ADP, and leaning on a stack to carry a roster this thin is less a strategy than a prayer. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and the schedule will not care.

There is something almost sad about 1stPickMikeVick's situation, because on paper the talent is genuinely there. Brock Bowers at TE1 is the kind of asset that wins leagues, and pairing him with Kenneth Walker III (RB10), Breece Hall (RB14), and Josh Jacobs (RB16) gives this roster a top-end concentration that most managers would envy. In a positionless format where you simply field your best players, that much quality stacked toward the top of the lineup is supposed to be the whole argument. And yet here sits 1stPickMikeVick, 10th in the Outer Wilds division and projected at just the 35th percentile of the field, which is the fantasy equivalent of bringing a magnificent feast and forgetting to book the venue. The draft tells you why: Dak Prescott came off the board a full round and a half before his ADP warranted, Malik Willis arrived two and a half rounds early, and neither QB projects as a starter. The elite core deserves better than the draft decisions surrounding it.

Bradk129 enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Outer Wilds division and projecting around the 40th percentile of the field, and the roster itself explains why optimism is hard to summon. The foundation is real: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, James Cook checks in at RB5, and both are projected starters. That backfield core is genuinely elite. The problem is that everything built around it feels one tier short. DeVonta Smith at WR14 and Travis Kelce at TE10 are solid contributors, but Justin Herbert grades as a QB8, and the projected starter alongside Kelce at tight end is Juwan Johnson at TE20, a name that does not inspire confidence at the back end of a starting lineup. The draft process did not help matters: Bradk129 logged zero steals, accumulated five minor reaches and one major reach in Calvin Ridley, taken nearly three rounds ahead of his ADP, and came away with only three modest values. When your best draft outcome is James Cook falling less than a round, the margin for error was already thin before the season kicks off.

sforrest14 enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting eighth in the Outer Wilds division and hovering right around the tournament median, which is a polite way of saying there is nothing here to get excited about. The roster's only genuine star power comes from Josh Allen and Jalen Hurts at the top, but reaching 1.2 rounds early on Hurts in round two means sforrest14 burned premium capital on a QB9 projection when that production could have addressed the thin middle of this lineup. George Pickens at WR10 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 are decent enough anchors, but the drop-off is steep, and the projected lineup bottoms out with Josh Downs as a WR46 starter, which is a tough ask in a field this competitive. The draft chart tells the rest of the story: sixteen chalk picks, zero steals, and a major reach as one of the two most memorable selections. That is not a draft that creates separation from the field, and with no obvious lever left to pull, sforrest14 looks destined to grind through a long, forgettable season.

Forstyle sits at the 50th percentile in the field and seventh in the Outer Wilds division, which is another way of saying the margin between a decent run and a forgettable one is razor thin. The core is legitimately good: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Drake London and A.J. Brown projecting as WR7 and WR8 give this roster a ceiling that most mid-table teams can't match. The problem is the edges. Rico Dowdle, the projected weakest starter, landed in Pittsburgh behind Jaylen Warren after Carolina moved on, and counting on a secondary role in that backfield for fantasy production is a real ask. The draft grades don't inspire much confidence either, with four major reaches including Jordan Love taken 2.1 rounds early and Jaylen Wright taken nearly six and a half rounds ahead of consensus. Forstyle isn't losing this season on talent at the top of the roster. It's losing, or winning, on whether those aggressive bets on the margins cash out.

BradenH6 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right, repeatedly. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchors the group, and the Drake Maye and Luther Burden stack gives this team a legitimate multiplier if things break the way the hype suggests they will. Burden is the interesting piece here. Ben Johnson is already drawing Amon-Ra St. Brown comparisons in camp, and after Burden averaged a 53% snap share down the stretch in 2025, pacing a 1,000-yard pace in that span, the faith feels earned rather than manufactured. Caleb Williams landing at QB6 when his ADP put him a full round earlier is the kind of quiet win that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones, and Carnell Tate falling a round past his ADP adds another projected starter at WR29 with upside. The Bryce Young reach stings on paper, but in a positionless format, the cost of a late-round flier matters less than the quality at the top, and this team's top is genuinely good. Sitting at the 56th percentile of the field, BradenH6 hasn't announced themselves. They've just quietly put together a team that belongs.

