OGJMum drafted like someone who confused urgency with wisdom, and the board has the receipts. The most damning entry on the ledger is Lamar Jackson, pulled at 1.07 despite an ADP of 2.03, a reach that cost this roster a full round of value before it even got started. That kind of panic-buy at the top of a draft sends a message, and the rest of the board confirmed it, with five major reaches total, including Sam LaPorta dragged into the fourth round at a position that rarely justifies that kind of premium, and Brandon Aiyuk yanked 4.3 rounds ahead of consensus in the fourteenth. The cruel irony is that the two players who actually fell to OGJMum, Breece Hall and Tony Pollard, were gifts the draft gods delivered despite the manager's best efforts to waste every pick around them. Hall at RB14 is a legitimate building block. Pollard, the projected weakest starter, is the floor. Sitting dead last in the Pokmon division and in the fourth percentile of the field, this roster is the cost of drafting with your heart instead of your head.

TheFFKoala sits 11th in the Pokémon division and in the 7th percentile of the entire field, and the draft tells you exactly why. Not a single steal, not a single value, eleven chalk picks, and eight reaches, two of them major. The headline offender is Jeremiyah Love, pulled at 2.04 when the market had him pegged more than two rounds later at RB13. That kind of early aggression might be forgivable if the rest of the board rewarded patience, but it never did. Jalen Hurts arrives as a projected QB9 and is theoretically the roster's engine, yet the offseason departure of A.J. Brown to New England puts his passing efficiency in genuine jeopardy, and if that offense sputters, so does the rushing touchdown volume that made Hurts a fantasy pillar for five straight years. Trey McBride at TE2 is legitimately excellent, but one elite tight end cannot drag a roster out of the seventh percentile. This draft had no margin for error and burned through it before the double-digit rounds even started.

Palkias Revenge sits 10th in the Pokmon Division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster grades out in a way that makes optimism genuinely difficult to summon. The receiver and tight end groups are legitimate strengths, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), DeVonta Smith (WR14), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and Colston Loveland (TE3), but in a positionless format those weapons can only carry so much weight when the rest of the roster drags. The running back group is weak across the board, with Rachaad White (RB39) as the best available option, and the quarterback situation offers little comfort either, projecting Matthew Stafford (QB14) as a reasonable starter but leaning on C.J. Stroud (QB22) as the weakest projected starter on the roster. Worse, the draft provided no steals and no values, 17 chalk picks, and a major reach in Michael Mayer (TE39) taken more than six rounds early. The stars are real, but the floor beneath them is soft, and there is no hidden gem buried in this draft chart waiting to change the math.

There is something almost noble about rileystevens committing this hard to a vision, and something almost painful about watching that vision rest on so narrow a foundation. The engine here is the Dallas stack: Dak Prescott (QB7) feeding CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Jake Ferguson (TE12), a triple correlation that turns every Cowboys offensive explosion into a fantasy bonanza and every flat Cowboys Sunday into a quiet disaster. Lamb and Ferguson are both projected starters, Prescott is a QB7, and when that offense hums, this roster can genuinely compete with anyone in the Pokmon division. The problem is what surrounds the stack. Justin Jefferson (WR6) is the most intriguing non-Cowboy on the roster, a genuinely elite talent whose 2025 struggles tracked closely with J.J. McCarthy rather than Jefferson himself, and a Kyler Murray partnership in Minnesota could restore him fully. But Isiah Pacheco (RB52) and MarShawn Lloyd (RB66) are the running back options, and Lloyd was a four-round reach. This team sitting at 22nd percentile feels about right: the ceiling is real, the floor is a Cowboys bye week.

ryanhu did everything right and still ended up with a roster that does not quite work, which is the draft equivalent of following a recipe exactly and pulling a disappointment out of the oven. The discipline is genuinely impressive: sixteen chalk picks, two values, zero major reaches, a draft sheet so patient it borders on monastic. Javonte Williams fell a round and a half into his lap, Chuba Hubbard slid even further, and ryanhu was there both times. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 form a credible foundation, and Caleb Williams at QB6 is a legitimate asset. But then the receiver group arrives, and the whole thing deflates. Zay Flowers at WR16 is the only receiver projected to start who ranks inside the top 40, and the names behind her read like a waiver wire in waiting. The value picks were real. The positional rank next to Hubbard at RB29, the projected weakest starter, is real too. Eighth in the Pokmon division and the 40th percentile of the field is the honest projection, and the cruel part is that ryanhu earned it the right way.

SWallaceFF sits seventh in the Pokmon Division and at the 40th percentile of the field, and nothing in the draft log suggests a turnaround is coming. The roster's ceiling lives at the top of the receiver group, where Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and Tee Higgins and Luther Burden check in at WR19 and WR22, but that strength only papers over a deeper problem: the players who need to carry the load beyond that tier simply do not grade out. Kyler Murray projects at QB19 and Tyler Shough at QB20, meaning SWallaceFF is essentially fielding the weakest quarterback situation in the field among teams that bothered to draft the position at all. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 provide some lift, but the depth drops sharply after them. Worst of all, the draft offered no relief, producing zero steals or values against 15 chalk picks and five minor reaches, including paying up early for Murray and Shough. Coming off a 44 percent win rate last season, this roster looks like it is running it back with most of the same problems and none of the upside.

