The draft board told the story in real time, and it was not a good one. Chunky2026 sits ninth percentile in the field and dead last in the Ganondorf division, and the draft log explains every bit of it. The headline disaster is Mac Jones, taken at pick 15.10 with an ADP of 23.03, a reach of 7.4 rounds for a QB39 who has no realistic path to fantasy relevance in 2026. That pick alone would be a fireable offense, but J.J. McCarthy got taken 3.2 rounds early right behind it, meaning Chunky burned two late picks on quarterbacks ranked QB37 and QB39 while Patrick Mahomes, the projected QB12 and the team's actual best signal-caller, was already on the roster. The receiver group has some life, Rashee Rice, Nico Collins, and Chris Olave project as genuine starters, and the Mahomes and Rice stack adds a small layer of upside. But five major reaches across a draft leave a roster shaped less by strategy than by panic, and the standings projections suggest the division has already noticed.

Mid-Suavemente sits 11th in the Ganondorf division and in just the 19th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much optimism about a turnaround. The roster does have genuine anchors: Christian McCaffrey grades out as RB3 and CeeDee Lamb as WR5, and both are projected starters. But the draft that assembled this team swung and missed in costly spots, most notably the Matthew Stafford selection at pick 3.11 against an ADP of 6.02, a reach of more than two rounds for a QB14. That kind of early capital spent on a mid-tier quarterback is the sort of decision that echoes through every round that follows, squeezing out the upside picks that could have compensated for a thin middle tier. What surrounds McCaffrey and Lamb grades out as largely replacement-level, with Rico Dowdle projected at RB32 as the weakest projected starter, a shaky foundation for anyone hoping to compete. This roster is not one bad beat away from contention; it is structurally short, and the calendar is not going to fix that.

There is no charitable way to frame what Solan8r is walking into. Sitting 10th in the Ganondorf division and projected at just the 25th tournament percentile, this roster grades out as a bottom-tier operation with very little good news buried in the fine print. The draft tells most of the story: two major reaches, including Bo Nix at QB15 spent four rounds ahead of his value, and virtually nothing in the steal column to offset the overpays. That Nix is projected as a borderline starter is one thing, but the fallback of Daniel Jones at QB25 as the weakest projected starter on the roster is genuinely grim. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Drake London at WR7 are real assets and the clearest reason not to completely abandon hope, but in a format where quality at the top of the lineup drives outcomes, two strong receivers cannot mask a quarterback situation this fragile. The 2025 campaign produced a 7-29 record and fifth-percentile scoring, and nothing about this construction suggests the floor has been found.

Sitting ninth in the Ganondorf division and projecting at just the 33rd percentile of the field, koolestkidkyle is staring at a ceiling that most managers would refuse to accept. The core is not without merit, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and George Pickens at WR10 give this roster a legitimate foundation, but the rest of the projected starters thin out fast, bottoming at Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47. That kind of depth on the back end of the lineup is where tournament runs go to die. The draft did nothing to change the trajectory, producing zero steals, one value, and a string of minor reaches that suggest the manager was hunting upside and mostly overpaying for it. Trevor Lawrence, sitting at QB10, is the kind of quarterback you tolerate when everything else is humming, and not much else here is humming. koolestkidkyle needed a draft that created options and instead got one that closed them, leaving this team exactly where it looks: short on answers and long on hope.

FollowRobThomas sits at 35th percentile and eighth in the Ganondorf division, and the draft record explains most of why. Two of the team's most visible moves were reaching for Dak Prescott by more than a round and Jared Goff by nearly two, locking early capital into a QB7 and QB16 when the market said those players would still be there later. That is not how you build a margin for error. The one genuine offensive star is Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, and his ceiling is real, but the supporting cast drops off sharply: Jordan Addison projects as the weakest projected starter at WR43, and the depth behind him is largely wishful thinking. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 give the Goff stack some legitimate upside, and Cam Skattebo at RB20 was a fair value at his draft slot, but those are patches on a roster that needed a foundation. With no obvious move left to unlock the ceiling, FollowRobThomas looks like a team that drafted its own ceiling, and it is not very high.

miller88jeremy is staring at a 2026 season that looks a lot like last year's 16-20 record with fewer excuses left to make. The roster grades out at the 38th percentile in the field and sits seventh in the Ganondorf division, and the draft did not do much to move the needle, producing seven minor reaches and two major ones against a single steal. The headliner, Saquon Barkley, projects as RB8, which sounds fine until you remember he just came off a statistical step back in 2025, is now 29, and has Philadelphia reportedly looking to lighten his workload. Pair that decline arc with Travis Kelce, a major reach taken 2.3 rounds early who projects as TE10, and you have a roster where the two boldest investments are both aging players trending in the wrong direction. Josh Allen at QB1 is genuinely elite, and the Allen to D.J. Moore stack gives the offense a real ceiling, but when the floor is Khalil Shakir at WR51, that ceiling has to hold up every single week, and that is a fragile way to live.

