Sitting 12th in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division and in the 4th percentile of the entire field, talibinks built something genuinely difficult to achieve: a roster with no steals, no values, and four major reaches scattered across the draft like land mines. The TE stack is the most damning evidence. Tyler Warren at TE4, Harold Fannin at TE6, Kyle Pitts at TE7, Travis Kelce at TE10, and Jake Ferguson at TE12 are all projected starters, but Warren was taken nearly a full round early, Fannin almost two rounds early, and Ferguson a full two rounds early. Those reaches did not come cheap, and they pulled capital away from building genuine top-end firepower. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 is legitimately elite, and Luther Burden carries real upside if the Ben Johnson hype machine converts into actual production, but after those two the roster falls fast, bottoming out at Wan'Dale Robinson as the projected weakest starter at WR47. talibinks did not draft poorly by accident. They worked for this.

JohnTLips enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division and in just the 4th percentile of the entire field, and the draft log offers little comfort. There were no steals, no values, and a draft philosophy that leaned heavily on chalk with a side of wishful thinking: six minor reaches and a major reach on Dak Prescott, taken more than a full round before his ADP, already a shaky foundation for a team that needs every pick to land. Justin Jefferson is a genuine anchor at WR6, and the running back depth around Jeremiyah Love and Kyren Williams is real, but this roster asks a lot of those top names because the back end falls off fast. Rico Dowdle projects as the weakest projected starter at RB32, which tells you something about the margin for error here. When your floor depends on Jefferson staying healthy and Prescott rediscovering something he may have already lost, you are not building toward a ceiling. You are just hoping the ride does not drop too fast.

kellyh711 sits 10th in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division and in the 18th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches across 19 rounds. The most damning of those reaches is Bo Nix, taken at 4.08 when his ADP sat at 6.03, a QB15 consumed in premium draft capital that could have extended what is genuinely a strong group of contributors. Then there is Kenyon Sadiq, a TE21 projection reached nearly three rounds early at 8.08, with Gunnar Helm and Mason Taylor already on the board as late-round insurance that kellyh711 would later reach for anyway. The irony is that Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Drake London at WR7 give this roster a legitimate spine, players capable of carrying a lineup on their own. But when your QB anchor is a reach and your mid-round capital kept evaporating on positions already covered, you have not built around your stars so much as buried them.

There is no sugarcoating the situation in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division: kendallizer is sitting ninth in the division and in just the 24th percentile of the field, and the roster construction offers little reason for optimism. The two genuine anchors, Caleb Williams at QB6 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5, are legitimately elite, and Colston Loveland projects as TE3, which is a real asset. But after that trio, the floor drops sharply. Derrick Henry grades out at RB12, which sounds fine until you realize the remaining starters thin out quickly, with KC Concepcion projected at WR50 penciled in as a projected starter. Worse, the draft offered no cushion: zero steals, zero values, and a draft board that leaned on chalk and reaches, including Zach Charbonnet taken more than two rounds before his ADP. When your best path to contention runs through hoping Williams, Lamb, and Loveland outscore the field while a WR50 fills a starting spot, you are not managing a roster so much as you are managing expectations.

AustinFFL ran a clean draft, the kind efficiency hawks hold up as a model: five values, eleven picks at chalk, zero major reaches, and a 2026 roster that sits 47th percentile in the tournament. That is the cruelest sentence in fantasy football. Lamar Jackson landed half a round late, Rhamondre Stevenson and Aaron Jones each slipped more than a round past their ADPs, and the manager still wound up with a starting receiver group anchored by Jakobi Meyers, a WR45 who was already a minor reach at pick 8.09. The top end is genuine, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this team a ceiling worth respecting, and Lamar at QB3 does not hurt. But the 2025 squad went 28-8 and finished 90th percentile in scoring, so the bar is set high, and right now the projection lands in the middle of the Roller Coaster Tycoon division. AustinFFL did everything the process asks of a drafter and arrived somewhere unremarkable anyway, which is less a draft failure than a reminder that the process does not owe you an outcome.

helmersglue is a team built for the middle of the standings, which is precisely where they sit at 49th percentile and seventh in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division. The receiver group is genuinely good: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 form a top end that can carry a week, and the fact that helmersglue reached 1.3 rounds early to land Wilson suggests the manager knew it too. The problem is that small misalignments compound. There are no steals anywhere on this roster, every pick came in at or above market value, and the two biggest aggressive moves, Jacory Croskey-Merritt at RB40 and Jordan James at RB67, were taken a combined six rounds ahead of where the field had them. If those two hit, this team has enough depth to climb. If they disappoint, Breece Hall at RB14 is doing a lot of heavy lifting while Isaiah Likely at TE13 quietly keeps the floor from collapsing entirely. The margins decide this season, and right now they are razor thin in both directions.

