Anchored by a quartet of quarterbacks that could double as a Netflix series—Patrick Mahomes, Justin Fields, Trevor Lawrence, and Michael Penix Jr.—their strategy seems to revolve around the revolutionary idea of fielding an entire team of QBs. Meanwhile, Brenton Strange, their TE21, is poised to contribute with all the impact of a wet noodle, potentially solidifying his spot as the weakest link in this delicate chain. Boasting an average age of 24.3 years, the Dragonflies are one of the younger squads out there, but it's unclear if youth will bring exuberance or just naïveté. Their collection of wide receivers

—Jaxon Smith-Njigba, Xavier Worthy, and Rome Odunze—is ranked ninth in the division, which pairs beautifully with their ninth-place overall standing. The draft strategies were nothing short of avant-garde: snagging Patrick Mahomes and Michael Penix Jr. below their ADPs, while reaching gloriously early for Justin Fields and Najee Harris. Not to mention the jaw-dropping decision to pluck Jacory Croskey-Merritt from obscurity leagues earlier than anybody thought plausible. And who could forget the potent Mahomes/Worthy stack bonus, which may or may not offset the rest of this whimsical draft strategy? As they prepare to battle for glory—or at least survival—one thing's for sure: the Pandora Dragonflies' season promises to be anything but predictable.
