Last year's Pulisic Is Dead To Me went 26-10 and finished in the 85th percentile, and whoever is running this team clearly decided the best response to that success was to rebuild the roster around a philosophical commitment to wide receivers and hope. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and A.J. Brown at WR8 are legitimate building blocks, and the depth behind them is real, but the engine powering all of that production is, at best, foggy. Matthew Stafford, taken nearly two rounds early, sits as the QB14, and the fallback options behind him, C.J. Stroud and Daniel Jones, were each reached for as well. Stroud in particular is the number that should keep this manager up at night: a QB22 projection on a player who has spent two years trying to recapture what made him exciting, with a concussion history and an inconsistent offensive line making optimism feel more like denial. The 2025 version of this team was a legitimate contender. The 2026 version is projected 12th in the division and in the bottom 12 percent of the field, and the gap between those two realities lives almost entirely under center.

There is not much to sugarcoat here for njad222, sitting 11th in Division Q Bert and in just the 13th percentile of the field after a 2026 draft that produced two major reaches and a single steal. Joe Burrow and Caleb Williams give the squad genuine upside at the position, and the Williams-Luther Burden stack is a legitimate tournament-winner if things break right, but the rest of the roster grades out as a long string of averages with very little margin for error. Jonathan Taylor was taken a full round before his ADP suggested he would fall, Bryce Young was pulled 3.2 rounds ahead of schedule at a QB26 projection that does not justify the urgency, and Ray Davis, clocking in at RB62, was another early pull on a player who figures to contribute little. Coming off a season in which the team scored in just the 28th percentile, this feels less like a rebuild in progress and more like a manager running out of levers to pull, hoping volume alone can compensate for a ceiling that keeps refusing to rise.

The Holy Calves drafted like a manager who discovered quarterbacks exist only after the eighth round and then overcorrected with the desperation of someone arguing with a vending machine. Tua Tagovailoa, taken nearly five rounds before his ADP, projects as QB31. Michael Penix Jr., grabbed seven-plus rounds early, projects as QB33. Kirk Cousins, another major reach, lands at QB35. Three panicked early investments to field a QB room that collectively projects below replacement, while Drake Maye, the one QB worth owning, was apparently an afterthought despite his QB2 projection. The receiver corps is legitimately strong, with Drake London, Malik Nabers, Zay Flowers, and Emeka Egbuka all projecting as starters, and Nabers arriving as a genuine steal after falling four-plus rounds past his ADP. But in a positionless format where every player competes for the same lineup slots, that strength gets quietly strangled by how much draft capital was surrendered chasing quarterback

mediocrity. Holy Calves sit 10th in Division Q Bert, projected in the bottom fifth of the field, and the draft board tells you exactly why.

Last year Justin Qbert went 28-8 and scored in the 96th percentile, which is the kind of season that makes a manager feel bulletproof heading into the next draft. The 2026 roster suggests the armor has some serious cracks. The receiver group is legitimately impressive, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Garrett Wilson (WR17), but the positions that tend to separate elite rosters from good-looking ones are where this team gets quiet. Jordan Love (QB17) and Tyler Shough (QB20) project as the QB starters, and the decision to reach on Jacoby Brissett five rounds ahead of his ADP for a third quarterback option is the kind of draft capital that could have shored up other areas instead. Ashton Jeanty (RB7) is a genuine weapon, but the drop-off to Kenneth Gainwell (RB34) is steep. The cumulative result is a team sitting at the 31st percentile in tournament projections and ninth in its division, a long, uncomfortable way from where it finished twelve months ago. The reputation is real. The roster is something else.

Smitty's Kickers did almost everything right on draft day and still landed at 35th percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the whole enterprise. The draft was overwhelmingly disciplined, with 15 chalk picks and genuine patience rewarded in spots, most notably RJ Harvey falling nearly two and a half rounds past his ADP to land at pick 12.11. That is real value, and Smitty found it. The problem is that Harvey projects as RB28, which makes him the weakest projected starter on the roster, and a floor built on a RB28 is not much of a floor. Puka Nacua at WR1 and Nico Collins at WR9 give this team a legitimate top end, but the draft also absorbed Germie Bernard nearly four rounds before the market agreed he was worth selecting, a pick that consumed capital without returning a projected starter. Patrick Mahomes and Brock Purdy project as QB12 and QB13 respectively, solid enough but not difference-makers in a positionless format where quarterbacks rarely separate rosters. Smitty played the value game correctly and still sits eighth in Division Q Bert. The cruelest drafts are the ones where the receipts look fine.