joshbrickner did not win this draft in one moment. He won it in a dozen small ones. The foundation is a backfield that would make most managers jealous: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and James Cook at RB5 give this team a floor that simply does not exist for most rosters in the field. Then consider that Bucky Irving, projected RB21, did not come off the board until 9.10 despite an ADP of 7.03, a two-and-a-half round gift that joshbrickner quietly pocketed. The quarterback situation follows the same pattern, Jayden Daniels landed a round later than his market price suggested, and the receiving corps gets an underrated boost from Jaylen Waddle, who escapes Miami's dysfunction and lands in Denver alongside a quarterback who led the league in pass attempts last year. None of this screams headline. It does not have to. Sitting at 60th percentile in the field with a roster this consistently assembled, joshbrickner looks like someone who was never going to beat himself, and in this format, that matters.

Jacob9er didn't manufacture this roster with one splashy pick or a late-round lightning bolt. The draft just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors a receiver group that goes several layers deep, with Nico Collins at WR9, George Pickens at WR10, and Malik Nabers at WR12 all projecting as starters, and Nabers arriving a full round after his ADP suggested he would. That kind of accumulation is not luck, it is execution. The same patience showed up later when Jordan Addison landed a round past his expected price. Five values across the draft, no steals but no disasters either, and the one major reach, Dontayvion Wicks in the 17th round, is the sort of low-cost swing a well-constructed roster can absorb without flinching. The quarterback situation is thin by any honest read, but in a positionless format the question is whether the top of this roster is

good enough to carry the weight. At 72nd percentile in the field and sitting fifth in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division, Jacob9er has the pieces to climb both.

OGSheckie didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't mortgage the middle rounds for a single marquee name, just drafted a clean, disciplined roster that kept coming out ahead. The foundation is legitimately elite: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Drake Maye at QB2 give this team a ceiling most managers in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division can only stare at from across the room. Tucker Kraft at TE5 means that positional strength doesn't fall off a cliff the moment Bowers has a bad week. The draft process backs up the eye test, with more values than reaches across the board, including Terrance Ferguson sliding nearly four rounds past his ADP, a quiet find that could look very smart by October. Justin Herbert is the interesting wrinkle, a QB8 projection attached to an offense that Mike McDaniel could open up or Jim Harbaugh could continue to strangle with ball-control pragmatism. At 73rd percentile, OGSheckie isn't chasing glory, but this is a roster that earned its position one good decision at a time.

PigskinPapers landed in the top 20 percent of the field not by gambling on upside or swinging for the fences on one transformative pick, but by simply drafting well, round after round. The foundation is legitimate: Josh Allen at QB1 gives this team a ceiling most managers would trade away draft capital to secure, and George Kittle at TE9 is the kind of reliable projected starter who quietly wins weeks while others are chasing waiver wire miracles. What makes the profile interesting, though, is the accumulation of value in the middle rounds. D'Andre Swift fell roughly a round and a third past his ADP before PigskinPapers scooped him up at RB24, and the same pattern repeated with Kyle Monangai and Woody Marks, both collected later than the market expected. None of those picks look like heists on their own. Together, they represent a draft that stayed disciplined, let the board come to them, and kept coming out ahead of where consensus said they should be. Third in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division feels about right for now, but this roster has the quiet depth to move.

There is not much to nitpick about wha1en's 2026 roster, and that is the point. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 slid to pick 2.02 when his ADP sat at 1.09, meaning wha1en grabbed one of the best players in the tournament at a discount before the board had even warmed up. That kind of discipline compounds: Sam Darnold came off at 12.02 despite an ADP of 9.02, and Bhayshul Tuten fell a round and a half into the ninth round. The result is a lineup built around projected starters at virtually every level, anchored by Trey McBride at TE2 and complemented by Jalen Hurts stacking neatly with Dallas Goedert. The minor reaches on Colby Parkinson and Theo Johnson are the closest thing to a blemish here, and even those are late-round bets on upside rather than signs of desperation. Four values, one steal, zero major reaches. wha1en sits second in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division and in the 82nd percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why.

Colej313 didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't trade future picks for a single star, just drafted round after round with the quiet confidence of someone who knew exactly where the market was wrong. The headline is the receiver room, where Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and Tetairoa McMillan and Emeka Egbuka slot in as projected starters at WR15 and WR18, all three locked into stacks with Matthew Stafford and Baker Mayfield that were built at a discount. Stafford fell a full round past his ADP, Mayfield fell 1.2 rounds, and Kyler Murray slid 2.3 rounds to give Colej313 three quarterback options without paying quarterback prices for any of them. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchor the backfield at projections that would anchor any roster in the field. There are reaches here, Kimani Vidal and Brandon Aiyuk both taken ahead of consensus, but those are the quibbles on a draft that finished with more value than chalk and a team sitting first in the Roller Coaster Tycoon division. Colej313 came out ahead. Consistently, boringly, devastatingly ahead.
