TheATJ lands third in the Pikachu Division and in the third percentile of the entire field, and the draft board explains exactly why. The defining move, repeated five times over, was reaching. Dak Prescott came off the board at 2.03 when his ADP sat at 3.07, Patrick Mahomes followed at 3.10 against an ADP of 5.08, and then Kirk Cousins materialized at 15.10 despite an ADP of 18.09, a third quarterback taken nearly three full rounds early in a format where even one is a luxury. Each of those early triggers meant a real player elsewhere on the board went unpurchased, and the downstream damage shows. Sean Tucker, projected RB65, was snatched at 17.10 against an ADP of 21.08, and Trey Benson, projected RB64, followed the same pattern a round later. Christian McCaffrey is a genuine anchor at RB3, and Zay Flowers at WR16 gives this roster some real footing, but spending premium draft capital on quarterbacks nobody needed and late-round depth nobody wanted is the kind of self-inflicted wound that a pretty top of the roster simply cannot close.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on paper, and then there is the version you actually have to live with come September. Pika-Who? sits 11th in the Pikachu division and in just the 19th percentile of the field, and the numbers do not really hide why. The top of the roster is legitimate: Lamar Jackson projects as a QB3, Jonathan Taylor as an RB4, and Saquon Barkley as an RB8, a trio that would anchor almost any competitive lineup. The problem is that the production falls off a cliff almost immediately after that. The receiver group grades weak, with Tee Higgins at WR19 as the best of the bunch and Michael Wilson, a minor reach at WR39, as the next name of consequence. Then the draft capital meant to address that weakness went to Tory Horton and Jack Bech, reached on by more than three rounds apiece, two players projecting outside WR90. When your clearest path to improvement runs through a pair of late-round gambles that already cost you future picks, the uphill road gets steeper.

There is not much to feel good about in the Pikachu division if you are 4thDownDesigns. Sitting tenth in the division and at just the 32nd percentile of the field, this roster is built on a foundation that looks impressive on the surface but cracks under scrutiny. Drake London (WR7), Trey McBride (TE2), and Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) are legitimate cornerstones, and the receiving corps as a whole grades out strong. But in a positionless format, the engine that turns all that talent into points is quarterback play, and Jared Goff (QB16) is a shaky one. The Goff/Jameson Williams stack offers some upside, but it is the kind of lever a manager pulls when they are hoping for lightning, not banking on consistency. Meanwhile, Alec Pierce (WR32) is on the PUP list recovering from ankle surgery, meaning his ceiling is already negotiating with his availability. No steals in the draft, a roster that grades near the bottom of the field, and an injury already casting a shadow before a single snap. This one is going to be a long autumn.

The name is aspirational, the roster is not. Brock Bowers Super Powers sits ninth in the Pikachu Division and in just the 36th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism: 15 chalk picks out of 18 total, which is less a draft strategy than a slow walk through consensus. The one place the team can genuinely brag is at the top, where Brock Bowers projects as TE1 and anchors whatever ceiling this roster has. But a superpower needs more than one outlet, and the quarterback situation is quietly brutal. C.J. Stroud, taken a full two rounds early at QB22, is the best of the bunch, and that reach looks worse the longer you stare at it. Kyler Murray and Shedeur Sanders round out the group, and none of them project as a difference-maker. With a largely undifferentiated wide receiver group topping out at DeVonta Smith at WR14 and no obvious trade chip to upgrade the position that matters most, Bowers may end up carrying this team on his back, which is a lot to ask of one tight end and one name.

TheBauerClub is sitting at 45th percentile and eighth in the Pikachu division, and the roster breakdown explains exactly why there is no easy fix coming. The running back group is genuinely strong, anchored by Bijan Robinson (RB2), De'Von Achane (RB6), and Kenneth Walker III (RB10), but that depth masks a real problem: the receiver group is a graveyard. Rome Odunze (WR30) leads the unit as the only projected starter, and the supporting cast features Jakobi Meyers (WR45), Kayshon Boutte (WR76), and Tyreek Hill (WR77), a name that once commanded respect but now ranks as the fourth option on this roster. The draft did not help matters. Sam Darnold (QB21) was drafted two full rounds before his ADP, a significant overpay for a QB21. Meanwhile, 15 chalk picks and zero steals suggest a manager who played it safe and got exactly what the market offered, nothing more. When your ceiling is essentially baked in by draft day and the receiver tier is this thin at the top, there is no lever left to pull.

Ash(ton) Ketchum sits at the 49th percentile and seventh in the Pikachu Division, which is exactly as unglamorous as it sounds, and yet nothing about this roster screams "easy week" for an opponent either. The foundation is genuinely good: Justin Jefferson at WR6, Malik Nabers at WR12, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give this manager a core that can hang with anyone on a given Sunday. The problem is what happens when you push past that top tier. Makai Lemon, the weakest projected starter at WR40, was actually a minor reach, taken a full round before his ADP suggested he'd be available, which means the manager paid a premium for the player most likely to cost them a close matchup. Drake Maye at QB2 offers upside, but Baker Mayfield at QB18 is the safety net, and that gap is wide. This team doesn't lose weeks it should win, and it doesn't win weeks it should lose. The margins decide everything here, and right now those margins are razor-thin in the wrong direction.