D191741xCh405 finished 2025 as a genuine scorer, 92nd percentile in points, and the bones of that team are still here. But 2026 has the feel of a season decided by inches rather than miles, and the roster reflects that tension. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 form a ceiling that is legitimately scary, and Jalen Hurts arriving as a QB9 with two live stacks through DeVonta Smith and Dallas Goedert adds real upside layering. The concern is that Hurts is now working without AJ Brown for the first time in years, which puts his passing efficiency in an unfamiliar spotlight and, if things go sideways in Philadelphia, his rushing touchdown volume follows. The draft was largely chalk, 13 of 18 picks at or near ADP, with Jerry Jeudy representing the one genuine overpay at nearly three rounds early. This is a 42nd percentile roster sitting sixth in the Ganondorf division, not because the talent is bad, but because the margins are this thin everywhere. Whether Jackson and Gibbs produce at the top of their projections, and whether Hurts navigates life post-Brown, will likely settle the question.

bigpoppathomp didn't light the draft board on fire, but they didn't need to. This is a team built on accumulated advantages, the kind of roster you get when almost every pick lands at or near its expected value and a couple land well ahead of it. The headliner is Jaxson Dart, snagged at 7.09 against an ADP of 5.06, a steal that gives this team a projected QB11 for a round-two price. Stack that with Malik Nabers at WR12, also taken nearly two rounds late, and bigpoppathomp locked in a genuine pass-game core before most managers realized those players were available. The run game adds real weight: James Cook at RB5 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team two projected top-ten backs anchoring the lineup, with Kyren Williams at RB15 and Josh Jacobs at RB16 providing the depth to survive a bad week. Tyler Warren at TE4 rounds out a starting group that has almost no weak links. Fifth in the Ganondorf division and sitting at the 51st percentile feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

Last year, foss345 finished in the 2nd percentile in scoring, a 4-32 record that was less a fantasy season than a controlled demolition. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that misery. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is the kind of foundational piece that changes a team's ceiling overnight, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 gives this lineup a second elite option that most managers in the Ganondorf division simply cannot match. Trey McBride at TE2 is the sort of positional advantage that quietly compounds across a long season, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 arrived as genuine value after falling more than a round past his ADP. The draft was largely disciplined, with Taylor and McMillan both coming in at a discount. The concern is at the margins, where RJ Harvey projects as the weakest starter at RB28, and his path to usage in Denver is genuinely clouded with Dobbins back and the Broncos adding Jonah Coleman in the 2026 draft. But a team sitting at the 71st percentile after finishing near the very bottom? That is not a rebuild. That is a resurrection.

The Wamego Bricklayers sit third in the Ganondorf division and at the 72nd percentile tournament-wide, and the draft record tells you exactly why: four values, twelve chalk, and only two major reaches across the whole board. That is a team built by someone who showed up with a plan and mostly executed it. The foundation is hard to argue with. Justin Jefferson (WR6) anchors the skill positions, Brock Bowers (TE1) was snagged half a round after his ADP, and Ladd McConkey (WR20) slid more than a full round past his number before Wamego scooped him up. The one genuine wrinkle is Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31), a projected starter whose 2025 was undermined by injuries and a murkier rapport with Trevor Lawrence than anyone expected after his first season. If Thomas recaptures that early form, this roster has legitimate upside baked into its floor. The Bricklayers did not chase headlines or swing for a single transformative pick. They just kept coming out ahead of the board, and at the end of eighteen rounds, that compounds.

bradroman19 didn't build this roster on one blockbuster move. This is a team assembled the way a good poker player wins, not by landing the monster hand but by consistently getting slightly more than they paid for. Joe Burrow at QB4 fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and bradroman19 was right there to scoop him up at 3.02. The Burrow-Tee Higgins stack gives this team a ceiling play baked into the foundation, and a Baker Mayfield-Emeka Egbuka stack adds a second pairing that could quietly carry weeks on its own, even as questions linger about whether Mayfield can recapture his 2024 form without Mike Evans in Tampa. Meanwhile, Puka Nacua projects as a WR1 and anchors a receiving corps that runs deep enough to absorb variance. None of these pieces arrived at a discount you'd brag about at dinner, but four documented values across a draft with zero reaches tells you exactly how this team was built: discipline at every pick, nothing surrendered to impatience. That formula produced an

84th-percentile scoring season in 2025, and this roster, sitting second in the Ganondorf division and in the 91st percentile tournament-wide, looks like it was built to do it again.

boonevillestomp sits first in the Ganondorf Division and at the 98th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The foundation is absurd: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors the receiving corps, Drake Maye at QB2 gives the manager elite production at a position many teams treat as an afterthought, and the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack adds a second layer of coordinated upside that compounds when games go right. What separates this roster from merely talented ones, though, is the discipline behind it. Across the whole draft, boonevillestomp logged four values and one steal against just one minor reach and zero major reaches, a ledger that reads like a clinic in patience. Harold Fannin at TE6 came two full rounds after his ADP, and Chris Godwin at WR38 slid nearly two rounds as well. You don't build a 98th-percentile roster by chasing players, you build it by letting them come to you, and that is precisely what happened here.
