There is no sugarcoating the math here. Tjefson sits 12th in the Paper Mario division and in just the 8th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much of an argument against either number. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is a genuine asset, and Drake London at WR7 gives this team a second pillar worth building around, but the supporting cast falls off quickly, and the draft offered no help, producing zero steals and zero values against 16 chalk selections and a major reach on Brock Purdy, taken nearly two full rounds ahead of his ADP. The one wrinkle worth watching is the Matthew Stafford and Davante Adams stack: Stafford won an MVP last season at 37, then watched the Rams draft his eventual replacement with the 13th overall pick, so he is pitching with a short clock and every incentive to make noise. If that stack catches fire, tjefson has something. If it does not, there is no obvious third lever to pull, and finishing near the bottom of the division looks less like a risk than a forecast.

Last year EWeinerFantasy went 34-2 and scored in the 99th percentile, which is the kind of season that earns a manager a reputation they will spend the next twelve months trying to live up to. The 2026 roster is not that team. Sitting 11th in the Paper Mario division and projected at the 31st percentile, the gap between last year's legend and this year's reality is already uncomfortable. The anchor pieces are real, Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Brock Bowers at TE1 give this team a genuine ceiling, but the connective tissue frays fast. The wide receiver group grades out as weak, and the projected starter at running back who gives the most pause is Rhamondre Stevenson, taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting as RB31. That is the kind of aggressive conviction that can look prescient or reckless depending on which direction Stevenson's season breaks. A roster with Jackson and Bowers should not be dismissed, but the distance between what this team was and what it is projected to be in 2026 is not a slump, it is a rebuild wearing last year's trophy as a name tag.

There is no kind way to frame the 2026 outlook for bandrews7 in the Paper Mario division: this roster sits 10th in the division and in just the 34th percentile of the field, and the draft did nothing to change those odds. Not a single steal, not a single value, three major reaches, and 17 chalk picks add up to a team that paid full price for mediocrity. The foundation is genuinely strong, Bijan Robinson at RB2, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 project as a legitimate core, but that floor collapses the moment you look up the lineup. The passing game support is thin enough to be alarming: Jameson Williams at WR21 is the only receiver projected to matter, and the quarterback situation reads like a cry for help, with Jared Goff at QB16 carrying the load while Daniel Jones at QB25 waits as the weakest projected starter on the roster. bandrews7 drafted a Cadillac engine and bolted it to a golf cart frame, and right now there is no obvious fix on the horizon.

tacanevari played a clean draft, which makes the disappointment almost philosophical. Fifteen picks at chalk, three genuine values, zero major reaches, and the roster still lands at 36th percentile and ninth in the Paper Mario division. The backfield looks like the engine room: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Derrick Henry at RB12, Josh Jacobs at RB16, all projected starters, all drafted at or near their price. But David Montgomery, the headlining value of the draft after falling a full round and a half past ADP, arrives in Houston with a murky path to carries after losing the Detroit timeshare and now pushing Woody Marks for the top job with the Texans. That is what happens when a value pick comes attached to a situation rather than a role. The receiver group grades out average, the tight end group is weak across the board, and Drake Maye has to carry the passing game almost alone given Baker Mayfield's QB18 projection and Shedeur Sanders sitting at QB32. The math was done carefully. It just did not math.

DFFC sits eighth in the Paper Mario division and in just the 39th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many obvious routes to a better outcome. The strength here is at tight end, where Colston Loveland (TE3), Tyler Warren (TE4), and Harold Fannin (TE6) are all projected starters, but the rest of the lineup asks a lot of players who project as fringe contributors. Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and DeVonta Smith (WR14) are genuine assets, yet the next projected starter after them is Jayden Higgins (WR54), which is a steep drop-off. At quarterback, Jordan Love's fantasy output has never matched his NFL reputation, he has never cracked 35 passing touchdowns in a season, and the supporting cast in Green Bay remains uncertain with Tucker Kraft recovering from injury. The draft offered no help either: not a single steal or value pick across the whole board, and a major reach on J.J. McCarthy (QB37) taken nearly five and a half rounds early. There is no cavalry coming.

AndrewHolva finished last season at the 91st percentile in scoring, so the bones are clearly there. But 2026 feels like a season that lives in the margins, and the margins are genuinely hard to read here. The top of the roster is real: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, A.J. Brown as WR8, and Jalen Hurts as QB9, giving the lineup a ceiling that most teams in the Paper Mario division cannot match. The problem is how Hurts got there. Taken at 2.11 against an ADP of 3.12, that reach cost AndrewHolva a round of value at a pivotal point in the draft, and the Dallas Goedert investment at 6.11 when his ADP sat at 9.03 compounds the same pattern. Meanwhile, Brian Thomas Jr. arrived as a genuine value at WR31, but his 2025 was defined by injuries and a murky connection with Trevor Lawrence that leaves his upside cloudier than his ranking suggests. This is a team with a plausible path to a division title and an equally plausible path to finishing right where it started: 54th percentile, wondering what went sideways.

