Last year DiegoFLopez went 28-8 and scored in the 85th percentile, the kind of season that earns you a reputation. This year's team is projected 5th percentile, dead last in the Overwatch division, and the distance between those two numbers is the whole story. The running back corps looks genuinely strong, with Chase Brown, Breece Hall, Kyren Williams, and D'Andre Swift all projecting as starters, but the receiver group is thin at the top, with D.J. Moore at WR26 as the only projected starter and nothing behind him that inspires confidence. The draft did not help much, producing zero steals and a major reach on Caleb Williams, taken nearly two rounds before his ADP. Oronde Gadsden was supposed to be a safe bet at tight end after finishing 11th in receiving yards last season, but the Chargers signed David Njoku in the offseason and that cloud has not fully lifted. DiegoFLopez is not rebuilding, exactly. This is more like watching a championship banner hang in a gym where the team has already graduated.

MrMarvel enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Overwatch division and in just the 28th percentile of the field, and the draft did little to improve the outlook. The top of the roster is genuinely appealing: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Christian McCaffrey at RB3 give this team a real foundation, and Justin Herbert at QB8 keeps the position from being a drag. But the drop-off is steep and the draft made it steeper. Four minor reaches and two major ones, with Tory Horton going four-plus rounds ahead of his WR93 projection and Jack Bech going nearly three rounds early to land at WR94, suggest a manager who kept gambling on upside at the back end and kept losing the hand. The team finished with zero steals on the board. When your ceiling players are carrying the weight and your late-round swings are trending toward triple digits, there is no obvious lever left to pull. Jefferson and McCaffrey will work hard. The math may not care.

There is no spin available for thefullwick, just a roster that reads like a draft-night cautionary tale and a division rank of 11 to confirm it. The worst of it is not even close: Keenan Allen, projected WR99, was taken more than ten rounds before his ADP, and Jalen Tolbert, projected WR102, nearly matched that waste at nearly nine rounds early. Those are not late-round gambles on upside, they are mid-draft commitments to players projected outside the top 100 at their position, slots where you are supposed to be building real depth. Instead, the useful parts of this roster, Drake London at WR7, Rashee Rice at WR13, Tyler Warren at TE4, arrived almost entirely at chalk prices, meaning thefullwick paid full freight for its wins and burned premium capital on its losses. The draft logged zero steals and zero values against three major reaches. Sitting at the 28th percentile of the field, this team is not unlucky or misunderstood. It is exactly what the draft board says it is.

Iowa Hammer drafted with patience and discipline, finishing with 15 chalk picks, one genuine value, and zero major reaches, which sounds like a clean sheet until you look at what all that efficiency actually produced. Josh Downs at WR46 is the projected weakest starter, and finding him a round after his ADP qualifies as the lone coup worth celebrating, which is a bleak sentence to write about a team sitting ninth in the Overwatch division. The QB room is genuinely strong, Joe Burrow at QB4 and Dak Prescott at QB7 giving the roster a ceiling that shows up in the projections. Trey McBride at TE2 and George Kittle at TE9 add another layer of upside. But Zay Flowers at WR16, Jaylen Waddle at WR23, and a collection of contributors behind them project only to middling outcomes when the whole is assembled, leaving Iowa Hammer stranded at the 48th percentile. They played the draft

correctly and landed somewhere forgettable anyway, which is not bad luck. It is just the quietest way a roster can fail.

punkchildp enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Overwatch division and right at the tournament median, which is a polite way of saying there is no margin for error and not much reason for optimism. The receiver group is the clearest drag on the roster. Davante Adams at WR25 is the headliner, and after him the depth falls off a cliff, with Stefon Diggs (WR56) and Calvin Ridley (WR78) eating up draft capital that the board did not justify. Diggs was taken 2.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, Ridley a painful 3.2 rounds early, and neither projection rewards that kind of faith. Patrick Mahomes and Matthew Stafford bring some stability at the top, and Bijan Robinson at RB2 is a genuine weapon, but when your weakest projected starter is Kyle Monangai at RB33, the floor is lower than you want it to be. A team that went 14-22 and scored at the 41st percentile last season needed an aggressive retool. This draft looks more like a shrug.

rudydelaney15 is the definition of a team that will be decided by inches. The backfield is legitimately dangerous, with Ashton Jeanty (RB7), Kenneth Walker III (RB10), and Travis Etienne (RB18) all projecting as starters, and that group alone can carry weeks where everything else goes sideways. The receiver corps is softer, topping out at Luther Burden (WR22) and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31), and Xavier Worthy projects as the weakest starter at WR49, the kind of weekly coin flip that separates 8-5 from 6-7. The draft tells a similar middle-of-the-road story: twelve chalk picks, one steal in Eli Stowers, and one genuinely puzzling reach in Kirk Cousins, taken 3.7 rounds ahead of his ADP. Cousins sitting at QB35 while Josh Allen anchors the top of the depth chart is the roster's most glaring tension. Allen is elite. What comes after him is a shrug. At the 51st percentile, rudydelaney15 does not need a miracle, just clean execution on the margins, which is exactly the hardest thing to guarantee.

