ikenyon played the draft about as cleanly as the raw numbers suggest. Twelve chalk picks, a handful of genuine values, and almost nothing taken embarrassingly early. And yet here we are, staring at a team sitting in the bottom five percent of the field with a projected division rank of 12th. That is the cruelest math in fantasy football: doing the process right and still ending up here. Drake Maye and Jayden Daniels project as QB2 and QB5 respectively, which is genuinely excellent, but the value underneath those two dissolves quickly. Jeremiyah Love and Javonte Williams project as RB13 and RB17, serviceable but hardly anchors, and RJ Harvey is a projected RB28 on a Denver backfield that just added Jonah Coleman in the draft while Dobbins remains in the mix, which is not exactly a red carpet to carries. Tetairoa McMillan lands at WR15, but the drop to Rome Odunze at WR30 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 is steep enough to feel the altitude. ikenyon found value. The value just did not find wins.

Dashboard Burritos sits 11th in the Paper Boy division and projects in the bottom 10 percent of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The manager went to the well 20 times without pulling up a single steal or value, chalking 15 picks and reaching on five more. The most damaging of those, Jameson Williams at WR21, was taken nearly two rounds before the market agreed, and Keenan Allen, projected WR99, cost a pick more than five rounds ahead of his ADP. That is not aggressive drafting, that is paying a premium for uncertainty. Josh Allen is genuinely great, a QB1 who stacks with D.J. Moore to provide some floor, but even Allen cannot carry a lineup whose weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, and whose depth beyond the top names fades fast into the WR80s and WR90s. There is no obvious trade chip to flip, no late-round gem waiting to bloom, no lever left to pull. This roster is largely what it is, and what it is projects to finish near the bottom.

Sharp841 sits tenth in the Paper Boy division and in just the 13th percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The headliners are real: CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Tyler Warren (TE4) give this team a legitimate top-end anchor, and Nico Collins (WR9) is no afterthought. But the drop-off is steep and it arrives fast. Beyond that trio, the projected starters include Travis Etienne (RB18), Quinshon Judkins (RB22), and D'Andre Swift (RB24), a group that sounds serviceable until you remember that Judkins is coming off a fractured fibula and is only now reportedly on track for training camp, which makes RB22 feel more like a ceiling than a floor. The draft did not help matters: Bo Nix cost a pick that would have done more work elsewhere, and the board reveals zero steals against two major reaches. There is no cavalry on the way, no discarded gem sitting in a late round. Sharp841 has its stars and then it has hope, and hope does not start on Sundays.

Kobe2x sits ninth in the Paper Boy division and at the 33rd percentile of the field, and the draft chart does not offer much reason for optimism. The headliners are real: Lamar Jackson, Justin Jefferson, and Saquon Barkley are legitimate difference-makers, and the Lamar Jackson/Mark Andrews and Kyler Murray/Jefferson stacks give the roster some upside on the right week. But below that top tier, the floor drops off fast, and the projected weakest starter is Makai Lemon at WR40, which tells you something about how thin the margin for error is. The draft did nothing to buy back that cushion: fourteen chalk picks, zero steals, and a five-round reach on Tank Dell at WR74 that used an 11th-round pick on a player the market valued three rounds later. This roster is entirely dependent on its stars staying healthy and the stacks firing in unison. If Jackson or Jefferson misses time, there is no obvious fallback, no late-round heist to celebrate, and no lever left to pull. The stars have to be perfect, because everything else is wallpaper.

JTRELA20 enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Paper Boy division and at the 36th percentile of the field, and the roster gives little reason to expect a dramatic climb. The stars are real: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 form a legitimate top of the lineup, and Jalen Hurts at QB9 adds another credible anchor. But the draft that built this roster offers a cautionary tale. Hurts cost a second-round pick on a QB9, a full round before the market valued him. Daniel Jones, a QB25, was pulled two-plus rounds early. Those are not aggressive bets that paid off in hindsight; they are early-round equity burned at positions where the return rarely justifies it in a positionless format. Strip away Chase and Achane and the supporting cast grades out thin, with T.J. Hockenson projected as the weakest starter at TE23 and the depth beyond the top names offering little upside. The floor here is not catastrophic, but the ceiling has already been spent.

stephiesmall's sits at 49th percentile, and that number captures something honest about this roster: it is genuinely hard to pinpoint where the season goes sideways or suddenly catches fire. Trey McBride at TE2 is the clearest edge on the roster, a player who landed at pick 2.04 after his ADP sat at 1.08, which is the kind of gift that makes a draft feel smart in retrospect. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give the lineup legitimate upside at the top, but the ceiling conversation gets complicated fast. Cam Ward projects as QB23, and stephiesmall's reached nearly three rounds early to get there, which is a bet that still needs to pay off. Then there is Josh Jacobs, projected at RB16 and currently sitting inside an unresolved legal situation that clouds his availability entirely. On a team where margins decide everything, losing a projected RB16 before the season starts is not a small contingency. This is a roster that needs its assumptions to hold.

