bbqbandit sits 12th in the Tony Hawks Underground division and in the 14th percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly how it happened. The reach count is the story here: four major reaches, six minor reaches, zero steals, and a single value pick across the entire board, a draft sheet that reads less like a strategy and more like a series of panicked decisions made before the room got there. The most damaging of those panics was Kyle Monangai, taken at 8.12 against an ADP of 12.01, a 3.1-round overreach for an RB33 that cost bbqbandit three rounds of potential value at a position in the back half of the board. Travis Etienne, reached 1.6 rounds early at pick 4.12, is a fine player at RB18, but drafting him there meant compressing every subsequent decision. The consequence shows up at receiver, where the projected starting lineup bottoms out at Matthew Golden, a WR52 who represents the ceiling of what late-round desperation could recover. There is no charitable read available here, and bbqbandit did not find one.

Down With Gesickness sits 11th in the Tony Hawks Underground division and in the 15th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly how it got there: four major reaches against a single steal, which was C.J. Stroud falling into their lap at 12.09 despite an ADP of 9.08 and a QB22 projection that does not make him a difference-maker anyway. The team name is doing the most interesting work here, because Mike Gesicki checking in at TE33 and taken nearly two rounds early is less a homage than an autopsy. Drake Maye at QB2 is the real asset, and the stack with A.J. Brown has genuine upside, Brown having proven he can be a first option in a competent passing game even if durability questions have followed him throughout his career. But Maye was reached on at 1.04 versus a 2.02 ADP, and when your best argument for the roster is that you overpaid for a good player and got lucky on one late faller, the charitable read has already left the building.

There is no gentle way to say this: GhengisKvam is staring up at the rest of the Tony Hawks Underground division from the basement, sitting at 10th in the division and the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer an obvious escape route. The receiving corps is the clearest anchor dragging this team down, with Christian Watson projected WR28 and Rome Odunze at WR30 leading a group that falls off a cliff quickly, bottoming out at Jakobi Meyers as the projected weakest starter at WR45. Kvam had the draft capital to shore things up but spent it poorly, reaching five rounds early on Elic Ayomanor (WR95) and over five rounds early on Carson Beck (QB40), assets that grade out near the fringes of usefulness. Jonathan Taylor and Derrick Henry give the team a legitimate foundation, but in a positionless format where everyone is surfacing their best players, a strong backfield core without complementary firepower elsewhere is like showing up to a knife fight with a very nice knife and nothing else.

ChizzyDaBoss994 played a patient, disciplined draft, landing Jordan Love as a major value at 9.07 and Omar Cooper Jr. two rounds after his ADP, and yet here we are, staring at a roster sitting in 9th place in the Tony Hawks Underground division and the 23rd percentile of the field. That is the particular cruelty of this build: the process was sound and the outcome is still bleak. The problem is not careless spending, it is misdirected spending. Rounds three through six were committed to Tucker Kraft, Kyle Pitts, and Dalton Kincaid, all reached before their ADP, which is a meaningful chunk of draft capital steered toward a TE5, a TE7, and a TE11 when the rest of the roster was still taking shape. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 is a genuine anchor, and the Love stack with Kraft carries real upside, but beyond Smith-Njigba the receiver group collapses fast, with Khalil Shakir at WR51 as the next man up. ChizzyDaBoss994 did not play recklessly. The roster just does not care.

Sitting at 35th percentile and eighth in the Tony Hawks Underground division, greggroesbeck is not a team on the cusp of turning things around, it is a team that has already made most of its mistakes. The draft tells the story plainly: three major reaches and zero steals across the entire board, which means the roster was paid for at full price or above, with little surplus value to show for it. Hunter Henry at TE18 cost a seventh-round pick when his ADP said tenth, Jordan James at RB67 was taken more than four rounds early, and Ja'Kobi Lane at WR89 went nearly four rounds before the market agreed. The one bright spot is the Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack, a genuine asset when both are clicking, but Burrow's upside does not erase the fact that the projected starters grade out near average across the board and the weakest of them, Rico Dowdle at RB32, was himself a minor reach. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, just a long season ahead.

