As the season unfolds, laurenjump will need to capitalize on its quarterback and wide receiver strengths while hoping for a breakthrough from Isaiah Likely to improve their standing both within the division and overall.

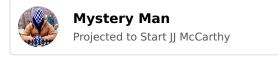
