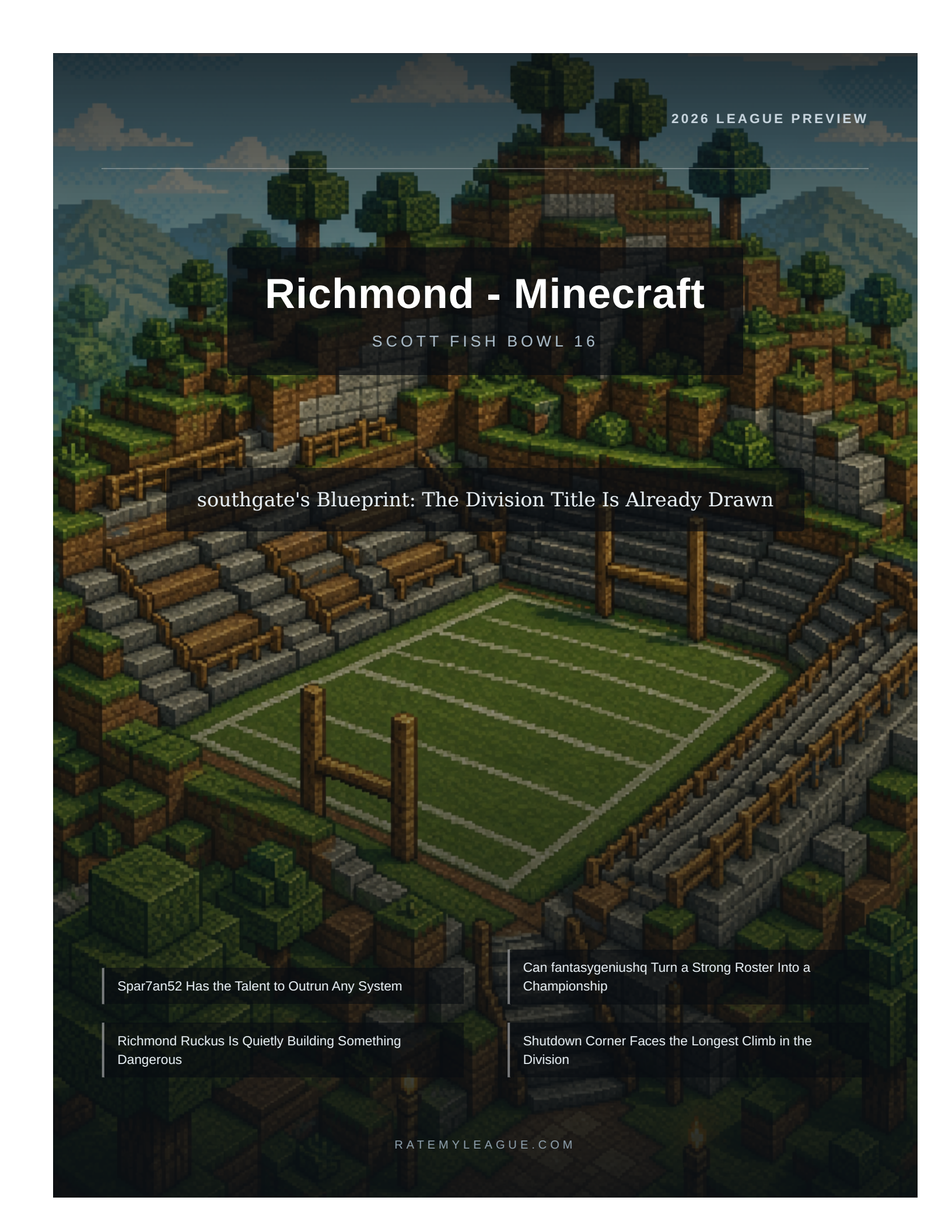

Shutdown Corner enters 2026 ranked 12th in the Minecraft Division and in just the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster gives little reason to argue with either number. The running back group is legitimately deep and talented, with Jonathan Taylor (RB4), Omarion Hampton (RB9), and Derrick Henry (RB12) all projected as starters, but the receiver corps grades out weak, and the QB situation is where hope goes to quietly expire. Justin Herbert (QB8) is the best arm on the roster and carries some intrigue now that Mike McDaniel is running the Chargers offense, yet Herbert has shown a ceiling-capped profile under Harbaugh, and Patrick Mahomes (QB12) offers no real upgrade over him. The draft did little to improve the outlook, producing zero steals, two major reaches, including Dontayvion Wicks taken more than three rounds before his ADP, and only three genuine values across the whole board. There is no hidden lever here, no late-round dart that changes the math. Shutdown Corner is built like a team that peaked during the draft and still did not peak enough.

