There is no charitable read available for All22_FF, a team sitting dead last in the Sephiroth division and in the 2nd percentile of the entire field. The draft chart tells the story plainly: five major reaches against zero steals, a distribution that practically announces itself as the work of someone drafting by feel rather than by board. The most damning entry is Jaxson Dart, pulled three-plus rounds ahead of his ADP at 2.04 and projecting as a QB11, which is a fine player taken at a ruinous price on a board where value was absolutely available. Then there is Harold Fannin, reached on by 1.6 rounds early in the third round, locking in a TE6 projection when patience might have netted something comparable later and freed that capital for actual scarcity. The one genuine bright spot, Bhayshul Tuten projecting as an RB25 with a backfield opening in Jacksonville finally cracking the door for him, arrived as a value, but one good round cannot rescue a draft defined by impatience. All22_FF went 13-23 last season and nothing here suggests the trajectory reverses.

MEATBALLfantasy sits 11th in the Sephiroth division and in the 6th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains both numbers without any additional commentary needed. Six major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and this roster is the monument to that philosophy. The centerpiece of the carnage is the quarterback situation: Kyler Murray, reached 2.9 rounds early at QB19, is a man currently locked in a "true competition" with J.J. McCarthy for a starting job in Minnesota after a lisfranc injury cut his Arizona tenure short, and MEATBALLfantasy responded to that uncertainty by also reaching 2.7 rounds early for McCarthy at QB37. Two quarterbacks, both reached, both in question, both sharing the same depth chart. Then there is Jordan James, hauled in 6.5 rounds before his ADP, projected QB19 at QB67, sitting behind a receiver group anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and George Pickens at WR10 that genuinely deserved better than this draft surrounding it. The receivers did not fail MEATBALLfantasy. MEATBALLfantasy failed them.

There is a version of this roster that works, and mywitzn has found it with Lamar Jackson and Tyler Warren, a stack that gives the lineup a genuine weekly ceiling and represents about the only unambiguous win on the draft board. Warren was the one real value, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP before mywitzn grabbed him at 4.03. That is where the good news ends. The team sits 10th in the division and in just the 9th percentile of the field, and the draft did little to improve those odds, producing zero steals against six reaches, including Cooper Kupp pulled five and a half rounds early in Round 14. The projected starting group bottoms out at Rhamondre Stevenson, ranked RB31, which is a quietly brutal number in a positionless format where every roster spot has to earn its keep. Joe Burrow gives the lineup a secondary quarterback option that is genuinely elite when healthy, but his injury history makes "when healthy" carry a lot of weight, and banking on that feels less like a plan than a prayer at this point.

LofiThrilla sits ninth in the Sephiroth Division and at the 25th tournament percentile, and the roster does not make a compelling case for optimism. The backfield looks strong on paper, with Bijan Robinson projecting as RB2 and Saquon Barkley still in the mix, but Barkley at RB8 comes with real asterisks beyond the one marking him a starter. At 29 and coming off a down 2025, with Philadelphia reportedly looking to reduce his workload, betting on Barkley to recapture his peak feels like hoping lightning strikes twice in a place it has already stopped storming. The rest of the projected starters grade out as filler: Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47 is the weakest projected starter on the roster, and the tight end room offers nothing better than Oronde Gadsden at TE16. The draft board did not help matters either, with two major reaches and only a single steal across the entire draft. Last year's 13-23 finish was not a fluke. This year is shaping up the same way.

Ruck1540 drafted with discipline. Fifteen chalk picks, two minor reaches, and a draft board that mostly rewarded patience, including landing Woody Marks at pick 18.10 when his ADP sat closer to the third round. The problem is that patience, executed correctly, still left this roster sitting eighth in the Sephiroth Division and in the bottom third of the field. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is the kind of foundational piece teams build around, and the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack adds a layer of genuine upside. But the rest of the projected starters drop off in ways that hurt: Kyle Pitts projects as TE7, Kenyon Sadiq as TE21, and the difference between those two numbers is where scoring goes to die on a close week. Ruck1540 did not overpay for names, did not panic, and played the value game as cleanly as the draft results suggest. The roster just does not project like a team that did any of that, and that gap between process and outcome is the most frustrating place a manager can be.

andyrutt enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Sephiroth division and just inside the 40th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The top of the lineup has real pieces, Drake Maye projects as a QB2, Ashton Jeanty sits at RB7, and Nico Collins checks in at WR9, but the depth falls off a cliff quickly. The draft did not help matters. Three major reaches define the board, most damaging being Maye himself, taken fourth overall when the field consensus had him going nearly a full round later, and Darnell Washington, a TE38 who cost a pick more than three rounds ahead of where the market valued him. The team essentially paid a premium to fill the back end of its lineup with players like Dalton Schultz, who projects as the weakest starter on the roster at TE22. andyrutt went 22-14 last year and scored at the 73rd percentile, which makes this draft all the more puzzling. That ceiling has not vanished, but the path to finding it just got considerably narrower.