Corosis didn't build this roster with a single headline move. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a lineup that sits at the 56th percentile in the field with real upside underneath that number. The foundation is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a projected starter who essentially asks nothing of the picks around him because he carries so much on his own. James Cook at RB5 arrived a half-round late relative to ADP, which is the kind of quiet efficiency that separates good drafts from average ones. Brock Purdy is the one place where Corosis reached, going more than two rounds early to land the QB13, but the stack with projected starter Mike Evans at WR27 gives that investment a secondary dividend. Sixteen chalk picks sounds boring until you realize chalk means the value was there and the manager didn't flinch. Jayden Reed at WR48 is the projected floor of the starting lineup, and floors that high don't happen by accident. This team belongs in the conversation.

dkeesy didn't build this roster with a single flashy move. They just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick, and the cumulative effect is a team that sits comfortably in the top half of the field at the 58th percentile. The foundation is obvious: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this team a top-end that most managers would envy, and Trevor Lawrence landing at QB10 a full round after his ADP is exactly the kind of quiet advantage that separates disciplined drafters from everyone else. Lawrence also stacks with St. Brown, giving dkeesy a built-in ceiling game whenever Detroit's offense clicks. Chris Olave at WR11 and Malik Nabers at WR12 add genuine depth behind the headliners, meaning the lineup can absorb bad weeks without a crisis. The 2025 résumé backs the optimism too: a 75-percent win rate and 92nd-percentile scoring aren't flukes. There's enough here to make noise in the Overwatch division.

Jack25521 lands at 66th percentile and fourth in the Overwatch Division on the back of a draft that quietly won more exchanges than it lost: one steal, three values, and twelve chalk picks against just four reaches of any significance. The headliner of that value column is Cam Ward, a QB23 projection snagged at pick 13.02 when his ADP sat nearly three rounds earlier, a find that shores up a quarterback group that reads thin on paper but costs this roster almost nothing in positional capital. Meanwhile, the receiver corps is the real engine here, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1, George Pickens at WR10, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 all penciled into the starting lineup. That is not luck, that is drafting with patience and conviction. The one blemish worth noting is Jacoby Brissett, a QB28 taken two and a half rounds ahead of schedule, but in a format this positionless, a late-round misjudgment on a backup quarterback barely registers. This team was built to compete.

Boito86 didn't need a headline move to build something real. The foundation is Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, two projected starters who would anchor any contender in this field. But the draft didn't stop there. Omarion Hampton comes in at RB9, Javonte Williams at RB17, and Cam Skattebo at RB20, giving Boito86 a depth of quality that lets the best performers rise to the top regardless of week-to-week volatility. Jalen Hurts projects as a QB9, quiet and efficient, exactly the kind of value that holds up over a long tournament run. The one genuine reach was Malachi Fields at WR90, pulled four-plus rounds early, but that's a late-round gamble on upside, not a draft-defining mistake. The softest spot in the projected lineup is Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47, now in Tennessee competing for targets after the Titans used a top-five pick on Carnell Tate, but Robinson crossed 1,000 yards last season and still carries real credibility. Third in the division and 69th percentile tournament-wide, Boito86 got here the unglamorous way, just consistently winning exchanges.

There was no single moment where m33m's draft turned into something special, just a steady accumulation of correct decisions that left the roster looking quietly formidable. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, as clean a first-round anchor as anyone in the field can claim, and the capital spent on Saquon Barkley at RB8 kept that strength compounding rather than diluting. Then came the steal that separates good drafts from great ones: Bucky Irving, projected RB21, fell two full rounds past his ADP to land at 9.03, which is the kind of market inefficiency that wins tournaments. The receiver group filled in without drama, Nico Collins at WR9, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Tee Higgins at WR19 forming a projected starting corps that would make other managers uncomfortable. Travis Kelce at TE10 rounds out a roster that never needed a single bold swing because it was consistently getting more than it paid for. Sitting second in the Overwatch division and at the 70th percentile of the field, m33m looks like exactly the kind of team that sneaks up on you.

DynastyLegZ didn't need a single flashy moment to build one of the Overwatch division's most compelling rosters. They just kept winning the small battles. The clearest example is Josh Jacobs, a projected RB16 taken nearly a round and a half after his ADP, a quiet pick that would barely register in a draft recap and yet represents exactly the kind of incremental edge that separates good managers from great ones. Pair that with the starter-laden skill group anchored by Brock Bowers at TE1 and A.J. Brown at WR8, and you have a team where the floor is genuinely high before the draft even gets interesting. The back end carries some risk, particularly with Brandon Aiyuk and Ted Hurst taken well ahead of their respective ADPs, but in a positionless format those late-round swings on upside are a feature, not a fault. DynastyLegZ finished 2025 at 70th percentile in scoring and enters

2026 sitting first in the division, which tells you this is not a team that got lucky. They drafted well, steadily, and it shows.