Sitting at 49th percentile and sixth in the Pokmon division, ktompkinsii is precisely the kind of team that makes playoff predictions feel like a coin flip. The receiver group is genuinely strong, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Drake London at WR7, and Chris Olave at WR11, all projected starters who give this roster a legitimate upper tier. But depth of talent only matters if the margins break right, and there are a few places where they might not. Bo Nix grades out as a QB15, which is functional without being comfortable, and last year's 10-26 record with a 31st-percentile scoring finish is the kind of data point that suggests this team has underperformed its personnel before. The draft was mostly chalk, 13 picks at or near consensus value, with the major reach on Pat Bryant at WR86 the one decision that might quietly cost a matchup late in the season. This is a team that can beat anyone on a good week and lose to anyone on a bad one.

AndrewCooper's 2026 Scott Fish Bowl roster is the product of a manager who simply refused to lose a pick. Every single selection landed exactly at market value, 18 chalk calls in a row, and yet the finished product is legitimately good, which tells you the plan coming in was sharp. Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchors the backfield, and the receiver corps pairs A.J. Brown at WR8 with Nico Collins at WR9, two projected starters who give this team a high floor before anything else kicks in. The tight end group is where the needle really moves, though. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 are both projected starters, and Mark Andrews at TE14 provides a third option that most managers would happily call their best. The Jordan Love and Kraft stack adds a layer of upside to an otherwise steady build. AndrewCooper sits fifth in the Pokmon division and at the 56th percentile in the field right now, but this is a roster built to outperform projections by sheer depth of good decisions rather than any single lightning-strike pick.

There was no lottery ticket on this board, no moment where lindellions swung big and somehow connected. There was just a draft that kept coming out ahead, quietly and repeatedly. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors everything, but the layer beneath him is what gives this roster its texture: James Cook at RB5 slid past his ADP by more than half a round, and Derrick Henry at RB12 drifted nearly a full round further than he should have, and lindellions collected both without drama. George Pickens at WR10 and Jameson Williams at WR21 give the receiving corps genuine upside, and the projected starter floor bottoms out at Jayden Reed at WR48, which is a comfortable place to stop worrying. Nothing here was stolen, but two values in the same draft without a single major reach is the kind of quiet discipline that lands a team in the 76th percentile of the field. The Pokmon division should take note: this roster earned its standing one sensible decision at a time.

Last year, vesper13 posted a 6-30 record and landed in the 4th percentile of scoring, the kind of season that makes a manager question every decision they've ever made. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that misery. Josh Allen is a QB1 anchor, and his stack with D.J. Moore at WR26 gives vesper13 a built-in multiplier on big Allen games. De'Von Achane at RB6 is the kind of explosive top-end talent that was simply absent a year ago. Then there is Rashee Rice, projected WR13 if he takes the field, and that "if" is doing real work in this sentence: a knee procedure, probation violations, and a looming jail stint make him genuinely hard to count on. But the roster does not need Rice to be perfect to represent a massive upgrade. Sitting third in the Pokmon Division at the 86th percentile, vesper13 has built something that looks nothing like last year's wreckage, and that alone is worth getting excited about.

CantALoupeFF sits second in the Pokmon Division and at the 93rd percentile of the entire field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: six values, fourteen chalk picks, and not a single reach anywhere on the board. That kind of discipline is rarer than it sounds. The foundation is genuinely impressive, starting with Brock Bowers at TE1 and Malik Nabers at WR12, both secured at a slight discount to their ADPs. Then consider that Omarion Hampton, Kyren Williams, Travis Etienne, and Bucky Irving all project as starters, with Irving himself sliding nearly a round and a half past his ADP before CantALoupeFF scooped him at RB21. Drake Maye lands here as a QB2 projection after falling a few spots past his expected range, giving the team legitimate upside at the most volatile position in the format. The 2025 numbers, a 61 percent win rate and 81st percentile scoring, confirm this manager already knows how to convert a good roster into actual results. Nothing here feels lucky. It feels built.

Vogtski did not stumble into correlation, Vogtski engineered it. The entire ceiling of this roster runs through one pairing: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a stack so tightly wound that when it hits, it does not just score points, it buries opponents. That is the plan, not a hedge, not a fallback, and the rest of the roster exists to keep the lights on while those two do their work. The supporting cast is genuinely capable of doing exactly that. Saquon Barkley at RB8 and Chase Brown at RB11 give the lineup a backfield foundation that does not need the stack to carry every week, and Brown arriving four picks after his ADP means Vogtski paid below market for that insurance. The division-leading rank and 97th-percentile standing in the field reflect what happens when a builder commits to a thesis instead of hedging against one. If Burrow and Chase connect the way the projections suggest they will, this roster does not just compete, it wins in large, uncomfortable numbers.