MarkKSilver heads into 2026 sitting 7th in Division Q Bert and at just the 38th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The wide receiver group is genuinely elite, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and Justin Jefferson (WR6), with DeVonta Smith (WR14) now stepping into a true alpha role in Philadelphia after A.J. Brown's departure, and Tee Higgins (WR19) and Mike Evans (WR27) rounding out a deep pool of projected starters. But the rest of the roster reads like a cautionary tale about draft-day conviction overriding market signals. Three major reaches at quarterback, including Aaron Rodgers pulled a staggering 4.2 rounds early, left MarkKSilver with a QB group projecting no higher than QB16 despite the draft capital spent there. Coming off a 2025 season that landed in the 2nd percentile of scoring, this team needed a reset and a plan. What it got instead was more of the same misplaced aggression, and the receivers, no matter how good, cannot carry this ship alone.

one bad Maafala sits at the 49th percentile, which is another way of saying the margins own this team's season before a single week is played. The foundation is real: Trey McBride at TE2 is a genuine weekly weapon, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives the roster an engine in the backfield worth building around. But the ceiling gets tested at the edges, where Makai Lemon projects as WR40 and the weakest projected starter on the roster. Lemon doesn't sink the ship on his own, but in a tournament decided by fractions, a WR40 in the starting lineup is exactly the kind of soft spot that separates ninth place from fifth. The draft was steady rather than brilliant, twelve chalk picks and four values but no steals, which tells you this is a roster assembled by someone who knew what they were doing but never found the discount that flips a middle-of-the-pack team into a dangerous one. Division Q Bert will not circle this squad as a free win, and that's the honest ceiling here.

evabfisher didn't manufacture this roster with splashy gambles. The engine here is a steady accumulation of value, six picks that fell past their ADP and almost nothing that cost extra to acquire. The most telling examples come from the backfield: Derrick Henry slid a full round and a half before evabfisher picked him up at RB12, and TreVeyon Henderson fell nearly as far, landing at RB19 when most drafts had him gone well earlier. Add Chase Brown at RB11 and Jadarian Price at RB26 as additional late-falling pieces, and you have a collection of projected starters built almost entirely on market inefficiency rather than luck. The receivers are the thinner side of the ledger, with Chris Olave at WR11 carrying most of the weight above WR54, but in a positionless format the backfield depth buys real flexibility. Josh Allen anchors the whole thing at QB1. Sitting 70th percentile in the field and fifth in Division Q Bert, evabfisher isn't threatening to run away with anything, but this is a team that got built correctly and that tends to matter when the schedule tightens.

SultanofStat sits at 78th percentile in the field and fourth in Division Q Bert, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why this team belongs in that conversation. The foundation is legitimate: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give the roster two players who project as genuine positional cornerstones, and Rashee Rice at WR13 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 form as dangerous a receiver pairing as you will find at this level. What separates this draft from a merely good one, though, is the discipline shown in the middle rounds. Bhayshul Tuten fell more than two full rounds past his ADP and landed at RB25, and Travis Kelce slipped a round past his number to give SultanofStat a TE10 floor behind Loveland. That is the kind of board awareness that compounds quietly. Bo Nix, coming off a league-leading pass attempt season with a shiny new weapon added in Denver, slots in as a sensible QB15 with a real ceiling to chase. There is one eyebrow-raising moment, Emanuel Wilson taken nearly six rounds early, but one reach in eighteen rounds is a remarkably clean receipt.

whatgibbsff came into this draft and apparently decided that conventional wisdom was optional. Six major reaches, eleven chalk picks, and yet here they sit at 82nd percentile in the field and third in Division Q Bert, which is either a vindication of process or a reminder that outcomes and decisions are not the same thing. The foundation is legitimate: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, James Cook at RB5, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 form a backfield core that most managers would not reach for in a dream, and Cook and Walker both arrived as genuine values relative to ADP. That is real. The question is what to make of the late-round quarterback spending, where Geno Smith, Shedeur Sanders, and Deshaun Watson were all taken multiple rounds ahead of schedule, and where the Josh Jacobs situation, still unresolved legally and very much unresolved from a fantasy standpoint, adds uncertainty to an otherwise strong group. The reaches mostly hurt at the margins. The core mostly held up. For whatgibbsff in 2026, that is a reasonable place to start.

Just Win Baby sits at 84th percentile and second in Division Q Bert, and the draft tape makes it easy to understand why. The foundation is immaculate: Lamar Jackson at QB3 slipped nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 2.12, and Brock Bowers at TE1 was taken at the top of the first before anyone else could get there. That is the kind of top-end clarity that separates disciplined drafters from the rest of the field. Below those anchors, the value kept coming: Cam Skattebo at RB20 fell nearly two rounds, Jacory Croskey-Merritt at RB40 slid almost as far, and David Njoku at TE29 dropped more than two full rounds before this team scooped him late. Seven values and one steal across the whole board, against just one minor reach, is a distribution that reflects real patience and real process. Kyle Pitts at TE7 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 round out a starting group that is genuinely difficult to poke holes in. This roster was built the right way.

Mint Jell doesn't want a diversified portfolio. They want correlated bets, and they've built two of the cleanest stacks in Division Q Bert: Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb running Dallas's offense in tandem, and Jalen Hurts paired with Dallas Goedert to own the Eagles' production at the source. When those connections fire, the scoring doesn't trickle in from independent contributors, it floods through connected channels at once. The McCaffrey acquisition adds legitimacy to the foundation, the RB3 projection arriving at 2.02 after slipping well past his ADP, and Jaylen Waddle brings a genuinely interesting subplot, a WR23 who escaped Miami's dysfunction for Denver's volume-hungry offense under Bo Nix. The ceiling here is real. The division lead and 87th percentile standing reflect that. But this roster lives and dies by whether those stacks sync up on the same week, and when they do, Mint Jell won't just win a matchup, they'll bury it.
