Brown and DeVonta Smith, could almost be promising if they weren't weighed down by Cooper Kupp, who was somehow snagged right before he probably thought about retiring. Drafting Jalen Hurts earlier than consensus might have been a bold play, but one wonders if it was more a cry for help from a team grasping at the coattails of forgotten glory. Yet, there's something admirable, in a quixotic sense, about PinkPuppy's steadfast

belief in players past their prime and their stubborn optimism—a trait that no doubt will keep them competitive in their own universe, far removed from the realities of the scoreboard.

As they sit precariously in the 19th percentile, rorschacher teeters on the edge, burdened by the weight of a difficult journey ahead where the potential for redemption feels as distant as ever.

Still, with a slight stack bonus from pairing Williams with Warren, there might just be a glimmer of hope—or at least a few more points—to salvage this season's narrative.

As the 2025 fantasy football season looms, ChefJBeezy faces a daunting uphill battle to recapture their former glory. After basking in a reasonably successful run last year, finishing in the 67th percentile, their current outlook is far bleaker. Their ninth-place division ranking and placement in the bottom quarter of teams overall cast a long shadow over this year's prospects. A significant point of concern is at the quarterback position, where Tua Tagovailoa, currently languishing at QB24, could very well be the weakest link. Despite a talented wide receiver corps boasting names like Travis Hunter and Garrett Wilson, inconsistency and underperformance loom large. The team did manage to snag some value with Rome Odunze and Dalton Kincaid being drafted after their ADP,

but questionable decisions, such as taking Josh Jacobs slightly early and egregiously reaching for Anthony Richardson and Amari Cooper, may compound their woes. Without a marked improvement in performance and a reversal of fortune from their key players, ChefJBeezy's hopes for success this season seem dim.
