There is no sugarcoating what the numbers say about LouTesta in 2026: this roster sits at the bottom of the Pikachu division and grades into the 13th percentile of the entire field, and nothing in the draft history suggests a hidden edge waiting to surface. The top of the roster is genuinely appealing, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Nico Collins at WR9 give the team a legitimate one-two punch, but Collins cost a second-round pick on a player whose ADP was nearly a full round later, and that kind of draft premium ripples downward. With zero steals and zero values across the entire draft, LouTesta leaned on chalk and still sprinkled in six reaches, including Germie Bernard taken nearly three rounds early at WR79 and Cooper Kupp drafted ahead of schedule at WR88. When your projected weakest starter is Jayden Reed at WR48 and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 is doing most of the heavy lifting at quarterback, the ceiling is capped and the floor is uncomfortably low. The lever does not exist.

TheRealJForest is sitting at 11th in the Pikachu division and the 23rd percentile of the field, and the roster doesn't offer much reason for optimism about either of those numbers improving. The bones of this team are genuinely decent, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give you a pair of legitimate difference-makers, and the Caleb Williams/Loveland stack adds a little connective tissue. But the receiving corps is where this thing quietly falls apart. Projected starters D.J. Moore at WR26 and Courtland Sutton at WR37 are fine players managing the back half of their careers, and nothing behind them changes the math. After a 2025 campaign that landed in the 7th percentile in scoring, TheRealJForest needed a draft that injected upside, and instead got one built almost entirely on chalk with a major reach on Bucky Irving that cost 2.3 rounds of draft capital. The Robinson and Loveland peaks are real, but peaks aren't enough when the surrounding cast grades out this thin.

Jeremy_D is not hedging his bets here, he is doubling down on them. The entire ceiling of this roster runs through two stacks: Josh Allen paired with Dalton Kincaid, and Lamar Jackson paired with Zay Flowers. When those connections fire together, this team can genuinely compete with anyone in the field. The problem is that "when" is doing a lot of heavy lifting. Kincaid has spent the better part of two seasons being productive in the windows he is actually healthy, and Bills GM Brandon Beane's "too early to tell" on that knee is not exactly the ringing endorsement a stack-dependent roster needs. If Kincaid is limited or missing, the Allen stack loses its teeth, and suddenly this team is leaning entirely on Flowers and Jackson to carry the correlated vision. That is a lot of pressure on one pairing. A 26th-percentile tournament ranking and 10th in the division suggest the projections are skeptical too, and with 15 chalk picks and one major reach on LaPorta, there is no draft surplus to bail anyone out if the stacks go cold.

There is no polite way to say this: drewheigl is staring down a long season in the Pikachu division, currently ranked ninth and projecting in just the 27th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The foundation is not without merit, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is a genuine anchor, and a Dak Prescott and George Pickens stack gives the team a live ceiling on any given week. But the problems start almost immediately after those names. Isaiah Likely, pulled two full rounds ahead of his ADP, grades out as a TE13, a reach that only pays off if things break right. Meanwhile, Wan'Dale Robinson projects as the weakest starter on the roster at WR47, and Dontayvion Wicks was taken four and a half rounds early only to project at WR96. A team that posted a 36 percent win rate and finished in the 24th percentile in scoring a year ago needed upgrades everywhere. Instead, drewheigl drafted twelve chalk picks and two major reaches, which is less a rebuild than a continuation of the same slow slide.

Mutant League Football enters 2026 ranked eighth in the Pikachu Division and sitting in the 28th percentile of the field, and the roster grades out in a way that makes optimism feel like a stretch. The receiver room is genuinely good, Drake London (WR7), DeVonta Smith (WR14), Tee Higgins (WR19), and Davante Adams (WR25) forming a projected-starter group that most managers would envy, and Trey McBride (TE2) is an elite anchor at his position. The problem is that the rest of the roster undercuts all of that. Jaxson Dart (QB11) and Tyler Shough (QB20) offer passable production at the position, but the backfield runs thin in a hurry, with J.K. Dobbins projected as the weakest starter at RB36 and Rhamondre Stevenson checking in at RB31. The draft offered no steals and produced only two values, so there is no wave of late-round upside quietly waiting to break. This roster has a clear ceiling and a very visible floor, and right now those two lines are uncomfortably close together.

JKimmel1 enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Pikachu Division and at just the 38th tournament percentile, and the roster doesn't offer much reason for optimism. The top end is real, CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Jonathan Taylor (RB4) are legitimate difference-makers, but the supporting cast grades out thin fast. Last season's 28 percent win rate and 19th-percentile scoring weren't flukes, they were a diagnosis. The draft didn't do much to change the prognosis: 15 chalk picks, one major reach in Ja'Kobi Lane (WR89) taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, and zero steals across the entire board. When your best draft-day move is getting Luther Burden (WR22) one round late, you didn't move the needle. Chigoziem Okonkwo (TE19) projects as the weakest starter on the roster, and leaning on him as a contributor speaks to how quickly the depth drops off. Lamb and Taylor can keep this team competitive in any given week, but week-to-week survival isn't the same as building a tournament run.