Jwinters99 did not win the draft on one flashy pick. The case for this roster is built on a pattern: again and again, the board came to them. Emeka Egbuka at WR18 slid nearly two rounds past his ADP, Rome Odunze at WR30 fell a round and a half, and Jake Ferguson at TE12 dropped a full round before Jwinters99 quietly claimed him. That is not luck, that is a manager who stayed disciplined and let the draft reward patience. The one genuine blemish is Bo Nix, reached nearly two rounds early to land the QB15, a price that feels steep when you already hold Jayden Daniels at QB5. Still, the foundation here is hard to dismiss: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Omarion Hampton checks in at RB9, and Daniels anchors the position at QB5. A 59th percentile tournament ranking and fifth in the Outer Wilds division feels like a floor more than a ceiling. This team is in the conversation, and it earned that standing pick by pick.

StillStorming didn't win the draft with one knockout pick. They won it by not losing. The receiver group alone makes a case: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Nico Collins sits at WR9, and Zay Flowers comes in at WR16, all projected starters, all acquired at or near their cost. That kind of sustained accuracy across the board is harder to pull off than it looks, and it shows up in the tournament percentile, which lands at 62nd, a meaningful jump from a 33rd-percentile scoring season in 2025. The Stafford-Nacua stack adds a correlation bonus on top of a receiver group that was already drawing good cards. Colston Loveland at TE3 is the kind of quietly decisive pick that separates competent rosters from good ones, and StillStorming got him right at his price. The C.J. Stroud reach in the sixth round is the one moment where the discipline slipped, but one reach on an otherwise steady sheet is a small price. Third in the Outer Wilds division is the current standing, and the roster suggests that number has room to move.

Newozza didn't win the draft on one massive swing, they won it on volume and positioning. The headliner is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a legitimate top-end anchor, but the real story is how cleanly the picks stacked behind him. Malik Nabers at WR12, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 were all taken near chalk, which sounds unremarkable until you realize that hitting your price on four projected starters in a row is how rosters actually get built. Terry McLaurin landing at WR24 after falling nearly a round and a half past his ADP gave Newozza a quiet surplus at a spot where most managers were paying full price. De'Von Achane at RB6 rounds out a top line that is legitimately difficult to argue with. The draft log shows three values, twelve chalk picks, and only one major reach, a profile that reads less like a gambler's card and more like a manager who knew exactly what things cost and refused to overpay. Coming off a rough 2025, this roster looks like a genuine correction.

tweeter7 didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a steady hand and the patience to let value come to them. The foundation is impossible to argue with: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this team a top-end that most managers would trade half their bench to match, and Barkley falling nearly a full round past his ADP means tweeter7 got him at a discount on top of it. D.J. Moore similarly slid 1.2 rounds before tweeter7 scooped him at WR26, and Alvin Kamara tumbled a full two rounds to land at 18.03. None of these are flash-in-the-pan gambles, just picks that repeatedly came out ahead of market. The one eyebrow-raiser is Tyler Shough, taken 2.5 rounds early at QB20, though the Shough and Chris Olave stack at least gives that investment a logical payoff structure. Sitting second in the Outer Wilds division at the 66th percentile, tweeter7 looks like a team that built a winner the quiet way, by simply being right more often than wrong.

jmb22699 didn't need a miracle pick to build a contender in the Outer Wilds, just a draft that kept winning the small battles. The foundation is legitimately elite: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 fell nearly a full round past his ADP at 2.05, Trey McBride checks in as TE2, and Patrick Mahomes stacks with Rashee Rice to give this roster a high-ceiling ceiling every week Mahomes is cooking. What separates this team from others near the 75th percentile is how that value compounded. Rashee Rice slid one and a half rounds to land at WR13, Bucky Irving and Javonte Williams each fell over a round to fill out the projected starters, and RJ Harvey dropped a full two rounds to become the kind of late-draft asset that wins close weeks. The one real cost of admission was Sam Darnold, taken nearly three rounds before the market agreed. But when your starting core includes St. Brown, McBride, Mahomes, and Rice, you can afford one detour. jmb22699 drafted like someone who did the homework and let everyone else make the mistakes.
