There is no sugarcoating what pman555 is working with heading into 2026. Sitting 12th in the Mewtwo division and projecting in just the 16th percentile of the field, the roster simply lacks the firepower to climb out of the basement without something going very right. The top end is real enough: Lamar Jackson grades out as a QB3 and De'Von Achane as an RB6, and a healthy season from either keeps the lights on. But the trouble starts fast when you scroll past those names. The receiver group is a graveyard, with projected starters Jordan Addison at WR43 and Michael Pittman at WR44 representing the kind of depth-chart cameos that haunt weekly lineups. The draft offered no relief, producing zero steals and zero values against 14 chalk selections and a major reach on Tyquan Thornton, a WR97 taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP. Last season's 33rd-percentile scoring finish was not a fluke. Unless Achane and Jackson carry this thing on their backs all year, pman555 is picking a draft lottery spot, not a playoff seed.

TwoMews, One Bowl walked into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a real asset in Justin Jefferson (WR6), a player whose dynasty managers are cautiously optimistic about after a rough 2025 that probably had more to do with JJ McCarthy than Jefferson himself, and the manager built an impressive receiving corps around him, adding Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Chris Olave (WR11), and Zay Flowers (WR16) as projected starters. The problem is that fantasy football eventually demands someone throw the ball, and this team's answer is Cam Ward at QB23, a projection that ranks near the bottom of viable starters across the field. Ward was actually a good-value pick, falling more than a round past his ADP, so the manager did not overpay, but a bargain on a struggling asset is still a struggling asset. Sitting 11th in the Mewtwo division and in just the 17th percentile of the tournament, this roster reads like a beautifully decorated cake baked without sugar: the presentation is there, the substance is not.

SilverBullets drafted like a manager who panicked early and never recovered. The clearest indictment is the quarterback situation: Bo Nix (QB15) and Daniel Jones (QB25) were technically values on paper, both falling past their ADPs, but landing two quarterbacks ranked QB15 and QB25 while burning picks to get there is the kind of math that looks clever in a vacuum and damning in context. The reach problem is worse. Four major reaches across the roster, including Kyren Williams (RB15) taken nearly two full rounds early and Khalil Shakir (WR51) yanked off the board before anyone else wanted him, suggests a manager who fell in love with players and refused to wait. The one legitimate anchor, CeeDee Lamb (WR5), arrived as a modest value at pick 2.03, but Rashee Rice (WR13), the player penciled in alongside him to carry this roster, brings legal troubles, a knee procedure, and a concussion history that makes his WR13 projection feel more like a wishlist item than a projection. Eighteenth percentile in the field. It fits.

FLSteve did almost everything right in the draft and still ended up at 37th percentile, which is the fantasy equivalent of following a recipe exactly and somehow burning the kitchen down. The value column is real: Quinshon Judkins at RB22 came nearly two rounds after his ADP, and both Bryce Young and Brian Robinson slid three-plus rounds into waiting hands. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 anchor a genuinely strong core. The problem is what surrounds them. The receiver group projects weak, with Davante Adams at WR25 and D.J. Moore at WR26 as the top options and Jakobi Meyers at WR45 as the projected fourth starter, and Mark Andrews checking in at TE14 is average positional value, not a difference-maker. FLSteve drafted patiently, avoided reaches almost entirely, and still assembled a roster that sits ninth in the Mewtwo division. The value was there. The ceiling, apparently, was not.

Ardot26 finished last season at 67th percentile in scoring and somehow managed to slip to 41st percentile heading into 2026, which is a rough trajectory for anyone hoping to contend in the Mewtwo division. The draft did not help matters. Of 20 picks, three qualified as major reaches, and two of those landed on late-round fliers in Ja'Kobi Lane (WR89) and Chris Brazzell II (WR101), players so far down the depth chart that burning early capital on them borders on roster malpractice. The top end is not without promise, Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3 and Kenneth Walker III slots in at RB10, but Walker cost Ardot26 nearly a full round of overpay at pick 2.08, and the roster grades out eighth in the division, meaning the upside ceiling is already baked in and it is not high enough. Patrick Mahomes fell a round past his ADP and represents the clearest draft win here, but one bargain does not paper over a construction process that leaned on optimism where it needed precision.

WillieBobSteve enters 2026 looking like a team that drafted with confidence and landed somewhere around mediocre anyway. The receiver group is the clearest drag on the ceiling, with Luther Burden (WR22) as the only projected starter at the position and Tank Dell (WR74), Jaylin Noel (WR83), and Elic Ayomanor (WR95) rounding out a group that grades weak by tournament standards. That receiver weakness matters more because the draft itself didn't help, with three major reaches including Kaelon Black (RB71) taken a staggering 8.1 rounds early and Kimani Vidal (RB60) pulled four rounds before his ADP, both of whom now sit near the bottom of the depth chart. Brock Purdy (QB13) was a legitimate value at 8.02, and the top of the backfield with Jonathan Taylor (RB4) and James Cook (RB5) is genuinely strong, but the floor beneath those names drops off fast. At 43rd percentile and seventh in the Mewtwo division, WillieBobSteve is the kind of team that looks fine until you start counting what's actually going on the field.