Killermick lands at 61st percentile in the field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: no flashy heists, just a consistent pattern of getting good players at fair or better prices. Four values across the roster add up quietly, and two of them hit at premium positions. Jordan Love, projected QB17, slipped a full round and a half past his ADP into Killermick's lap at 8.09. Isaiah Likely, projected TE13, fell nearly two rounds before getting scooped at 10.09, giving this roster a legitimate tight end alongside Colston Loveland at TE3. That top-end pairing at tight end, combined with a backfield anchored by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, means Killermick's projected starters are carrying real weight before the roster even gets to its depth. The one blemish is Elijah Arroyo, taken 7.3 rounds ahead of ADP, a reach that stands out precisely because everything else was so disciplined. Fifth in the Paper Boy division is a fair landing spot for a team built this steadily, and there is legitimate room to climb.

dropthemikeFF didn't light anything on fire in the draft, and that's exactly the point. The receiver group tells the story: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the roster, but the real work happened in the middle rounds, where A.J. Brown at WR8, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Rashee Rice at WR13 landed in succession, the kind of sequence that quietly tilts a roster toward contention. Davante Adams at WR25 fell a full round past his ADP and walked into the lineup, not because dropthemikeFF got lucky but because they were paying attention. Even Chuba Hubbard at RB29, the projected weakest starter, was sitting 1.7 rounds past his ADP when he got picked. The one blemish is Bryce Young at QB26, taken 2.2 rounds early, which stands out on an otherwise disciplined sheet. Sitting at 60th percentile in the field and sixth in the Paper Boy division, this team isn't screaming for attention yet, but the draft record suggests it probably should be.

NoGutsNoSausage didn't land here by accident. This is a roster built on discipline, the kind of draft where the manager repeatedly let the board come to them and collected value while others reached. The headliner is Brock Bowers, the TE1, who slid a few spots past his ADP at 1.11, a small discount on what projects to be the best tight end in the field. The real patience payoff, though, is Pat Freiermuth, a TE30 who fell more than three full rounds past his ADP before NoGutsNoSausage finally scooped him up at 18.02. Add Harold Fannin at TE6, Kyle Pitts at TE7, and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 to a projected starting group anchored by Joe Burrow at QB4, and you have a team sitting at the 65th percentile not because of any one marquee moment but because the whole draft pointed the same direction. Fourth in the Paper Boy division is the current projection, but the draft process suggests this team has the ceiling to move up.

UNCLEMAKS sits third in the Paper Boy division and in the 76th tournament percentile, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: disciplined, efficient, and almost completely free of regret. The foundation is Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Jonathan Taylor (RB4), two projected top-five running backs anchored into the lineup, with Taylor slipping just enough past his ADP to qualify as a genuine value. Then Chase Brown (RB11) fell a full two rounds past where he was supposed to go, and UNCLEMAKS was right there to collect. That is not luck, that is patience. The wide receiver corps adds DeVonta Smith (WR14), who finally gets to step out from behind AJ Brown's shadow in Philadelphia and prove he can carry a passing game as a true alpha, and Chris Olave (WR11) rounding out a starter group with real upside. One minor reach on Aaron Rodgers (QB29) is the lone blemish on an otherwise clean card. One reach. This roster was built with intention, and in the Scott Fish Bowl, that is most of the battle.

JaseAbbey lands at second in the Paper Boy division and the 88th percentile of the field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: this roster was built brick by brick, round by round, without a single swing that blew up. The receiver group alone makes the case. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 project as two of the best pass-catchers in the tournament, and Luther Burden at WR22 slots in as a genuine third option, not filler. Then consider that Caleb Williams, projected QB6, came off the board a full round after his ADP suggested he would, landing in JaseAbbey's lap while others passed. Williams stacks directly with Burden, meaning big Chicago days should pay twice. The one genuinely interesting gamble is Matthew Stafford, who at QB14 gives this team a legitimate backup after winning last season's MVP in what amounts to his farewell tour, the Rams having already drafted his successor. Seventeen chalk picks sounds boring until you look at what the chalk actually was.

Joel Harrity didn't win the draft with one bold swing, he won it by repeatedly landing players later than he should have. James Cook, a projected RB5, slid nearly a full round past his ADP before Harrity grabbed him at 3.02. Breece Hall and TreVeyon Henderson each fell nearly two rounds and both landed on this roster. The pattern holds into the middle rounds too, where Hunter Henry, projected TE18, sat unclaimed until pick 12.11 despite an ADP of 10.07. Stack those quiet wins together and you get a lineup that projects to the 94th percentile of the field and sits atop the Paper Boy division. The one real cost was Dak Prescott, taken nearly a round early at 2.11, but Prescott projects as a QB7 starter, so the premium was not outrageous. Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 doesn't hurt either. This is a roster built the way good drafts actually get built, not through luck or heroics, but through discipline compounding across eighteen rounds.
