scottib1101 sits at the bottom of the Rocket League division and in the 5th percentile of the entire field, and the draft tells you exactly why. The most instructive line item is the reach on Jayden Daniels, pulled off the board 1.2 rounds early at pick 1.09, which would be defensible if the rest of the draft held together. It did not. Five major reaches followed, a relentless pattern of paying tomorrow's price for today's gamble, with Wan'Dale Robinson yanked 2.3 rounds early, Jalen Nailor grabbed 2.4 rounds early, Darnell Mooney cleared off the board 3.2 rounds ahead of schedule, and Jack Bech taken nearly three full rounds before the market would have delivered him. Zero steals. Two values across the entire draft. The roster does have real talent, Ashton Jeanty and a Mahomes-Kelce stack are genuinely useful anchors, but scottib1101 spent down every capital advantage acquiring depth it did not need to buy early, and now projects to pay for that impatience all season.

Nowlan drafted like someone who found a cheat code for one position and forgot there are others. Trey McBride at TE2 is genuinely good, and yes, James Cook at RB5 gives this roster a real anchor, but beyond those two the wheels come off fast and stay off. The quarterback situation is a quiet catastrophe: Sam Darnold projects as QB21, Bryce Young as QB26, and Geno Smith as QB30, meaning Nowlan is starting a quarterback who ranks somewhere between mediocre and genuinely concerning no matter which way they turn. Worse, the draft board tells the real story. Five major reaches, zero steals, and a late-round philosophy that produced Jaylen Wright at RB68 taken nearly six rounds early and Elijah Sarratt at WR98 taken more than six rounds early. Those are not bold swings on upside. Those are the picks of someone who panicked and pulled the trigger. The result is an 11th-place projection in the division and a 16th-percentile finish tournament-wide. There is no spin here. This roster earned its ranking.

GarretDuncan did not build this roster to dabble in correlation. He built it to live there. Caleb Williams feeding Rome Odunze, Brock Purdy leaning on George Kittle, Kyler Murray throwing to Justin Jefferson, three stacks baked into the starting lineup as the core mechanism, not a hedge. The ceiling here is genuine, the kind that can make a deep tournament run feel inevitable on the right week. But that is precisely what makes this preview so hard to write without a knot in your stomach. All three of those stacks have to perform, not one, not two, all three, and the tournament-wide ranking sitting at the 27th percentile suggests the fantasy community is not exactly lining up to endorse the plan. The draft sheet did not help matters much either, featuring almost entirely chalk picks and a reach on J.J. McCarthy that cost nearly four rounds of draft capital for a QB37. GarretDuncan bet everything on correlation clicking at once. Maybe it does. But hope is doing a lot of heavy lifting on this roster.

FirstandJen enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Rocket League division and at just the 38th tournament percentile, which is a polite way of saying the floor is closer than the ceiling. The roster's best hope is a receiver group anchored by Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) and Nico Collins (WR9), two legitimate difference-makers who can paper over a lot of sins. The problem is that the lineup requires ten starters, and the drop from Collins to the next tier is steep enough to make your stomach drop. Matthew Golden projects as the weakest starter at WR52, and after underwhelming results against fellow rookie wideouts in 2025, he now faces a thinned Green Bay receiver room where running out of excuses and running out of time are starting to look like the same thing. What makes this harder to fix is the draft gave the manager nothing to work with, zero steals and two major reaches, including Bo Nix nabbed nearly a round and a half before his ADP warranted. Chase and Collins are real. Everything behind them is a prayer.

omegaking ran a disciplined draft, collecting five value picks and refusing to panic at the board. Twelve chalk selections, two minor reaches, zero major reaches: this is what a patient manager looks like on paper. And yet the roster lands at 8th in the Rocket League division and the 39th percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether patience is a virtue or just a slower way to lose. The problem is not one catastrophic mistake but an accumulation of quiet disappointments. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1 and Saquon Barkley as RB8, a genuine foundation, but the production has to come from somewhere further up the roster than it currently does. Marvin Harrison Jr. sits at WR33, Jared Goff at QB16 despite being taken a round early, and the projected weakest starter is Josh Downs at WR46. omegaking did almost everything right by conventional draft theory and arrived at a roster that projects below the tournament median. The draft did not punish the mistakes. It punished the ceiling.

Rotonaut is a team that will win exactly as many games as it deserves, which is either a compliment or a quiet threat depending on which week you catch them. The foundation is real: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Drake Maye at QB2 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the Rocket League division would trade for, and Breece Hall sliding to RB14 after falling more than a full round past his ADP is the kind of quiet dividend that pays out over a long season. But the margins that make or break a 45th-percentile team are found further down the board, and that is where Rotonaut gets honest with itself. The projected starting corps leans on Jordyn Tyson, Parker Washington, and Quentin Johnston, a trio ranked WR34, WR35, and WR41 respectively, which means every week is a negotiation between the top of the roster carrying its weight and the bottom not giving points away. Coming off a 69 percent win rate in 2025, Rotonaut knows how to be competent. The question is whether competent is enough.

