There is no charitable read available for yoemcat, a team sitting at the bottom of the Road Rash division and in the 6th percentile of the field. The draft tells the story plainly: zero steals, zero values, and four major reaches across 18 rounds. The most damning of those reaches is Fernando Mendoza, a QB27 projection taken 5.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, which is the kind of speculation that would be defensible if the surrounding roster demanded it, but yoemcat spent earlier picks reaching on Drake Maye and Bo Nix too, burning three rounds of draft capital on a quarterback room that projects as a collective QB2, QB15, and QB27. Meanwhile, the receiving corps bottomed out with Elic Ayomanor as the most notable addition, a WR95 who was still somehow taken nearly three rounds early. The running backs are genuinely strong, with James Cook, Kenneth Walker III, and Kyren Williams anchoring a deep group, but when the rest of the roster reads like a series of regrettable impulse decisions, even a strong backfield cannot paper over the wreckage.

There is a particular kind of fantasy exhaustion that sets in when you look at a roster and realize the ceiling and the floor are basically the same room. FFMonarch sits 11th in the Road Rash division and in just the 8th percentile of the field, and after going 10-26 last season with scoring in the 17th percentile, the arrow is not pointing up. The draft did not help much: 12 chalk selections, two major reaches, and zero steals produced a squad that grades out near the bottom with no obvious corrective move available. The headliners, Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33, sound better than they play together on paper. Jackson was reached for a full round early, and Harrison arrives carrying two underwhelming seasons, a lengthy injury log, and a quarterback situation in Arizona that currently runs through Jacoby Brissett, which is not a sentence that inspires confidence. The projected floor starter, Khalil Shakir at WR51, tells you everything about where the depth lands. FFMonarch is not broken, exactly. It is just out of runway.

thegregslis sits 10th in the Road Rash division and at just the 30th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. Twelve chalk picks and six minor reaches tell the story of a manager who paid market price or above for nearly everything, which means there is no surplus value quietly waiting to bloom. The major reach on Keaton Mitchell, taken nearly three full rounds ahead of his ADP at 13.01, is the kind of swing that needs to hit perfectly to justify itself, and Mitchell projects as a fringe RB49 rather than a difference-maker. Meanwhile, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is the one undeniable asset, and the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack adds some upside in the right week. But a projected starter at WR48 in Jayden Reed anchoring the back end of the lineup, a TE group that grades weak, and almost no draft-day leverage to speak of leaves this roster looking like a car that runs, just not very fast, and the road ahead in this division is already steep.

DCTortugas sits ninth in the Road Rash division and projects at just the 33rd percentile of the field, and the draft record does not offer much reason for optimism. The manager reached on Matthew Stafford by nearly two rounds, grabbed Jameson Williams a round and a half early, and then, as if to put a bow on it, took Jalen Tolbert a staggering eight rounds before consensus, burning a late pick on a WR102 projection. Against that backdrop, the Stafford-Davante Adams stack feels less like a masterstroke and more like a team leaning hard on a single structural bet to bail out a shaky build. The good news is real: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 give this roster a legitimate top-end ceiling, and both project as starters. But elite receivers need points around them, and with Rachaad White sitting at RB39 as the top backfield option and the quarterback room anchored by a reach, DCTortugas is a team whose floor and ceiling may be uncomfortably close together.

bmc52 enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Road Rash division and squarely in the bottom third of the field, and the draft history doesn't exactly inspire a turnaround. The roster produced zero steals and zero values across the entire draft, with fourteen chalk picks and five reaches, three of them significant. The most damaging of those reaches may be Cam Ward, projected QB23, pulled eight rounds earlier than his ADP suggested. Ward is listed as a projected starter, which means bmc52 is counting on a QB23 to anchor the position week after week. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Chase Brown at RB11, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give the lineup a credible top end, but this format rewards depth and upside throughout the roster, and the back half of this one thins out quickly toward names like Ray Davis and Demond Claiborne, both reached for in the late rounds and both projecting well outside the relevant range. There is no obvious lever to pull, no sleeper quietly hiding value, just a team that paid full price or more for players unlikely to deliver it.

Pmax83 lands at 39th percentile and seventh in the Road Rash division, and the roster makes it easy to understand why. The receiving corps is genuinely elite, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Justin Jefferson (WR6), and Chris Olave (WR11) all projected as starters, and Garrett Wilson (WR17) waiting behind them. That group can carry a fantasy team, but only if the rest of the roster doesn't anchor it to the bottom. The problem is that it might. Jared Goff (QB16) and Sam Darnold (QB21) represent one of the weakest quarterback situations in the field, and the backfield offers nothing better, topping out at Kenneth Gainwell (RB34). The draft didn't help matters: two major reaches, Darnell Mooney (WR82) and Elijah Sarratt (WR98), burned late capital on players already projected outside the top 80. Pmax83 has the kind of top-end receiver talent that wins leagues, but talent at the margins was squandered on names that project nowhere near starter-worthy, and there is no obvious move left to fix the QB situation.

