ShowMeYourTDs drafted like someone who showed up to the auction already committed to overpaying. The team sits dead last in the King K Rool division and in the 4th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why: four major reaches across the board, zero steals, and a finishing philosophy that apparently treated ADP as a floor rather than a ceiling. Marvin Harrison Jr. comes in at WR33 after being taken nearly three rounds early, and Rome Odunze at WR30 cost two full rounds of surplus. Those are the projected starters anchoring the receiver group, and neither one justifies the price paid for them. Meanwhile, C.J. Stroud, the one player who actually fell to ShowMeYourTDs, is a QB22 still waiting to rediscover whatever made his first season worth remembering, with a deteriorating situation in Houston that offers no particular reason for optimism. The team went 12-24 last year and scored in the 16th percentile. Nothing in this draft suggests the trend reverses.

MrMeatyclackers sits 11th in the King K Rool division and in the 7th percentile of the entire field, and the roster explains why without much argument. The QB group is a genuine problem: Fernando Mendoza (QB27), Aaron Rodgers (QB29), and Shedeur Sanders (QB32) project as the three weakest starters on the team and there is no obvious upgrade path hiding behind them. The running back group is legitimately strong, anchored by Jonathan Taylor (RB4) and James Cook (RB5), but strength at one position only carries so much weight when the quarterback situation is this bleak. There are bright spots elsewhere, Jaylen Waddle (WR23) moves from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense where Bo Nix threw the ball more than anyone in the league last year, which is a genuine reason for optimism. The problem is that bright spots and a strong backfield are not enough to paper over a QB ceiling this low. The draft offered no steals and no values against ADP, just 14 chalky picks and a handful of reaches. This roster looks like a team that needed everything to break right and drafted like nothing needed fixing.

There is a particular kind of draft heartbreak reserved for managers who did everything right on paper and still ended up here, sitting tenth in the King K Rool division and projected at the 20th percentile of the field. UDDLRBAS played the value game correctly, posting four legitimate values and not a single major reach across the entire board. Courtland Sutton fell nearly a round and a half before being scooped up, Dalton Schultz dropped a full two rounds past his ADP, and yet the roster simply does not scare anyone. The problem is not process, it is ceiling. Drake Maye and Joe Burrow are a genuinely strong pairing at the top, but below them the lineup settles into an unremarkable middle. DeVonta Smith and Mike Evans anchor the skill positions at WR14 and WR27 respectively, serviceable and nothing more. Travis Kelce checks in at TE10, which should feel like an asset and instead just feels like a footnote on a team whose projected weakest starter is Jakobi Meyers at WR45. The draft was clean. The outcome was not.

Old Man Fumbles drafted like a patient accountant and ended up with a balance sheet that still does not balance. The value-hunting was real: Justin Jefferson fell to pick 2.04 and is projected WR6, George Kittle slid a full round and lands at TE9, and the receiver group as a whole is genuinely elite, with CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Tee Higgins at WR19 rounding out a starting core that most managers would envy. And yet the roster sits ninth in the division and in the 31st tournament percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes a drafter question everything they thought they knew. The culprit is the quarterback room, where a round-four reach on Matthew Stafford, projected QB14, consumed real draft capital on a player who does not move the needle. Stafford stacks with Davante Adams, which is a fine consolation, but it does not fix the underlying math. Old Man Fumbles found value on nearly every line of the ledger and still cannot make the numbers add up. That is not bad luck. That is the cruelest kind of correct.

PorcoRosso ran a disciplined draft. Derrick Henry fell 1.2 rounds past his ADP and landed at RB12. Ja'Marr Chase arrived as WR2. Kenneth Walker III projects as RB10. The value column looks respectable, the star power looks real, and the team still sits at 39th percentile with a division rank of eighth, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the game is knowable at all. The problem is not process, it is gravity. Kyler Murray was the major value of the draft, falling more than two rounds before PorcoRosso scooped him at QB19, and yet QB19 is still QB19 in a format that asks for ten starters. Chris Olave, taken a round early at WR11, was the one place the manager flinched on process, and even that pick is not obviously wrong. The roster did almost everything right by draft-room logic and ended up somewhere in the forgettable middle anyway, proof that ADP discipline is a floor, not a ceiling.

Markmarsh1327 sits at 44th percentile heading into 2026, and that number tells the whole story: good enough to stay in every game, not quite good enough to feel comfortable in any of them. The ceiling here is real. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 give this roster genuine top-end firepower, and Harold Fannin, snagged a round and a quarter after his ADP, looks like the kind of quiet draft-day win that separates 8-win teams from 11-win teams. But the margins cut both ways. Jeremiyah Love, Rico Dowdle, and Woody Marks were all reached for before their ADPs, and Dowdle projects as the weakest starter on the roster at RB32. None of those are catastrophic calls, but in a format where the difference between advancing and going home is a handful of points per week, a roster built on minor reaches at the back end doesn't leave much room for error. The 2025 campaign bottomed out at 28 percent wins. The pieces are better now. Whether the margins cooperate is another question entirely.