There is no polite way to frame MuleMurphy's 2026 outlook: this is an 11th-place roster in the Minecraft division, sitting in the 16th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to improve the math. Thirteen chalk picks and two major reaches define a build that took few swings and missed on the ones it did take, most notably pulling Jayden Daniels in round two at a position that scores zero starters in this format, a luxury pick that looks increasingly hard to justify. The receiver group is genuinely the one thing keeping this team off life support, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 headlining a strong unit, but strength at one position only matters if the rest of the roster can keep pace, and it cannot. David Montgomery, now in Houston fighting for touches with a second-year back, grades out at RB23, and the tight end options are collectively an afterthought. Coming off a 39 percent win rate in 2025, MuleMurphy needed a bold offseason. This was not that.

Bart won 69 percent of his matchups in 2025 and cracked the 75th percentile in scoring, so the fall to the 20th percentile this season isn't a slow decline, it's a cliff edge. The headliner is real: CeeDee Lamb projects as WR5 and Lamar Jackson, stacked with Zay Flowers, gives Bart a ceiling most managers would envy. But beneath that top layer the roster grades out 10th in the division, and the draft did little to change the math. Zach Charbonnet cost a 12th-round pick against an ADP that had him going in the 14th, J.J. McCarthy was taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP, and neither project as starters. Kenneth Walker III was a genuine get, sliding nearly a full round past his number, but one good-value RB10 can't paper over a construction that leans heavily on Lamb and Jackson carrying the load while the rest of the projected starters, down to Jayden Reed at WR48, are asked to fill in the gaps. There is no obvious lever left to pull, and in a field this competitive, hope is not a strategy.

SteveGalloNFL sits ninth in the Minecraft division and projects out at just the 33rd percentile of the field, and the draft board does not offer much cover for that standing. The foundation looks fine on the surface, Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the roster, and a stack with Dalton Kincaid adds a wrinkle that can pay off. But outside of Allen, the talent thins out in a hurry. Jeremiyah Love and Kyren Williams project as RB13 and RB15, which is serviceable, and Nico Collins at WR9 is a legitimate contributor, but the projected starter pool fades fast from there, bottoming out with Jordan Addison at WR43 as the weakest link. The draft did not help the cause either, logging twelve chalk picks, no steals, and a first-round reach on Jalen Hurts, who grades out at QB9, a full round before his ADP. Hurts is not bad, he is just not first-round value, and in a tournament where every pick is currency, spending early on a QB9 is a luxury this roster could not afford.

krehztim enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Minecraft Division, and the roster math is not kind. The saving grace is that Christian McCaffrey projects as RB3 and Justin Jefferson checks in at WR6, a legitimate top-of-the-market duo that could carry a team through a rough patch. The problem is that "rough patch" may be too gentle a phrase for what surrounds them. Brock Purdy arrives with his own cloud overhead, his weapons in San Francisco a rotating cast of walking boot Instagram posts, between Kittle's Achilles, Ricky Pearsall's knee swelling, and a receiver room that raises more questions than it answers. On the draft side, krehztim found some value with Travis Etienne and Emeka Egbuka falling past their ADPs, but those gains were partially eaten by reaching two rounds early on Matthew Stafford, a QB14, at pick 4.02. The floor here depends almost entirely on McCaffrey and

Jefferson staying healthy and dominant, which is to say the ceiling and the floor are the same ceiling and the same floor, and there is not much structural support holding either up.

Dukerbockers finished at 56 percent wins and 83rd percentile in scoring last season, which is exactly the kind of résumé that gets you a polite nod instead of a feared reputation, and the 2026 projection feels eerily similar. The floor here is real: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this roster a top end that most managers would trade for without blinking, and DeVonta Smith, Ladd McConkey, and D.J. Moore round out a group that keeps the points flowing even on an off week. The ceiling, though, is where the uncertainty lives. The backfield projects weakly, with Quinshon Judkins at RB22 leading a group that offers little cushion if he stumbles. Then there is C.J. Stroud, taken a round early at QB22, carrying two years of backslide and a concussion history into a season where he absolutely needs to rediscover his early form to justify the investment. Dukerbockers sits 7th in the Minecraft division and right at the 51st percentile, which is not a bad place to be, but it is not a safe one either. The margins decide this.

