As the 2025 fantasy football season approaches, guers find themselves facing an uphill battle, weighed down by a roster that struggles to inspire confidence. Young, at the helm of one of the tournament's younger squads, raises questions with his inconsistency and inexperience. Despite youth being on their side with an average starter age of just 24.7, this hasn't translated into a competitive edge. Their wide receiver trio, while holding some promise, ranks only eighth in their division; Ladd McConkey, Rashee Rice, and Jaylen Waddle face a tough test against superior lineups. In terms of draft value, there were a few strategic wins: Rashod Bateman was snagged slightly later than expected, while Jake Ferguson also represented a minor triumph. However, these small victories are overshadowed by early reaches on Ashton Jeanty, Ladd McConkey, and others, which drained

potential value from the roster. Notably, the decision to draft Tua Tagovailoa and T.J. Hockenson well ahead of their projected positions could prove costly, leaving guers ranked dead last in their division and languishing in the bottom percentile overall. As the season unfolds, guers must hope that youthful energy and unexpected breakout performances can salvage what currently appears to be a daunting campaign.

the shadow of last year's moderate success seems like a distant memory, casting doubt on their ability to climb the ranks and reclaim a more respectable position.