MurphDawg56 is a 45th-percentile team wearing a 45th-percentile expression, and in the Scott Fish Bowl that is either fine or fatal depending on which version of this roster shows up. The floor here is real: James Cook at RB5, Jeremiyah Love at RB13, and Breece Hall at RB14 give this team a backfield core that can carry a bad week without flinching. Justin Jefferson at WR6 is the kind of anchor that makes a middling team dangerous on the right afternoon. The problem is the margins, and the margins are shaky. Darnell Mooney, taken nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP and projected WR82, is the kind of reach that costs you in a tight division race, and KC Concepcion at WR50 projects as the weakest projected starter on a team that cannot afford weakness at the edges. A 13-23 record in 2025 says MurphDawg56 already knows what close-but-not-quite feels like. The top end justifies optimism. The bottom end keeps the floor uncomfortably close to the ceiling.

drewdelaware walked out of the Scott Fish Bowl draft looking like someone who colored outside the lines on purpose, and the finished picture is surprisingly clean. The board shows three major reaches, and two of them are easy to wave away as late-round swings on Dylan Sampson and Chris Brazzell II. The one that actually matters is Tyler Warren, snagged at pick 2.06 against an ADP of 3.04, which means drewdelaware decided a TE4 was worth a full round of opportunity cost before most managers had even settled into their chairs. Pair Warren with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10, both legitimate cornerstones, and the conviction starts to look less like gambling and more like a plan. The supporting cast has real range too, from Jameson Williams at WR21 down to speculative pieces like Sampson. Last season's 69 percent win rate and 64th-percentile scoring say this manager knows how to build, and the 2026 version of this roster gives them every reason to improve on both numbers.

vansh92 didn't swing for the fences and miss, or load up on one shiny position at the expense of everything else. This roster was built pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team that quietly sits at 66th percentile in the field. The foundation starts at the top: Drake Maye landing at QB2 when his ADP had him going a half-round earlier is the kind of minor fortune that compounds over a season, and pairing him with Jayden Daniels at QB5 means vansh92 is fielding two legitimate difference-makers under center. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 was a minor reach at 1.05, but reaching for a player projected RB3 overall is the kind of sin most managers would happily commit. Jake Ferguson falling a full round past his ADP to land as a TE12 starter is exactly the low-drama, high-return transaction that defines this draft. Three values, fifteen chalk, and a roster that starts McCaffrey and Maye: fourth in the Pikachu Division feels like a temporary address.

There are flashy drafts built on lottery tickets, and then there is what kLest did in 2026, which is quieter and ultimately more dangerous. The foundation is a tight end group that would make any manager in the Pikachu division envious: Brock Bowers at TE1, Tucker Kraft at TE5, and Harold Fannin at TE6 are all projected starters, and Mark Andrews at TE14 and Brenton Strange at TE17 sit behind them. That kind of sustained quality does not happen by accident. Layer in De'Von Achane at RB6 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 as projected starters and kLest has assembled a core that consistently projects ahead of the field rather than hoping one big swing connects. The draft itself reflects the same philosophy, fourteen chalk picks against zero major reaches, with Brock Purdy landing a full round past his ADP as the one genuine value. The result is a roster sitting 82nd percentile in the tournament and third in the division, a team that did not beat the room with boldness so much as it simply refused to lose the draft.

Chris2333 has built something genuinely dangerous in the Pikachu division, and the architecture is unmistakable: Joe Burrow to Ja'Marr Chase, stacked and loaded as the engine of the entire enterprise. Burrow projects as QB4 and Chase as WR2, and when that pairing runs hot, this roster does not just win, it detonates. The wrinkle is Rashee Rice, taken at 2.12 in a move that looked aggressive against his ADP of 4.02, and the concern is real. Rice is dealing with a knee procedure that sidelines him into the summer, a probation violation that will cost him time, and a recent history of concussion complications that cut his 2025 season short. If Rice is available and healthy, he is a difference-maker who elevates this roster's ceiling from impressive to terrifying. If he is not, chris2333 is leaning on that Burrow-Chase connection harder than ever, which is either a statement of faith or a

liability depending on which Sunday you ask. This is a team built to peak, and the peak is spectacular, but the floor is entirely contingent on whether the stack delivers.

whalesvag1na sits atop the Pikachu Division and in the 98th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This manager did not force picks or chase names, they simply waited and let the board come to them. Omarion Hampton landing at 4.07 against a 3.03 ADP is the kind of patience that separates disciplined drafters from everyone else, and pairing an RB9 steal with Puka Nacua at WR1 in the first round sets a tone the rest of the roster only reinforces. Travis Kelce slipped to a TE10 price tag at 8.07, Jakobi Meyers fell more than two full rounds, and the team finished with zero reaches across 20 picks. The one legitimate cloud hanging over this roster is the off-field situation involving Josh Jacobs, whose production has been excellent but whose status carries real uncertainty until more details surface. Even so, Saquon Barkley at RB8 and A.J. Brown at WR8 anchor a starting group with very little to apologize for. Clean draft, clean roster, clean division lead.