BlueRibbonBets enters 2026 sitting seventh in the King K Rool division and projecting at just the 43rd percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not hide a secret weapon waiting to be unlocked. Josh Allen is a genuine QB1 anchor, and the receiver group has real names in A.J. Brown (WR8) and Malik Nabers (WR12), but Nabers is the cautionary tale baked into this roster's ceiling. After tearing his ACL last season, Nabers drew enough concern this offseason that his redraft value cratered from a top-10 receiver in May to WR21 by July, and questions about his chemistry with Jaxson Dart add another layer of uncertainty on top of the health unknowns. Beyond those two, the projected starters grade out as average at best, with Khalil Shakir (WR51) holding down the weakest spot in the starting lineup. The draft offered no steals and leaned heavily on chalk, leaving BlueRibbonBets without the roster upside to paper over a slow start. If Nabers is not a full-go early, this team has very little margin for error.

TheBananaStand is neither a threat nor a punching bag, and that ambiguity is the whole story. The roster's best case rests on a tight end group that is genuinely elite at the top, with Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tyler Warren at TE4 projecting as two of the best players at the position in the tournament, and the draft reflected that conviction early. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Zay Flowers at WR16 give the squad legitimate upside at receiver, but below that tier the production thins quickly, and a 2025 finish in the 24th percentile of scoring suggests this roster has been here before, promising in spots and quietly disappointing as a whole. Jaxson Dart projecting as QB11 offers more than you'd expect from that position, but Tyler Shough at QB20 is a thin safety net if Dart stumbles. Sitting fifth in the King K Rool division at the 44th tournament percentile, TheBananaStand is the kind of team that finishes right where it started, one or two margins away from something better, and one or two away from something worse.

Vinegar Strokes built something real here, and the draft log makes it look messier than it is. Managers watching this board saw five minor reaches and three major ones and probably moved on, but the finished roster is sitting at the 50th tournament percentile with a starting core that holds up under scrutiny. Trey McBride at TE2 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 are the kind of projections that anchor a contender, and Breece Hall at RB14, Javonte Williams at RB17, TreVeyon Henderson at RB19, and Bucky Irving at RB21 form a group of projected starters that most managers would take without blinking. The catches are real, though. Alvin Kamara, projected RB50, was taken nearly five rounds early, and Sean Tucker, projected RB65, came off the board more than seven rounds ahead of his price. Those are not small miscalculations. The saving grace is that in a positionless format, late-round depth matters less than elite production at the top, and Vinegar Strokes has that. The reach count is a red flag that the roster keeps overruling.

oldNslow didn't win the draft with one flashy swing. They won it pick by pick, and the cumulative effect lands them at the 92nd percentile in a field where that kind of quiet precision is genuinely rare. The clearest example is Tucker Kraft, a projected TE5 taken nearly two rounds after his ADP, which is the kind of positional value that compounds across a long season. Pair that with Chigoziem Okonkwo falling 2.3 rounds past his number and suddenly the tight end group looks like a genuine strength built entirely on patience rather than luck. The receiving corps reinforces the point: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Drake London as WR7, and George Pickens as WR10, all starters, all acquired without reaching. After a 2025 season that landed in the 29th percentile in scoring, this roster reads like a deliberate correction. Third in the King K Rool division is where they sit right now, and with six values and zero steals that somehow still produced a top-tier roster, that ranking feels like a ceiling waiting to be tested.

tribefan210 sits at 93rd percentile in the field heading into 2026, and the draft log tells you exactly why: no major reaches, zero minor reaches, and a steady stream of players who fell right into their lap. The headliner is Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6, a projected-starter pairing that would make most managers in this division quietly reconsider their life choices. But the real craftsmanship shows up in the value column. Patrick Mahomes came off the board at 7.05 despite an ADP of 5.08, giving tribefan210 a QB12 projection at a meaningful discount, and Sam Darnold fell a staggering 2.2 rounds to become the steal of the draft at 11.05. Even Juwan Johnson, the weakest projected starter on the roster at TE20, was snagged a round and a half after his ADP. This team does not have one flashy move to hang its hat on. It has fifteen chalk picks, four values, one steal, and a 2025 foundation of 4616 points to build from. That is not luck. That is a manager who did their homework.

Cranky Kong's Revenge didn't just draft well, it drafted with a kind of cold, methodical authority that most managers in this field can only aspire to. The crown jewel is Christian McCaffrey, an RB3 projection snagged at 2.05 when his ADP sat at 1.09, a steal of nearly a full round on one of the most valuable players in the format. Pair that with Brock Bowers at TE1 anchoring the positional group and Justin Herbert landing at QB8 almost two full rounds after his ADP, and you have a roster built less on luck than on the kind of draft-room discipline that separates contenders from tourists. Rashee Rice at WR13 and D.J. Moore at WR26 round out a starting core that is genuinely difficult to attack. The 2025 season showed this manager already knows how to win, 20-16 and 61st percentile in scoring, and the 2026 roster is meaningfully better. Division rank first, 94th percentile tournament-wide. Cranky Kong isn't out for revenge. Cranky Kong is just ready.
