There is no version of AshKetchum's draft that looks good from any angle. The team sits at the 7th percentile of the field entering 2026, and the draft record tells you exactly why: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches scattered across the board like breadcrumbs leading nowhere good. The most painful of those reaches is Chris Rodriguez at RB48, pulled three-plus rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of move that haunts a manager all season. Meanwhile, Jaxson Dart is the projected QB1 here, and that context deserves scrutiny: Dart crossed 250 passing yards in a game exactly once last year, finished under 200 yards in half his starts, and made repeated trips to the medical tent. Banking on him as a fantasy engine requires a level of optimism that the 2025 results, a 1st-percentile scoring season, simply have not earned. Brock Bowers at TE1 is genuinely elite and the one bright spot on this roster, but one transcendent player cannot drag a team out of last place in the Pokmon Red and Blue division all by himself.

razinbazin did almost everything right at the draft table and arrived at a roster that still sits 11th in the Pokmon Red and Blue division, projected at just the 21st percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole enterprise. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this team a legitimate foundation, and Rashee Rice fell more than a full round past his ADP before razinbazin scooped him at WR13, a clean piece of value work. Tucker Kraft at TE5 looked like a savvy early reach until you remember he's still climbing back from an ACL tear and the Packers receiving corps did nothing this offseason to suggest he'll find easier targets than he left behind, making his recovery timeline a genuine variable rather than a formality. The problem is that the quarterback situation resolves to Sam Darnold as the projected starter at QB21, and no amount of receiver depth corrects for that kind of drag at the position that sets the ceiling. razinbazin bought correctly and still came up short. That's not a strategy failure. That's just a brutal draw.

There is no soft way to say this: Asstastic21 is sitting at the 22nd percentile heading into 2026, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The good news is Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give this team a legitimate top-end core, and the projected starters are reasonably deep. The bad news is almost everything else. The quarterback situation is genuinely grim, with Drake Maye projecting as a QB2 offering the only credible option before the shelf drops off a cliff to Kirk Cousins at QB35 and beyond. At the receiver spots, Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Mike Evans at WR27 are serviceable but not the kind of difference-makers that drag a bottom-tier roster into contention. The draft did not generate leverage either, producing zero steals and just two values against sixteen chalk picks, which means this team is roughly what it looks like and not quietly better. After an 8-28 campaign a year ago, Asstastic21 needed a draft that changed the conversation. This one did not.

ValerieElisse comes into 2026 sitting ninth in the Pokémon Red and Blue division and at just the 25th tournament percentile, and the roster reads like a team that drafted its way into a corner with no obvious exit. The draft board tells the story plainly: 12 chalk picks, three minor reaches, and two major reaches, with the late-round double-dip on Darnell Washington and Elijah Arroyo standing out as the clearest signs of a team forcing a plan where there was no plan to force. Against that, the lone bright spot is a genuine Stafford-Nacua stack, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1 and Matthew Stafford checking in at QB14, so the ceiling exists on the right nights. But the floor is anchored by KC Concepcion at WR50 as the projected weakest starter, and when that is your margin of error, the math gets unforgiving fast. After an 83-percent win rate in 2025, ValerieElisse knows what a good season feels like, which makes this projected slide hurt that much more.

nbowers12 built this roster with a single prayer: that Joe Burrow and Ja'Marr Chase show up to the same party. The Burrow-Chase stack is the engine here, not an afterthought, and when you're sitting 34th percentile in the field, you need that engine to actually run. Burrow lands at QB4 and Chase at WR2, so the upside is real, and taking Burrow at 2.12 when ADP had him going 2.05 is about as close to free money as this draft offered. The problem is that the floor looks like a cold Tuesday in Cincinnati, because beyond that stack the supporting cast is thoroughly average. Kyle Pitts at TE7 adds a legitimate second weapon, and his 2025 breakout suggests he can produce regardless of who Atlanta lines up under center. But nbowers12 also reached two full rounds early for Jared Goff at QB16, a curious investment in a player who matters almost nothing if Burrow is firing. Stack-or-bust rosters can absolutely win tournaments. This one just needs the stack to actually bust loose first.

AMSchellenberg arrives in the Pokémon Red and Blue division sitting seventh, projecting at the 42nd percentile, and last season's 10-26 record suggests this is less a team on the rise than one still searching for the ladder. The top of the roster has genuine appeal: Jonathan Taylor at RB4, A.J. Brown at WR8, and George Kittle at TE9 are the kind of names that generate optimism in March. The problem is the floor. Brown cost a first-round pick taken 0.8 rounds ahead of his ADP, meaning AMSchellenberg paid a slight premium for what everyone already knew was good, and the back end of the roster features Jaydon Blue at RB70, a player taken 6.6 rounds early in a draft that otherwise produced very little surplus value. When your biggest steal is RJ Harvey at RB28 and your weakest projected starter is also RJ Harvey, the margin for error disappears fast. The stars are real. Everything beneath them is optimism dressed as depth.