simplematt25 sits at 54th percentile and sixth in the Mewtwo Division, which tells you everything you need to know: this is a team built to compete, not to dominate. The foundation is legitimate, Josh Allen at QB1 and a tight end room headlined by Harold Fannin (TE6) and Kyle Pitts (TE7) gives simplematt25 a ceiling most managers in this field would envy. The margins, though, cut both ways. Rhamondre Stevenson was taken nearly two and a half rounds ahead of his ADP, landing at RB31, and Mike Washington Jr. was reached on by over four rounds to come in at RB59, which means two roster spots carry more optimism than projection. On the other side, Drake Maye fell nearly a full round past his ADP and slots in as QB2, a genuine bargain that quietly deepens the top of this lineup. The 2025 ledger, a 64 percent win rate and 73rd percentile scoring, suggests simplematt25 knows how to turn a decent roster into wins. Whether the receiver group, with Quentin Johnston (WR41) as the projected top option, can hold up long enough to let Allen and Fannin carry the day is the question this season answers.

Sippy didn't splash on one marquee move and coast. This roster was assembled pick by pick, with value accumulating quietly across the board. The RB group is where that discipline shows most clearly: Bijan Robinson checks in as RB2, and behind him sit Javonte Williams (RB17), Bhayshul Tuten (RB25), and Tony Pollard (RB30), all drafted at or past their ADP. That is not luck, that is a manager who understood where the market was soft and exploited it. Trevor Lawrence (QB10) anchors the passing game and carries genuine upside after a career year that included nearly 30 passing scores and a career-high 9 rushing touchdowns, even if the supporting cast around him in Jacksonville remains genuinely difficult to read. Lawrence being a QB10 projection despite that surrounding fog is exactly the kind of quietly favorable situation that tends to reward patient managers. Add A.J. Brown (WR8) and Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) at the top of the receiver group and sippy has real firepower to match the depth. A 56th-percentile projection undersells what this roster is capable of delivering.

nurseandy enters 2026 not with a single flashy cornerstone but with a draft that quietly won round after round. The foundation is real: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Caleb Williams sits at QB6, and Nico Collins checks in at WR9, a trio that gives this roster a legitimate ceiling before you even get to the depth. What makes the draft grade climb, though, is how nurseandy kept finding value in the middle and late rounds. Justin Herbert fell a full round past his ADP before landing here at QB8, Rachaad White slipped even further, and C.J. Stroud arrived at QB22 as a near-free dart in round ten. There were a handful of minor reaches scattered through the back half, but paying slightly early for players you actually want beats watching them disappear to the next team. The result is a roster sitting at 58th percentile tournament-wide with a 2025 track record of 68th percentile scoring to back up the optimism. This is what a clean, disciplined draft looks like.

dynastyinfidel enters 2026 sitting third in the Mewtwo division and 59th percentile overall, which undersells what this roster actually is. The foundation is built on Puka Nacua, a WR1 projection who comes stacked with Matthew Stafford, and George Pickens right behind him at WR10. Those two alone would anchor most competitive rosters, but then you add Tee Higgins at WR19 and Colston Loveland at TE3 and you start to see a manager who was picking with intention from the jump. The draft discipline shows in the margins too: Jadarian Price came a full round late at RB26, Dalton Schultz fell past his number at TE22, and Aaron Rodgers slid nearly three rounds before dynastyinfidel scooped him at QB29. The one blemish is Cooper Kupp, grabbed more than four rounds ahead of schedule, but one aggressive swing on a name player does not define a board this clean. When the chalk is sound and the value is real, you do not need to manufacture an argument. The roster makes it for you.

skmoney didn't stumble into the best stack in the field, they built their whole roster around it. Joe Burrow at QB4 feeding Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the kind of pairing that turns a good week into a great one, and skmoney made sure it was the foundation rather than a late-round bonus. Burrow fell to 2.10 against a 2.05 ADP, a modest gift, but the real point is that the stack exists at all in a format where plenty of managers treat quarterback-receiver correlation as an afterthought. The ceiling on this roster is genuinely high because when Burrow and Chase are humming, the rest of the lineup, anchored by Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and DeVonta Smith at WR14, doesn't need to carry an outsized load. A 92nd percentile tournament ranking and a 75 percent win rate in 2025 suggest the process here is sound. The plan is legible: stack hits, roster wins. The question for 2026 is simply whether Cincinnati cooperates.

DaddyMarino didn't win the draft with one big moment. They won it with the kind of quiet, compounding execution that only shows up when you add everything together. The receiver corps is the clearest evidence: Drake London at WR7, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 are all projected starters, and the depth behind them keeps the floor high even when the injury gods get bored and start causing trouble. What elevates the whole construction, though, is how efficiently DaddyMarino got there. Jaxson Dart fell more than two full rounds past his ADP and landed as a projected QB11, and the Dart-Nabers stack adds a multiplier that will win weeks. Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 as projected starters make the position a genuine weapon rather than an afterthought. The 2025 campaign was a 33rd-percentile disappointment, but this roster sits first in the Mewtwo Division and in the 93rd percentile of the field. DaddyMarino didn't overhaul anything. They just drafted better, pick after pick, until the gap was too wide to ignore.