titanloco is the kind of team that finishes 8-8 and spends the whole season wondering if that was good enough. The receiver group is genuinely excellent, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), A.J. Brown (WR8), and George Pickens (WR10) all projected starters, and Tee Higgins (WR19) and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) adding real depth behind them. That is the engine. The question is whether everything else can keep pace. Tony Pollard (RB30) is the projected top back and that is a number that does not inspire confidence. At quarterback, Jared Goff (QB16) and Baker Mayfield (QB18) give the team functional but unspectacular options. Isaiah Likely (TE13) is an interesting piece, following John Harbaugh to New York and stepping into a light tight end room where involvement figures to come. At 53rd percentile and sixth in the Minecraft division, titanloco sits exactly where the margins matter most. The receiver talent is real enough to win close weeks. Whether Pollard, Goff, and Likely can contribute on the right nights will decide whether this roster finishes just above average or just below it.

stevenmunger didn't swing for the fences in the Scott Fish Bowl, and that discipline is exactly why this roster lands in the 61st percentile with real upside to climb. The foundation is Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6, a pair of projected starters who give the lineup a ceiling most managers would trade their late-round lottery tickets to own. From there, stevenmunger just kept collecting. Colston Loveland fell nearly a full round past his ADP to land at TE3, and a starting group that also includes Sam LaPorta, Travis Kelce, and Mark Andrews reads like a checklist of good decisions quietly stacking on top of each other. Trevor Lawrence projects as QB10 and rounds out a starting core that has no obvious soft spots. The 2025 campaign finished at the 45th percentile, so there is ground to make up, but this is a roster built the right way: not on one spectacular gamble, but on a draft where stevenmunger consistently came out ahead of the market.

There was no single moment where fantasygeniushq swung for the fences and connected. Instead, this is a roster built on a quiet accumulation of correct decisions. The anchor is obvious: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this team a top-end advantage that most managers simply cannot match, and Warren arriving a full round and a half after his ADP made that pairing even sweeter. Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchors the backfield, flanked by a trio of capable starters in Cam Skattebo, Bhayshul Tuten, and RJ Harvey. Tuten, like Warren, came at a discount, falling more than a round past his ADP. The receiver group projects as the thinnest layer here, with Quentin Johnston at WR41 penciled in as the projected weakest starter, but Johnston himself arrived two full rounds late, so even where the ceiling dips, the manager paid the right price. A 65th-percentile projection and fourth in the Minecraft division feels like a floor for a team that consistently got value where others got lazy.

Richmond Ruckus didn't win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it on repetition. Puka Nacua at WR1 slipped to 1.06 when his ADP sat at 1.01, a modest fall that nonetheless handed the Ruckus a foundational piece for almost nothing extra. Tucker Kraft, projected TE5, fell nearly two full rounds before Richmond scooped him up in the sixth. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and Chase Brown at RB11 give this roster a punishing backfield core, and the projected starters cascade deep enough that Jakobi Meyers, the weakest of the bunch at WR45, is the floor rather than the ceiling. Yes, the quarterback room is thin, with Bo Nix projected QB15 and Kyler Murray at QB19 representing the realistic ceiling there, and both were reached for earlier than their ADPs warranted. But in a positionless format, quarterback value matters less than positional rank implies, and the rest of this roster has enough projected starter-quality depth to absorb it. Third in the Minecraft division and sitting at the 75th percentile, Richmond Ruckus looks like a team that simply drafted better than most rooms around it.

Spar7an52 sits second in the Minecraft division and in the 80th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet alone does not explain how they got there. Four major reaches dot this roster, including Fernando Mendoza pulled four rounds before his ADP and Brandon Aiyuk taken nearly four rounds early. On paper, that is the behavior of a manager who either trusts their board implicitly or has not checked it recently. But here is the thing: the conviction seems to have been real, because the rest of the draft was quietly excellent. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors everything, James Cook fell nearly a full round before landing at RB5, and Drake London and Chris Olave arrived as genuine values too. The core is legitimate. The reaches are not disasters so much as bets, and most of them landed in the double-digit rounds where the cost of being wrong is low. Spar7an52 drafted like someone who knew exactly what they wanted and went and got it. The roster, sitting at division runner-up, suggests they were right.

Southgate enters 2026 sitting first in the Minecraft Division and at the 86th percentile of the field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: this was a roster built on consistent execution rather than any single bold swing. The tight end group is where that philosophy pays off most visibly, with Trey McBride (TE2), Harold Fannin (TE6), George Kittle (TE9), and Jake Ferguson (TE12) all projecting as starters, a collection assembled largely at chalk prices. The receiver corps adds real depth behind it, with Rashee Rice (WR13), Luther Burden (WR22), and Makai Lemon (WR40) all projecting into the lineup, and Burden himself qualifies as one of four genuine values on the board, taken a full round past his ADP. Joe Burrow (QB4) anchors the passing game, and his stack with Ferguson and Dak Prescott (QB7) gives the roster connected upside on big weeks. Four values, thirteen chalk, and only one major reach across the entire board: Southgate did not try to outsmart the room, just consistently came out ahead of it.
