As ToxicDeath gears up for the 2025 fantasy football season, the outlook feels daunting after last year's respectable finish in the upper middle of the pack. Now languishing in a disappointing bottom-of-the-barrel division rank and low percentile standing among thousands, the team's hopes rest heavily on its strong running back corps. Derrick Henry and Josh Jacobs are expected to be workhorses, but the glaring weaknesses in the quarterback position, with J.J. McCarthy struggling to break the top 15, cast a long shadow over their prospects. The wide receiver group is an eclectic mix with Drake London leading the charge, but the inclusion of Matthew Golden as a key starter raises questions about depth and reliability. Despite snagging Cooper Kupp and Russell Wilson later than expected in drafts, the team undermined its potential with some questionable early picks,

particularly Derrick Henry and Noah Fant, whose draft positions were considerably overshot. As they navigate the challenges ahead, ToxicDeath must hope that strategic gambits and their running back strength can compensate for deficiencies in other areas.