bishoppriest didn't need a lottery ticket to build a winner in the Road Rash division, just a steady hand and a nose for value at the right moments. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Ashton Jeanty comes in at RB7, and Omarion Hampton slots in at RB9, giving this roster a top-end trio that most managers in the field would envy. What makes the draft especially clean is that bishoppriest got there without mortgaging the middle rounds. Brian Thomas Jr., a projected WR31 starter, slid a full round past his ADP and landed at pick 8.10, and Jaxson Dart at QB11 was secured slightly ahead of schedule without a dramatic overpay. The result is a lineup sitting at the 61st percentile that feels like it has more upside than that number suggests, built not on one bold gamble but on a dozen small advantages that quietly compound. In a format that rewards depth and consistency, bishoppriest drafted like someone who had already done the homework.

brettas_FF didn't win the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft on one big swing. They won it on volume, coming out ahead on pick after pick until the advantage compounded into something real. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster two projected top-ten backs, and the receiver group piles on with Nico Collins at WR9, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 all projecting as starters. Dallas Goedert fell a round and a half past his ADP before brettas_FF grabbed him at TE15, which is exactly the kind of quiet efficiency that separates good drafters from great ones. The 2025 résumé backs the confidence: a 75 percent win rate and a finish in the 89th percentile in scoring. The Michael Mayer reach at round 17 when his ADP sat at round 22 is an eyebrow-raiser, but at that stage of the draft it's a minor footnote on an otherwise steady sheet. Sitting 73rd percentile in the field heading into the season, this team belongs in the conversation.

sfarbota did not stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The architecture is built around Caleb Williams, a QB6 projection, stacked three deep with Luther Burden (WR22), Rome Odunze (WR30), and Colston Loveland (TE3), meaning when the Bears offense catches fire, this roster does not just benefit, it detonates. That is the whole thesis. Brock Bowers at TE1 gives sfarbota a second elite anchor independent of the stack, and Dak Prescott at QB7 was scooped four rounds past his ADP as a hedge, so the quarterback room can absorb a bad Williams week without the floor collapsing entirely. The risk is exactly what you would expect from a roster built this way: if Williams underwhelms and his weapons underperform alongside him, the ceiling never materializes and there is no clean escape hatch. Sitting 4th in the Road Rash division but ranking in the 83rd percentile of the full field, sfarbota is the kind of team that either wins a lot of weeks in dominant fashion or quietly fades when the stack goes cold. There is no in-between here, and sfarbota drafted it that way on purpose.

Manske enters 2026 sitting third in the Road Rash division and in the 83rd percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly how they got there: five values, fourteen chalk, and almost nothing wasted. The headliner is Christian McCaffrey, projected RB3 and snagged at 2.01 despite an ADP of 1.09, a full turn later than the market expected him to last. That kind of patient opportunism showed up again at tight end, where Trey McBride landed at 1.12 despite a 1.08 ADP, and Mark Andrews followed at 9.12 after slipping a full round past his number. The receiver group is the one area where the projections are more modest, with Chris Godwin sitting at WR38 as the weakest projected starter, but in a positionless format that punishes rosters without top-end talent rather than rosters without balance, the presence of McCaffrey, McBride, and Andrews at the top of this lineup carries

enormous weight. Manske did not need a heist to build a contender. They just kept winning small, and that tends to add up.

WilderGoose sits second in the Road Rash division and in the 84th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly how it happened: no major reaches anywhere on the board, three values, and a roster that simply kept coming out ahead at pick after pick. The clearest example is Malik Nabers, a WR12 projection who slid a round and a half past his ADP and landed at 5.05 like someone forgot to tell the rest of the room what they were leaving on the table. Patrick Mahomes fell a full round from his expected spot and gives WilderGoose a QB12 sitting behind Josh Allen, a QB1, which means the manager is never making a panicked waiver move when Allen has a bye. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Derrick Henry at RB12 anchor a projected starting group that would make most managers quietly jealous, and Tyler Warren at TE4 erases one of the positions where drafts most often go sideways. This is not a team built on one inspired swing. It is a team built on compounding small advantages until the math becomes undeniable.

Splawny11 sits atop the Road Rash division at the 84th tournament percentile, and the draft record tells you exactly how it happened: four value picks, fifteen chalk, and almost nothing wasted. There was no lottery ticket, no moment of reckless ambition, just a manager who kept coming out ahead at the margins. The foundation is genuinely elite, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), A.J. Brown (WR8), and George Pickens (WR10) all projected starters forming the kind of top-end group that wins weeks outright. Beyond those three, Zay Flowers (WR16) and D.J. Moore (WR26) provide real depth, and Michael Pittman (WR44) arrives in Pittsburgh with Aaron Rodgers and DK Metcalf around him, enough of a situation change to justify his WR44 projection being an underestimate. Tucker Kraft (TE5) anchors the tight end group as a projected starter, and Dalton Kincaid (TE11) was quietly the most instructive pick on the board, taken at 9.02 after falling more than a round past his ADP. Splawny11 did not beat the draft with flash. It beat the draft by not blinking.