Empoleon Dynamite finished 2026 at the 43rd percentile and sixth in the Pokmon Red and Blue division, which means this team lives precisely where the margins matter most: one bounce away from a playoff push, one bad week away from the bottom of the standings. The foundation is real, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and a supporting cast that includes DeVonta Smith, who finally steps out from A.J. Brown's shadow in Philadelphia, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, giving this roster genuine upside at the top of the lineup. Colston Loveland at TE3 adds another projected starter who can genuinely move the needle. But the manager who drafted this team ran almost entirely chalk, with just two values across the whole board, meaning there was no surplus of draft-day edge to paper over the weakness at quarterback, where Fernando Mendoza projects as QB27 and Aaron Rodgers as QB29. When DeVonta Smith is cooking and the top of the lineup hits, this team is a credible threat. When it doesn't, sixth place feels exactly right.

therogerdorn didn't build this roster on a couple of lottery tickets. They built it on volume and consistency, and that's a harder trick than it looks. Jayden Daniels at QB5 anchors the passing attack, with Trevor Lawrence at QB10 waiting if Daniels stumbles, and the skill positions behind them tell a similar story of depth over drama. Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, Drake London as WR7, and Tee Higgins at WR19 gives this team a legitimate second receiver rather than a fallback option. Even Michael Pittman, now paired with DK Metcalf in Pittsburgh behind a 43-year-old Aaron Rodgers on an offense still searching for its identity, lands at WR44 and provides real starter-caliber production in a positionless format that rewards exactly this kind of stacking. The draft itself was almost aggressively unremarkable, 18 chalk picks with zero major reaches, which sounds like a criticism until you look at the 58th-percentile projected finish. therogerdorn wasn't swinging for the fences. They were getting on base, and it worked.

Hombrevender finished last year at the 80th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 draft suggests this manager has no interest in backing off. The board will show three major reaches, and that number is impossible to ignore. Emanuel Wilson landed nearly six rounds ahead of his ADP, Christian Kirk more than five rounds early, and Zachariah Branch over three rounds early. By the spreadsheet, this looks like a draft full of impulsive detours. By the roster, it looks like a manager who knew exactly where they were going. James Cook as a projected RB5 and Josh Allen as a projected QB1 anchor a starting lineup that genuinely earns its 64th-percentile tournament standing, and the confidence that produced those two studs seems to be the same confidence that drove the late-round gambles. The question is whether Wilson, Branch, and Kirk become contributors or cautionary tales. If even one of those reaches pays off, Hombrevender looks savvy. If all three whiff, the upside quietly bleeds out and the reaches become the whole story.

filluprivers didn't build this roster on one big swing. They built it the way a good poker player wins, not by going all-in on a bluff, but by consistently getting the better end of small edges. The clearest example is the wide receiver group: Chris Olave fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before filluprivers scooped him up at WR11, and Zay Flowers at WR16 slots in as part of a Lamar Jackson stack that gives this team a high-upside ceiling every week Jackson goes nuclear. Speaking of Jackson, landing the QB3 two picks after his ADP suggests the draft board did filluprivers a quiet favor. Trey McBride at TE2 anchors things from another angle, and Alec Pierce, health permitting, is a genuine big-play weapon who led the league in yards-per-reception two years running. The PUP situation bears watching, but if Pierce is ready for Week 1, the upside here is considerable. Four values, zero steals, and a 71st-percentile projection: this is what quiet competence looks like.

Mrwillis16 did not need a signature moment to build one of the better rosters in Pokémon Red and Blue. The foundation is legitimate: CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) project as two of the best receivers in the field, and Chase Brown (RB11), Derrick Henry (RB12), and Breece Hall (RB14) give this team a backfield that holds up start after start. What separates a good draft from a great one is what happens in the middle rounds, and that is where Mrwillis16 quietly pulled ahead. Travis Etienne landed at RB18 a full round and a half after his ADP, Davante Adams came in at WR25 nearly two rounds late, and Chris Godwin added WR38 value a round after the market said he should have been gone. None of those picks made headlines in the moment. Together they built a roster sitting at the 90th percentile of the field, which is not an accident. That is a manager who kept winning coin flips all night long.

Tmart101 did not build this roster on one flashy swing. They built it by consistently finding players after the field had moved on. Malik Nabers, projected WR12, fell a round and a half before Tmart101 stepped in at pick 5.05. Caleb Williams, projected QB6, slipped more than a full round past his ADP and landed in the same draft. Josh Jacobs, projected RB16, dropped over a round before getting scooped at 7.05. That is six players taken at genuine value across the board, and the top of this roster reflects it. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 anchor a group of projected starters that would make most managers in this field uncomfortable, and the format lets Tmart101 deploy that depth without apology. The 2025 season landed in the 51st percentile, nothing to brag about, but the roster construction here looks like a clear step forward. Division-leading in Pokmon Red and Blue

and sitting at the 92nd tournament percentile, Tmart101 earned this position the quiet way, by simply outpicking the room.
