Cherry Mmboppin Daddies sits 12th in the Tron division and in the 4th percentile of the field, and the draft does not offer much comfort when you dig into the details. The most glaring problem is resource allocation: manager spent a third-round pick on Jaxson Dart (QB11) and a second-round pick on Tyler Warren (TE4), two major reaches that front-loaded value at positions where this format rewards flexibility, not premium commitment. Warren is genuinely good, and the Dart/Malik Nabers stack has real upside, but those early investments left the rest of the roster thin on reliable contributors. The back end of the draft produced zero steals and three major reaches total, meaning this team leaned early and hard and got little return on the late rounds to compensate. Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and Nabers (WR12) give the lineup a legitimate top end, but when the best available safety valve at quarterback is Malik Willis (QB24), the margin for error essentially does not exist. This roster is not one unfortunate break away from trouble. It is already there.

cbsowlinatree sits 11th in the Tron division and in the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster construction offers little reason to expect a dramatic reversal of fortune. The foundation is genuinely good: Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, Justin Herbert checks in as QB8, and a Herbert-Ladd McConkey stack adds a layer of upside that most teams at this range of the standings simply cannot claim. The problem is that the premium on those top players was paid with early picks that arrived ahead of ADP, including a reach on Herbert at 2.11 when the market had him a round later, and the roster thins out quickly after the stars. Jalen Hurts projects as QB9 but faces a pressure cooker season with AJ Brown now in New England, meaning the volume and rushing touchdowns that have powered five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes could finally erode at the worst possible time. With Michael Pittman at WR44 and Jakobi Meyers at WR45 filling out the starting mix, cbsowlinatree is a roster that needs everything to go right and has drafted itself into a position where very little is left to go wrong.

ShipChaser enters 2026 sitting tenth in the Tron Division and projected in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not offer much of an argument against either number. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Drake London (WR7), Emeka Egbuka (WR18), Luther Burden (WR22), and Mike Evans (WR27) all projected as starters, but Evans is a cautionary tale wearing a 49ers uniform, coming off an injury-shortened eight-game 2025 season that snapped his legendary consecutive 1,000-yard streak, and WR27 may be generous depending on how San Francisco uses him at this stage of his career. The rest of the roster offers little cushion. C.J. Stroud grades out as a QB22 and is the weakest projected starter on the board. The draft did not generate any steals and produced two major reaches, including Sean Tucker taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP. When your best hope is that a receiver corps can carry dead weight everywhere else, you are not chasing a ship so much as waving at one from the dock.

Dynastymcg did almost everything right on draft day, which makes the projected 31st percentile finish sting that much more. The discipline shows in the numbers: 15 chalk picks, zero major reaches, and two genuine values in Aaron Rodgers and J.K. Dobbins, both of whom fell past their ADP into waiting hands. The receiver group is legitimately strong, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), DeVonta Smith (WR14), and Zay Flowers (WR16) all projected starters who would anchor most rosters in this field. The problem is what surrounds them. Patrick Mahomes grades out as a QB12, a middling projection for a positionless format where quarterback output matters more than positional scarcity, and Tony Pollard sits as the weakest projected starter on the board at RB30, a player who was reached for 1.2 rounds early and has yet to justify the premium. Dynastymcg followed the draft manual to the letter and still landed a roster that projects ninth in the Tron division. Some teams lose on process. This one did everything correctly and lost on outcome, which is a far crueler lesson.

TheTyrant sits at 47th percentile and eighth in the Tron Division, and the draft board does not offer much of a defense for that standing. The top of the roster is genuinely exciting, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a ceiling worth respecting, and the Brock Purdy and George Kittle stack adds a reliable floor. But the drop-off is steep and the draft only made it steeper. Fourteen chalk picks and zero steals mean TheTyrant paid market rate for everything and found no bargains to paper over the depth. Worse, two major reaches in the final rounds, Troy Franklin at WR80 and Chris Bell at WR87, burned picks on players who were available much later, which is exactly the wrong place to be aggressive when the middle of your roster needs shoring up. Rashee Rice at WR13 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 give the starters some shine, but when Juwan Johnson at TE20 is your projected weakest starter, you are not a team with hidden upside waiting to be unlocked.

