Lumbago got em sits dead last in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division and in the fourth percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: zero steals, zero genuine values, and five major reaches scattered across the board like evidence at a crime scene. The most damning of those reaches is Bo Nix, a QB15 projection that this team paid for in round four, a full round and a half before the market priced him. That is a real running back's roster spot spent on a middling quarterback in a positionless format where you almost never need to prioritize the position that early. Harold Fannin was another round-two-plus overpay, landing at TE6, which is fine production at a fine position, but the price was steep enough to cascade damage down the rest of the draft. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is legitimately good and the only clean win here, but one elite anchor does not float a roster this aggressively mispriced from top to bottom. The backsliding is already baked in.

There is a certain exhaustion that sets in when you look at a roster and realize the problems are structural, not fixable with a lucky waiver wire claim or a timely breakout. RManuelSports sits 11th in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division and in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to close that gap. Three major reaches across the draft board tell the real story: Jaxson Dart taken nearly two rounds early to anchor a weak QB room, Fernando Mendoza pulled more than five rounds before his ADP as if doubling down on a bet already going sideways, and Tyreek Hill grabbed over three rounds early at WR77. Meanwhile, the genuine strengths, De'Von Achane at RB6 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, are real, but they need infrastructure around them to matter, and that infrastructure grades out thin. Last season's 2nd percentile scoring finish was not a fluke to overcome, it was a warning, and this roster looks like a team still reading the same map.

There is a particular exhaustion that comes from staring at a roster and knowing the math just does not work. FinkleFreaks sits 10th in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division and in just the 16th percentile of the field, and the draft did not provide much of an escape route. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Joe Burrow at QB4 give the team a genuinely elite ceiling at the position, but the format is positionless, and quarterback brilliance only stretches so far when the supporting cast grades out average at best. The running back group projects with Chuba Hubbard, ranked RB29, as the weakest projected starter, and the draft added little surplus value to cushion that: 12 chalk picks, four minor reaches, and one major reach on Pat Bryant at WR86 all point to a team that drafted without much of a margin for error. Malik Nabers at WR12 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 offer some hope at the top, but hope is not a roster strategy, and right now FinkleFreaks looks like a team that has already used most of its lifelines.

fareeezy sits ninth in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division and in just the 26th percentile of the field, and nothing in this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The foundation looks promising enough: Christian McCaffrey projects as RB3, Jayden Daniels came in a full round ahead of his ADP as a QB5, and Jalen Hurts stacks nicely with Dallas Goedert, who quietly became one of the more dependable pieces in the Eagles offense last year. But the roster grades out near the bottom of the tournament for a reason, and that reason has a name: Jordan Addison, the projected weakest starter at WR43, represents the kind of ceiling-capper that can quietly sink an otherwise functional lineup. Last season's 39 percent win rate and 32nd-percentile scoring weren't a fluke or a run of bad luck, they were a signal. With a draft that produced no outright steals and two major reaches, fareeezy enters 2026 looking less like a team on the rise and more like one still searching for a lever that isn't there.

Sadie's Gunslingers arrive in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division sitting eighth and projecting out at just the 31st percentile of the field, and the draft sheet does not offer much hope that the gap gets closed. The roster has genuine anchors: Drake Maye projects as QB2, Jonathan Taylor as RB4, and Tucker Kraft as TE5, a legitimately elite trio at the top. The problem is that the supporting cast falls off a cliff. Rashee Rice at WR13 is a reasonable secondary piece, but the projected starter corps bottoms out at Jalen Coker, a WR55 who was already taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, meaning the manager paid a premium for the weakest link in the chain. With only four values on a 19-player roster and a draft that leaned heavily on chalk, there was no real surplus built in to absorb projection misses. When your ceiling requires everything to break right and your floor requires almost nothing to go wrong, you are not building a contender, you are buying a lottery ticket and hoping the numbers come up.

stephenhgill5 finished in the 87th percentile last season and enters 2026 looking like a team that borrowed someone else's trophy. The top of this roster is genuinely impressive, CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Trey McBride (TE2), and Kyle Pitts (TE7) form a core that most managers in Red Dead Redemption 2 would envy, and the good news on Pitts is that his 2025 breakout now looks like a baseline rather than a fluke, even with Atlanta's quarterback situation still unsettled. But the tournament projects this team at just the 41st percentile and seventh in the division, and that gap between last year's result and this year's projection is the story. The draft did not help much, producing zero steals and leaning heavily on chalk, with three minor reaches and a major reach on Jack Bech (WR94) taken more than three rounds before his ADP. When your ceiling depends on Lamb and McBride carrying the load and your best draft flexibility went toward a WR94, the 87th-percentile version of this team starts to feel like a long time ago.