FASTWILLY enters 2026 as the Sephiroth Division's most frustrating puzzle: good enough to beat you on any given week, not quite polished enough to scare anyone into circling this matchup. The foundation is genuinely strong, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this roster a backfield core most managers would trade three draft picks for, and Chase Brown at RB11 arriving a full round past his ADP quietly makes that group even better. The problem is at the edges, where margins get decided. Malik Willis projects as QB24 and cost a seventh-round pick to find out, a reach of 3.4 rounds that limits FASTWILLY's ceiling when the position runs cold. The wide receiver group tops out at Tee Higgins at WR19, and Michael Pittman at WR44 is the kind of player who is useful until you desperately need him to be great. Travis Kelce at TE10 steadies things. Last year's 89th-percentile scoring output suggests the engine runs fine. Whether fine is enough in the Sephiroth Division is the only question that matters.

FantaZPhoenix came out of the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft sitting 51st percentile and fifth in the Sephiroth division, numbers that look modest until you see what is actually on this roster. The board will tell you this manager reached, and it is not wrong: Carson Beck was grabbed 6.4 rounds ahead of schedule, Sean Tucker nearly four rounds early. But the roster tells a different story, one built around a genuinely elite core of Jonathan Taylor (RB4), Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Chris Olave (WR11), and Garrett Wilson (WR17), the last of whom actually fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed here as a gift. That is the whole tension with this team. The reaches look reckless in isolation, but they exist alongside real conviction picks that paid off, and the 2025 résumé, a 72 percent win rate and 88th percentile scoring, says this manager knows how to close. Whether the Beck and Tucker gambles were genius or fortunate noise, the talent underneath them is legitimate enough that it may not matter.

jck158 didn't win the draft with one flashy move. They won it by being right, over and over again. A.J. Brown at WR8 slid more than a round past his ADP before this team grabbed him. Mike Evans, a projected starter at WR27, fell a similar distance. Courtland Sutton came off the board nearly a round and a half late. None of those individually reshapes a roster, but all three landing in the same draft starts to look less like luck and more like discipline. The headliner is Justin Jefferson, a projected starter at WR6, and Trey McBride at TE2 gives the team a positional edge most rosters simply won't match at that spot. The Bo Nix reach at QB15 is a real cost, taken more than two rounds before his ADP, but Brock Purdy, who stacks with Evans, softens that exposure. Sitting 4th in the Sephiroth Division and at the 63rd percentile, jck158 isn't a lock for anything, but this is a roster that was built correctly, and that tends to matter by October.

Sitting at the 97th percentile in the field, dshaffer72 built something that looks less like luck and more like a masterclass in patience and board awareness. The foundation is legitimately elite: Brock Bowers at TE1, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, and Jalen Hurts at QB9 give this roster a ceiling most managers in the Sephiroth division can only project onto their monitors with envy. What separates dshaffer72 from teams with comparable names at the top is the efficiency underneath. Lamb fell nearly a full round past his ADP, Bucky Irving landed as a steal at RB21, and George Kittle arrived a round late at TE9. The draft logged three outright steals and five additional values against just one minor reach, and that discipline shows up in the projections. The Hurts context is worth watching, given the offseason departure of AJ Brown putting new pressure on Philadelphia's passing game, but a QB9 with Hurts' rushing touchdown floor is not easily rattled. The weakest projected starter here is Michael Wilson at WR39. That is not a problem, that is a depth chart.

JuiceyReno is sitting at 98th percentile in this field, and the reason is not complicated: when you build a positionless lineup around the best players on your roster, having Josh Allen at QB1, James Cook at RB5, Kenneth Walker III at RB10, and Colston Loveland at TE3 is basically a closing argument. Allen was a minor reach at 1.01, but you do not apologize for taking the QB1 first overall. Cook and Walker both fell well past their ADPs, Cook by nearly a round and Walker by over one and a half, which means JuiceyReno got the two best backs on the roster at a discount. Loveland at TE3 and Isaiah Likely at TE13 give the team a top-of-market advantage at that position, and Jordan Love sits in reserve as QB17, a player whose real-life value has historically outpaced his fantasy production, though Green Bay's stated intention to lean on Love's arm more in 2026 is the one signal worth watching. This roster does not need a narrative. The talent makes the case.

lanemitchell96 did not win the draft with one heist. They won it by being right, over and over again. Christian McCaffrey, projected RB3, fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.06. Puka Nacua, projected WR1, slid more than half a round and cost the same. Drake London, projected WR7, fell over a round. Six of the top seven values on this roster came in at a discount, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting in first in the Sephiroth Division and the 99th percentile of the field. The projected starters, McCaffrey, Nacua, London, Derrick Henry, and Kyren Williams, are the kind of core that makes opposing managers do uncomfortable math. Parker Washington is the wild card worth watching: he outperformed every expectation in 2025, leading Jacksonville in targets and receiving yards, but whether the Jaguars actually commit to him as their lead option with Travis Hunter on the roster is a genuine question. The floor here is extremely high. The ceiling depends on how many of those answers break right.