Last year lewiswood finished in the first percentile in scoring, a genuinely staggering collapse that made 2026 feel less like a rebuild and more like the bare minimum would constitute progress. Progress has arrived. The headliners are CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6), a pair of projected starters who alone represent a higher ceiling than most of what lewiswood deployed all of last season. Patrick Mahomes (QB12) steadies the quarterback room, and while Tyler Shough (QB20) carries real questions at 27 years old, his stack with Chris Olave (WR11) gives lewiswood a legitimate secondary scoring engine if the Saints offense clicks. Chase Brown (RB11) and Kyle Pitts (TE7) round out a starting core that projects at 60th percentile in the field, good for sixth in the Paper Mario division. This roster was built almost entirely on chalk, which is fine when chalk looks like Lamb and Jefferson. A year after bottoming out, lewiswood is not just improved. It is legitimately dangerous.

Bishop111823372 didn't stumble into correlation, they built toward it. The architecture is clear: Josh Allen paired with Dalton Kincaid as one stack, Caleb Williams paired with both Luther Burden and Rome Odunze as another, meaning on any given week this roster can chain together multiple touchdowns from a single drive. That Williams-Burden connection is worth watching closely. Burden spent the first half of 2025 as a ghost, barely cracking 30 percent snaps through Week 9, then exploded in the back half at a pace that extrapolates to 1,000 yards, and now head coach Ben Johnson is openly comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown heading into camp. If Burden is finally the WR22 his hype suggests and Williams is dealing, this team lights up. That's the bet. The ceiling here is legitimately high, sitting at 62nd percentile in the field, but nearly every point of upside runs through whether those stacks fire together. When they do, Bishop111823372 looks like a contender. When they don't, the floor gets uncomfortable fast.

pabr didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't load up on upside plays that imploded at the seams. This roster was built the old-fashioned way: pick by pick, each one landing right about where it should or better. The anchor of it all is the tight end group, where Trey McBride (TE2), Sam LaPorta (TE8), and Jake Ferguson (TE12) give this team a level of reliability at the position that most managers can only dream about on draft day. At the top of the receiver room, George Pickens (WR10) slid three-quarters of a round past his ADP, a quiet win that adds up when you're building through consistency rather than chaos. The Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack gives the team a bonus connection with real upside baked in. Coming off a 75th-percentile scoring season in 2025 and currently sitting 63rd percentile in the field, pabr looks like exactly what the draft suggests: a team that doesn't need a lucky bounce to be dangerous, because it already did the work.

Leppy171 finished 24-12 last season and sits third in the Paper Mario division entering 2026, and neither number feels like a fluke when you look at how this roster was built. The draft was not built on one moonshot pick that either saves the season or sinks it. Instead, Leppy171 found Kyren Williams at RB15 a full round and a half after his ADP suggested he would be gone, then turned around and landed Quinshon Judkins at RB22 under nearly identical circumstances. Both players project as starters, and both were acquired at a discount. That kind of consistency compounds. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the whole operation, and Dak Prescott at QB7 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 give the lineup reliable production at positions where the field often struggles to find it. The one genuine question is depth at receiver, where Josh Downs projects as the WR46 and third starter. That is not a fatal flaw in a positionless format, but it is the lever Leppy171 will need to pull correctly when the schedule gets tight.

JTeck didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. The team won it by accumulating small edges across almost every round. The receiver group is where that discipline shows most clearly: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9 give this roster a top-end foundation that most managers in the Paper Mario division can't match, and Jaylen Waddle (WR23), Carnell Tate (WR29), and D.J. Moore (WR26) keep the quality from falling off a cliff once you get past the headliners. Then there's the back half of the draft, where JTeck picked up RJ Harvey (RB28), Rico Dowdle (RB32), and Rachaad White (RB39) at a collective discount, each slipping roughly a round past their ADP. None of those is a world-beater in isolation, but taken together they represent exactly the kind of low-cost depth that quietly separates good teams from great ones. The one real blemish is a reach on Elijah Sarratt nearly five rounds early, but that's a late-round gamble, not a defining mistake. Landing at 68th percentile in the field and second in the division, JTeck drafted a team that earns its record, not one that hopes for it.

Last year, jimmer5 finished in the 9th percentile in scoring with a 6-30 record, a number so bleak it barely needs commentary. The 2026 roster looks like a genuine correction. The backfield alone tells the story: James Cook at RB5 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team two of the best players at the position in the entire field, and both came to jimmer5 at slight discounts relative to ADP. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the receiving corps and represents the kind of top-end talent that simply was not on last year's team. Altogether, five players on this roster were drafted as values, and not a single major reach appears on the sheet, which means jimmer5 built this thing without overextending. The weakest projected starter is Quentin Johnston at WR41, which is a real limitation at the margins but not enough to undermine what the top of this roster can do. Division-leading projections and an 87th-

percentile tournament ranking say the floor has been raised dramatically. The rebound is not a hope, it is a reasonable expectation.