Parry_FF enters 2026 sitting exactly at the 50th percentile, which is less a criticism than a diagnosis: this is a team built on a strong foundation that needs its edges to hold. The foundation is real. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Omarion Hampton as RB9, and Chase Brown as RB11, a haul that gives Parry a reliable floor week after week. The concern is at the margins. Jalen Hurts at QB9 is a legitimate starter, but Parry reached 1.2 rounds early to get him, and the investment shows in a receiving corps where Jaylen Waddle tops out at WR23 and the rest of the group trails off quickly. Travis Kelce at TE10 helps, but this roster's ceiling depends on whether the supporting cast elevates or drags. Parry finished at the 73rd percentile in scoring in 2025, so the upside is there, and sixth in the Pikachu division is a rank earned, not assigned. The margins, as they usually do, will have the final word.

tfeeser spent draft day shopping early and often with someone else's coupons, reaching on nine players before the board got there, and the roster that came out the other side is genuinely hard to argue with. The headliner is the Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase stack, a QB4 and WR2 pairing that gives this team a weekly ceiling most managers would trade their whole draft strategy to own. But the conviction showed up in the middle rounds too, where tfeeser grabbed Derrick Henry at RB12 almost a full round ahead of consensus and kept right on reaching through the late rounds, stacking running back after running back with the calm certainty of someone who had already decided what kind of team they were building. The result is a squad sitting at 64th percentile in the field, nothing flashy on paper, but anchored by two elite players and backed by enough volume everywhere else that the strategy almost earns a retroactive endorsement. Whether tfeeser saw something the board missed or just got away with it, the ledger still reads the same way.

hannahr did not swing for the fences and whiff. This roster was built pick by pick, round by round, and the cumulative effect is a squad sitting at the 68th percentile with a receiver corps that could carry a lineup on its own. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Nico Collins at WR9, and Rashee Rice at WR13 are all projected starters, and Collins came at a minor discount despite being taken a hair before his ADP. The draft board was kind in the middle rounds, too: Isaiah Likely slid to TE13 value at pick 10.07, and Josh Jacobs fell a full round and a half to land at RB16. That Jacobs situation carries real uncertainty given an unresolved offseason legal matter, but even if that resolves poorly, the surrounding talent gives hannahr enough cushion to absorb it. Brock Purdy stacking with Mike Evans adds another layer of upside. Nothing here screams lottery ticket, and that is exactly the point. This team looks like a problem because someone did their homework and refused to flinch.

Last year, Pika Six finished in the 11th percentile with 3,854 points and an 8-28 record. That version of this team is gone. The 2026 roster lands in the 68th percentile and sits third in the Pikachu Division, and the difference is exactly what you'd hope to see after a miserable season: real talent at the top. Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and CeeDee Lamb (WR5) are as good a one-two punch as you'll find anywhere in this tournament, and Chris Olave (WR11) and Terry McLaurin (WR24) give the lineup genuine depth behind them. Caleb Williams (QB6) anchors the position, and his pairing with Olave through Tyler Shough (QB20) as a stack gives the roster a clever hedge if Williams disappoints. Jake Ferguson (TE12) was the draft's clearest find, sliding nearly two rounds past his ADP to 10.01. This is a team that knows what went wrong in 2025 and fixed it.

Pika Pika Pikachu! didn't build this roster on one flashy swing, they just kept winning small battles until the sum became something worth respecting. The steal of the draft was Jayden Daniels, a QB5 projection who somehow slid two full rounds past his ADP, landing at 4.12 while managers ahead of the pick looked elsewhere. That kind of value doesn't announce itself, it just quietly tilts the balance. The receiver corps did the same thing, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 and George Pickens right behind him at WR10, both entrenched as starters. Then the tight end group arrives like a second wave: Tyler Warren at TE4, Harold Fannin at TE6, and George Kittle, who fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before landing here at TE9. Fourteen chalk picks out of eighteen total, with no major reaches anywhere on the board, says this manager knew the price of every player and refused to panic. The result is a team sitting second in the Pikachu division and in the 87th percentile of the field. That's not luck, that's drafting.

TheNFelle sits first in the Pikachu Division and in the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the ledger of how that happened is almost boring in its consistency: sixteen chalk picks, one steal, one value, and only two minor reaches across the whole draft. That kind of restraint is how you build a team that doesn't have a soft underbelly. The headline is the starting lineup, which is genuinely difficult to attack. Josh Allen is a QB1. Colston Loveland is a TE3 and Tucker Kraft is a TE5, meaning TheNFelle can field two top-five tight ends in the same lineup without sacrificing anything. A.J. Brown at WR8 and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give the passing game a backbone most managers in this field would trade for. And where the roster does have a value story to tell, TreVeyon Henderson tells it cleanly, a projected RB19 who slid two full rounds past his ADP and into TheNFelle's lap at 9.03. Nobody had to overreach to build this. They just had to keep showing up and winning the pick.