Sundevil134 played the draft about as correctly as you can play it, and the roster still lands at 43rd percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes a person stare at a wall. Nearly every pick came at or after ADP, Brock Purdy fell a full two rounds to pick 7.10, Luther Burden slid a round to 6.03, and both stack neatly behind Caleb Williams. That is real value extracted from a real draft. The problem is that value accumulation works when your floor players can carry weight, and Rhamondre Stevenson projecting as the weakest projected starter at RB31 is not a floor so much as a trapdoor. Cam Skattebo cost three rounds of draft capital above his ADP to land at RB20, which means Sundevil134 overpaid for a player who does not even crack the top half of running backs. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this team legitimate upside, but seventh in the division suggests the math does not lie, even when the process was sound.

aclark41 sits at the 47th percentile and sixth in the Tony Hawks Underground division, which tells you everything about where this season lives: not condemned, not comfortable. The foundation is real. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster, and Justin Jefferson, taken at 2.05 when ADP had him going nearly a full round earlier at 1.12, looks like the kind of patient value that wins close weeks. But the margins cut both ways. The major reaches on Kaytron Allen and Elijah Sarratt, both pulled nearly four rounds ahead of consensus, represent bets that most of the field declined to make, and at RB61 and WR98 respectively, they project as low-end contributors at best. When Jefferson is cooking and Josh Allen is being Josh Allen, this roster hums. When the bottom of the depth chart gets called on, the difference between sixth and third in this division could come down to whether those late-round gambles pay off in weeks where a point or two decides everything.

Last year, fantasyfootballshow finished in the 18th percentile of scoring, a genuinely miserable place to spend a season. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that pain. The foundation is Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10, two projected starters who give this team a high floor before a single waiver wire decision is made. Add Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Malik Nabers at WR12, both projected starters, and you have a core that would make most managers in the Tony Hawks Underground division jealous. The draft work holds up under scrutiny too: Nabers came at solid value, and Quinshon Judkins at RB22 fell more than a round past his ADP, giving this team depth that compounds an already strong top end. The quarterback picture is modest, with Baker Mayfield projecting as QB18, but in a positionless format, the quality stacked elsewhere carries more weight. This looks like a team that learned from a rough year and answered the right way, and a 60th-percentile projection feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

Bombargo is sitting pretty in the Tony Hawks Underground division, and the draft sheet tells you everything you need to know about why. The receiver corps alone could anchor most rosters: Drake London (WR7), Zay Flowers (WR16), and Garrett Wilson (WR17) form a projected-starter trio that any manager in this field would take, and Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) adds upside for managers willing to bet on a bounce-back, though the Arizona quarterback situation and his injury history demand patience. What makes this build genuinely impressive, though, is the discipline behind it. Six good values and a steal scattered across the roster, with Alvin Kamara (RB50) falling more than two full rounds past his ADP and Cam Ward (QB23) sliding nearly as far. The TE group, anchored by Brock Bowers (TE1) and Tyler Warren (TE4), is rated strong for a reason. Two minor reaches are the only blemishes on an otherwise clean sheet. This is what it looks like when a manager shows up prepared and lets the draft come to them.

Cjspeedy05 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right, over and over. Puka Nacua lands at WR1 and was taken fifth overall, a mild slip from his ADP that Cjspeedy05 pounced on. Jalen Hurts, projected QB9, fell nearly a round and a half past his ADP before this team grabbed him at 5.05, a quiet transaction that pays dividends every week a manager fields their best players. Then consider that the roster carries four values, twelve chalk picks, and zero major reaches across the entire draft, a profile that reads less like luck and more like a manager who knew exactly what things were worth and waited. The Goff and Jameson Williams stack adds a bonus layer of upside without costing roster equity elsewhere. Saquon Barkley at RB8 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this lineup two projected top-ten options at the position. Sitting third in the division and in the 82nd percentile of the field, Cjspeedy05 looks like exactly what a well-constructed team looks like before the season starts.

Sitting at second in the Tony Hawks Underground division and 89th percentile in the field, simivalley looks like the product of someone who actually did their homework before draft day. The foundation is legitimate: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Trey McBride at TE2 are the kind of cornerstones that make a lineup hard to attack, and Rashee Rice at WR13 gives this team a genuine second option rather than a courtesy starter. What separates a good draft from a clean one, though, is what happens in the middle and late rounds, and that is where simivalley really earns its grade. Jaxson Dart fell two and a half rounds past his ADP and landed here at QB11, Tyler Shough slid more than three rounds and adds a QB20 at virtually no cost, and Jauan Jennings dropped over three rounds in the late going to give the team real depth at the margins. Three steals, fifteen chalk, zero major reaches. That is not luck, that is process, and the roster reflects it.

MMonzo didn't win the draft with one knockout pick. They won it by rarely losing a round. James Cook at RB5 slid nearly a full round past his ADP before MMonzo grabbed him at 2.11, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 fell almost as far before landing here too. Add Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Breece Hall at RB14 as projected starters, and the top of this roster is doing serious work before you even get to the depth. That depth has its own story: the back end of the board features Brian Robinson, Braelon Allen, and Jaylen Wright all taken well ahead of their ADPs, which is a calculated bet on upside rather than a passive draft. Not every swing will connect, but the foundation is sturdy enough to absorb a miss or two. The result is a team sitting first in the Tony Hawk's Underground division and in the 93rd percentile of the field, which is exactly what consistent, compounding draft value looks like when it all adds up.