TheFFScout didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a session: consistently making better decisions than the table, round after round. Josh Allen at QB1 and Joe Burrow at QB4 form a quarterback room that most managers would envy, and the Burrow-Tee Higgins stack adds a bonus layer of correlation upside that could turn a good week into a great one. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and TreVeyon Henderson at RB19 give the team two projected starters who can genuinely move the needle. The draft chart is almost aggressively clean: sixteen chalk picks, no major reaches, and J.K. Dobbins falling nearly two rounds past his ADP to land at RB36 as the one clear value. Kyle Pitts at TE7 quietly anchors the back half of the lineup. The weakest projected starter is Khalil Shakir at WR51, which is a reasonable floor when your ceiling looks like this. A 70th-percentile scoring season in 2025 and a 62nd-percentile tournament projection suggests a team that competes without drama, and sometimes that is exactly enough.

Last year was a disaster for Ech0, a 6-30 record that landed them in the bottom 16 percent of the field in scoring, the kind of season that demands a full reset. The 2026 roster looks like exactly that. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is the centerpiece, a legitimate top-of-the-market acquisition that Ech0 grabbed with a slight discount past his ADP, and pairing him with Josh Jacobs, who fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before landing here, gives this team real upside at the top of the lineup. Brock Bowers at TE1 adds another elite-tier piece, and the quarterback group, anchored by Dak Prescott and Jalen Hurts, is genuinely strong. The draft was mostly chalk, which is fine when the chalk includes players ranked where these are. The one blemish is Chris Bell, reached on by four rounds, a puzzling early commitment to a WR87. But that is a footnote on what is otherwise a roster built to climb. The 64th percentile projection and fifth-place divisional standing reflect a team that has done the hard work of rebuilding. The floor here looks nothing like 2025.

JeffHaseleyFBG did not build this roster with one glittering swing. They built it the way a good poker player builds a stack, picking up small edges, round after round, until the pile becomes undeniable. The foundation is a wide receiver group that belongs at the top of any conversation in the Rocket League division, anchored by Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and CeeDee Lamb (WR5) running in tandem as projected starters, with Zay Flowers (WR16) and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) adding genuine depth behind them. That is not luck; that is a manager who kept winning exchanges at the draft table. Fifteen chalk picks sounds boring until you realize chalk at WR4 and WR5 means you correctly identified two of the best players at the position and took them without flinching. Trevor Lawrence (QB10) arriving five rounds late and Jakobi Meyers (WR45) nearly two rounds late are the quiet bonuses layered onto an already sound foundation. Fourth in the division and 68th percentile overall is a fair starting point for a team built to grind its way considerably higher.

fantasyscott didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't overthink the board, just drafted smart and walked away with a roster that sits at the 70th percentile of the field. The foundation is Bijan Robinson at RB2, as close to a locked-in weekly difference-maker as this format offers, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 gives this team a legitimate one-two punch before you even get to the rest of the starters. Justin Herbert landing at QB8 when his ADP suggested he'd be gone a full round earlier is the kind of quiet win that separates good drafters from great ones, and Harold Fannin at TE6 adds another projected starter who would anchor rosters across the field. Almost the entire draft came in at or near consensus value, with only two minor reaches and zero major ones, which is less a criticism than a compliment: fantasyscott didn't need to gamble because the board kept delivering. Third in the Rocket League division and projected to build on a 53-percent win rate from 2025, this team looks less like a hopeful project and more like a quiet threat.

There was no lottery-ticket moment in michaelgullott's draft, no single transformative swing that defined the roster. What there was, consistently, was a manager who came out ahead of the board. De'Von Achane at RB6 anchors the backfield, and the depth behind him is quietly impressive: Quinshon Judkins projects as RB22, and after a late-season fibula fracture cut his 2025 short, reports out of Cleveland suggest he'll be ready to go in training camp, which makes him one of the more interesting upside plays on this roster. Puka Nacua at WR1 is a genuine weapon, and the Matthew Stafford stack gives that projection a natural ceiling raise. Tyler Warren at TE4 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 round out a starting group that simply keeps delivering value. The draft sheet shows three players taken after their ADP with no meaningful cost, against just one notable reach. That kind of consistent execution, not flash, is why michaelgullott sits second in the Rocket League division and in the 81st percentile of the field.

GridironyUK sits first in the Rocket League division and in the 92nd percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly why: zero reaches, one outright steal, and a roster that reads like a clinic in patience. The steal that anchors the whole operation is Jerry Jeudy, snagged at pick 18.08 when his ADP sat at 15.06, a full 3.2 rounds of free value dropped into the lap of a manager who simply waited. Add Lamar Jackson, Chase Brown, and Davante Adams each falling roughly a round past their market price, and you have a team that never overpaid for anything. The on-field talent backs the draft discipline completely: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, Malik Nabers as WR12, and Emeka Egbuka as WR18, with Jackson at QB3 directing a starting lineup that has almost no soft spots. Xavier Worthy projects as WR49 and draws the label of weakest projected starter, which, on this roster, qualifies as a compliment. This is what a clean SFB draft looks like.