TomHarveySports lands at 62nd percentile heading into 2026, which doesn't sound like a triumph until you look at how the roster was built. This was a draft defined by consistency rather than any single flashy move: 15 chalk picks, one steal, and almost no damage done on the reach side of the ledger. The headliners deliver on that promise. James Cook projects as RB5 and came at a modest discount, while Jaxon Smith-Njigba sits at WR3 among all receivers in the field. Those two alone make this roster worth respecting. Justin Herbert is the wild card worth watching. Mike McDaniel's arrival in Los Angeles adds genuine upside to a QB8 projection, though Herbert's ceiling stays complicated as long as the Chargers keep winning games the old-fashioned way and his rushing contributions remain modest. After a 2025 that produced a 21st-percentile scoring season, TomHarveySports

needed a cleaner draft, and by most measures that's exactly what happened. The Red Dead Redemption 2 division won't be charitable, but this roster earned its seat at the table.

AC9119 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They just kept winning exchanges, and the scorecard shows it: 18 chalk picks, one minor reach, and zero major reaches across the board. That kind of disciplined execution compounds quietly, and the receiver group is where it shows up loudest. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, A.J. Brown at WR8, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 form a projected starting core that most managers in this tournament would trade their firstborn to acquire. Brown's move to New England is the subplot worth watching, pairing with Drake Maye after the young quarterback's MVP runner-up season, and if Brown can stay healthy, a concern that has shadowed him in five of his seven seasons, the ceiling on that investment is very high. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Isaiah Likely at TE13 only reinforce the sense that this roster was assembled with quiet confidence at every turn. The 67th percentile projection feels conservative given the top-end talent here, and that's exactly the kind of gap worth betting on.

JackKeenan's 2026 roster reads like a draft where the manager simply kept winning the small arguments. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the whole operation, and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 gives this team a safety net most managers would trade a late-round pick to own. The receiver group is where the consistency really compounds: Drake London at WR7, Zay Flowers at WR16, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 form a projected-starter core that holds up against nearly any team in the field. Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 and Parker Washington at WR35 add legitimate depth without anyone needing to stretch their imagination. The draft sheet shows 18 chalk picks and almost nothing in the steal column, which sounds unexciting until you notice the results, because chalk at the right prices is just called hitting your marks. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 handles the ground game contribution. The Brandon Aiyuk reach at nearly three rounds early is the one moment of conviction that raised eyebrows, but conviction

backed by a roster this well-constructed looks a lot less like a gamble. Fourth in the division and 75th percentile overall, JackKeenan built something that belongs in the conversation.

dredsea finished 84th percentile in scoring last year and drafted like someone who learned nothing needs to change. The foundation is legitimate: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Caleb Williams at QB6 give this roster a ceiling most managers in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division are still dreaming about. But what separates a good draft from a clean one is what happens in the middle and late rounds, and dredsea kept finding value long after the obvious picks were gone. Mark Andrews fell more than two full rounds past his ADP and landed at 11.01, a genuine steal for a projected TE14. Brock Purdy slid more than a round and comes packaged with George Kittle, giving dredsea a second functional stack on top of the Williams and Luther Burden connection. The draft chart shows one minor reach and zero major ones across the entire board. Sitting third in the division and 82nd percentile in the field, this team earned every bit of that standing before a single game is played.

Dead Cat Bounce landed at 88th percentile in the field and second in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. The manager picked up Brock Bowers at 2.03 despite an ADP of 1.07, getting the TE1 at a discount before the board even warmed up. Then came the backfield, where Saquon Barkley, Omarion Hampton, and Cam Skattebo all fell past their ADPs and all project as starters, giving this roster a foundation that most managers would have had to overpay to build. Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors the receiving corps and stacks neatly with Kyler Murray, which is the kind of structural bonus you earn by drafting with a plan rather than just filling slots. The one blemish is Kirk Cousins, a minor reach relative to his ADP, but Cousins sitting behind Murray and Daniel Jones makes that a shrug rather than a siren. Across 19 picks, five good values, two outright steals, and zero meaningful overpays is a scorecard worth framing.

You sir, are a fish. enters 2026 sitting first in the Red Dead Redemption 2 division and at the 96th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly why: six value picks, twelve chalk selections, and zero major reaches. That is not a team built on lottery tickets. It is a team built by repeatedly letting the board come to them. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors the receiving corps alongside Nico Collins at WR9 and George Pickens at WR10, a trio that would headline most rosters in this field on its own. Meanwhile, Derrick Henry at RB12 arrived a round later than his ADP suggested he should have, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 slid more than a full round past his market price before this manager calmly took him at 9.03. No single moment defines this roster, just pick after pick where You sir, are a fish. came out slightly ahead. Last season's 69 percent win rate and 74th-percentile scoring suggest this is not a fluke outfit, and the 2026 projection looks like more of the same.
