benefiting from a small stack bonus with Evans and Mayfield, the team's tendency to reach on picks like Mayfield and others signals a strategy fraught with risk. As the season unfolds, cincodemanger will need more than just strategic gambles; they'll require consistent performances across the board to elevate themselves from the depths of their division standings and tournament rankings.