JShort25 sits at 48th percentile in the Scott Fish Bowl field, which is the fantasy equivalent of being exactly on time to a party where the good food is already gone but the host hasn't started cleaning up yet. The margins here are real and they run in both directions. Justin Jefferson, projected WR6, is the clearest reason for optimism, a player whose 2025 slump looks increasingly like a quarterback problem rather than a Jefferson problem, and Kyler Murray arriving in Minnesota could restore him to the elite tier his talent has always suggested. That upside is genuinely exciting. The concern is that JShort25 reached two full rounds early for Xavier Worthy, who projects as WR49 and figures to be the weakest projected starter on the roster most weeks. When your ceiling play and your floor play are both at wide receiver, the season lives inside a very tight band. Derrick Henry at RB12 and Breece Hall at RB14 keep the floor from collapsing entirely, but this team earns nothing on reputation. The margins decide it.

raultherunt is the team that lives in the margins, and in the Scott Fish Bowl, that is both a warning and a genuine opportunity. The foundation is legitimate: Josh Allen at QB1 paired with Dalton Kincaid in a functional stack gives this roster a ceiling that most teams sitting at 48th percentile cannot claim. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 project as high-end contributors, and Jameson Williams at WR21 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 form a respectable receiving core. The danger is that raultherunt leaned heavily on chalk during the draft, with a notable tendency to reach, most painfully on Keenan Allen at WR99, a 4.7-round overpay for a player projecting near the bottom of the position. Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31 is the weakest projected starter and the roster's most exploitable soft spot. A 50-percent win rate and 40th-percentile scoring in 2025 says exactly what this team is: capable enough to beat anyone on a good week, beatable enough to lose to anyone on a bad one. The margin is razor-thin, and raultherunt needs Allen to carry them over it.

AmazinAzian583 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by winning exchange after exchange on draft day, and the cumulative effect is a squad that belongs in the Tron division conversation. The foundation is legitimate: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this team a top-end that most managers would trade their whole middle rounds for. But the draft story is really about the quiet wins underneath. Caleb Williams fell a full round past his ADP and landed at QB6 projected, already a win, and he comes packaged with Rome Odunze in a stack that amplifies both. David Montgomery, Rachaad White, and Chris Rodriguez were each drafted a round or more after the market expected them to go. None of those pickups reshapes the roster on its own, but five good-value selections across a single draft is a pattern, not luck. A 61

percent win rate and 69th-percentile scoring in 2025 suggest this manager knows how to convert paper into points. The 2026 floor looks comfortable.

McGunnigle didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right more often than they were wrong, and the roster reflects it. The centerpiece is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a genuine top-of-the-field anchor, and he doesn't stand alone. A.J. Brown at WR8, Nico Collins at WR9, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give this team a tier of projected starters that most managers in this tournament would take apart just to have one of. Baker Mayfield, a legitimate QB18, fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed at 8.12, which is the kind of quiet win that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones. The Matthew Stafford and Davante Adams stack adds a connected upside thread without costing the team flexibility elsewhere. McGunnigle finished last season at 70th percentile in scoring, and the 2026 construction looks like a team that wants to push further into that conversation. Fourth in the Tron Division is where the projections put them now, but this group has the ceiling to make that number look pessimistic.

O State Ballaz didn't make headlines on draft day, and that's precisely the point. This roster was built through steady, accumulative advantage, the kind that doesn't announce itself until you look at the finished product and realize just how consistently this manager came out ahead. James Cook at RB5 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 form a backfield core that would be the envy of most rosters in the field, and the supporting cast of Josh Jacobs, Cam Skattebo, and D'Andre Swift, who fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before landing here, gives the team genuine depth at the position. Trey McBride at TE2 is the sort of anchor that quietly elevates everything around him. The one cloud on the horizon is Josh Jacobs, whose off-field situation remains unresolved enough to introduce real variance into those projections. But even accounting for that, a roster sitting at 88th percentile in the tournament and third in the Tron Division didn't get there by accident. It got there by drafting well, repeatedly, without drama.

Sitting at second in the Tron Division and the 91st percentile of the field, Prepare To Terminate built this thing the quiet way, not with a single marquee swing but with a draft that kept finding edges round after round. The foundation is genuinely imposing: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 give this roster two players who belong among the position's elite, and the Dak Prescott and George Pickens stack adds a layered secondary threat, with Prescott landing at QB7 after falling nearly two rounds past his ADP. George Pickens at WR10 is the kind of value that makes a draft quietly dangerous. Chase Brown slipped a full round and arrives as the RB11. Mark Andrews at TE14 keeps the position functional without being a liability. The reaches on MarShawn Lloyd and Tory Horton are real, but when your top end looks like this, late-round swings on upside are exactly the right way to spend your chips. This roster did not get lucky. It got built.

ElCamino sits atop the Tron division at the 92nd percentile, and the draft log tells you exactly why: seven values, ten chalk picks, and almost nothing wasted. This roster was built pick by pick, each one landing a little better than the board expected. Drake Maye at QB2 is the anchor, arriving at 2.06 despite an ADP of 2.02, and the scouting on him reads like a case study in efficiency: MVP-level production even before New England added AJ Brown to finally give him an alpha target. Brock Bowers at TE1 gives the team one of the cleanest positional advantages in the field, and Jake Ferguson at TE12 arrived more than a round late. Chris Olave at WR11 slid nearly a full round past his ADP, and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 did the same. None of these picks look like lottery tickets; they look like homework. The Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack adds upside without costing the roster its floor. ElCamino did not gamble its way here. It ground its way here.
