MungryPablo sits fourth percentile in the field and last in the Ryu division, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: zero steals, nine chalk picks, and a parade of reaches that never stopped coming. The most damaging moment came at 1.05, where Colston Loveland was taken a full round and change before his ADP, an aggressive commitment to a TE3 projection when the board still had real value sitting untouched. Then, almost inexplicably, the second pick of the entire draft at 2.08 went to Caleb Williams, a QB6, in a positionless format where paying quarterback prices that early is a choice you have to be spectacularly right about to justify. Williams does stack with both Rome Odunze and Loveland, which is something, but stacking a quarterback you overpaid for with a tight end you overpaid for is less a plan than a receipt. Meanwhile, Sam Darnold arrives as the QB21 in a Seattle offense that leaned heavily on Jaxon Smith-Njigba last season and now loses Kenneth Walker, leaving Darnold's path to fantasy relevance genuinely murky. There is no charitable read available here, and MungryPablo did not leave one.

There is no spin to put on what unclerayrayy did here. The roster sits at 13th percentile in the field and 11th in the Ryu division, and the draft record tells you exactly why: zero steals, four minor reaches, and four major reaches against just two values across the entire board. The major reaches are where the story gets genuinely grim. Jaydon Blue, a RB70, was taken 6.3 rounds before his ADP. Demond Claiborne, a RB63, went 4.6 rounds early. Mike Washington Jr., a RB59, cost a pick 5.2 rounds ahead of market. None of those three are projected starters. unclerayrayy spent late-round capital on non-contributing depth while the one legitimate value on the roster, Amon-Ra St. Brown, a WR4, essentially fell into the lap at 2.03 rather than arriving by design. The projected weak spot is Kenyon Sadiq, a TE21 reached 3.2 rounds early in round eight. This is what panic looks like fossilized in a draft log.

The Philly Phreaks are sitting 10th in the Ryu Division and in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the roster offers precious little reason for optimism. The foundation looks real enough: Christian McCaffrey grades out as RB3, and Jayden Daniels projects as a QB5 starter. But a team needs more than a good floor, and this is where the draft tells a discouraging story. The manager reached three rounds early on Shedeur Sanders, a QB32, and nearly three rounds early on Cam Ward, a QB23, burning premium draft capital on a position where the returns barely register. Those rounds could have reinforced the WR group, which leans heavily on Chris Olave at WR11 and then drops off to Davante Adams at WR25 and D.J. Moore at WR26. The two legitimate draft values, Moore and DK Metcalf, are nice to have, but they feel like window dressing on a roster that made its critical mistakes early and is now asked to compete without a lever left to pull.

There is not much mystery to skmetallica's predicament in the Ryu division: the roster grades out at the 28th percentile of the field and sits ninth in the division, and the draft did almost nothing to change the trajectory. Eighteen of the twenty picks came in at chalk or worse, including two major reaches, and the most damning of those is Justin Herbert burned at 2.09, a full round ahead of his ADP, at a time when that capital could have addressed almost anything else. Herbert projects as QB8, which is fine, but spending a second-round pick to land QB8 is the kind of move that creates a quiet, compounding deficit across the rest of a roster. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give skmetallica a genuine foundation, but from Tee Higgins at WR19 on down the projected starters thin out fast, and the weakest of them, Quentin Johnston at WR41, is exactly the kind of fringe piece that separates contenders from spectators. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Ant54 walked out of the 2025 season with an 81% win rate and a smug grin, so what happened? The 2026 roster grades out at the 29th percentile, good for eighth in the Ryu Division, and the draft offers almost no explanation for optimism. Fifteen chalk picks, three minor reaches, one major reach, and zero steals. Zero. The headliner of those reaches is Jacoby Brissett, taken 2.5 rounds early at 11.01 to come in as QB28 on the projections, which is the kind of move that makes you wonder if the manager was drafting from a different database entirely. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Nico Collins at WR9 anchoring real weekly upside, and Tyler Warren at TE4 alongside Tucker Kraft at TE5 gives this team a legitimate edge at the position. But when your quarterback ceiling is Jordan Love at QB17 and your entire draft felt like a shrug, the ceiling seals itself shut pretty quickly. Chase can only do so much.

jgus67 didn't stumble into correlation, they built for it. The centerpiece is a Jaxson Dart double-stack, with Malik Nabers at WR12 and Isaiah Likely at TE13 both projected to start alongside their quarterback, meaning when Dart has a big game, this roster doesn't just benefit from it, it compounds it. Lamar Jackson pairs with Zay Flowers to add a second live wire, giving the team two distinct stacks that can ignite independently or in tandem. The draft execution mostly held up: Likely fell 1.2 rounds past ADP, Trey McBride landed at TE2 value, and Nabers anchors the whole structure as a genuine top-tier receiver. The concern is that correlation cuts both ways. If Dart underperforms, the Nabers and Likely projections get dragged down with him, and the roster's current 46th-percentile standing reflects exactly that variance risk. There's a real ceiling here, but jgus67 is flying without a net, and the Ryu Division won't wait around for stacks to warm up.

Corywood sits at exactly the tournament's median, which is another way of saying every single week will come down to the margins. The top of this roster is legitimate: Justin Jefferson at WR6, George Pickens at WR10, and Rashee Rice at WR13 form a ceiling most managers would envy, and Kyle Pitts at TE7 keeps the floor from caving in. But Rice is the variable that could swing this whole season three or four different directions. The off-field situation is genuinely alarming, a probation violation and a knee procedure have already cost him months, and his 2025 availability was already a mess before any of that. If Rice is active and healthy he is a difference maker; if he is not, Corywood is leaning harder on everyone else and hoping the depth holds. Joe Burrow at QB4 is the other piece worth watching, taken a half-round early but hard to argue with the upside. This roster does not have a fatal flaw. It just does not have much margin for the bad luck that tends to find the teams right in the middle.

There was no single moment in walstibs's draft that made the room gasp, and that was precisely the point. The foundation is Josh Allen at QB1, landed at 1.09 when the field had him priced at 1.05, a small gap that nonetheless represents the discipline of a manager who never panicked. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 tells the same story: available at 2.04 while consensus had him gone before the turn at 1.11. Round after round, the market made small errors and walstibs collected them. Breece Hall at RB14 fell a full round and a fifth past his ADP before walstibs scooped him up, adding a projected starter alongside Chase Brown at RB11 and Cam Skattebo at RB20. The result is a team sitting at the 79th percentile of the field, fourth in the Ryu division, built not on one transcendent swing but on the accumulated advantage of a draft that kept coming out slightly ahead. That is a boring story to tell and an excellent way to win.

Pkehoe82 didn't win the draft on one big swing. They won it by quietly accumulating small advantages across nearly every pick, and the cumulative effect is a team that lands in the 79th percentile of the field. The clearest example is the receiver corps, where Puka Nacua projects as WR1 and Jaylen Waddle, acquired at reasonable cost, now steps out of one of the league's more dysfunctional passing offenses and into Denver alongside a quarterback who led the league in pass attempts last season. That context makes Waddle's WR23 projection feel conservative. De'Von Achane at RB6 anchors the backfield and came in slightly past his ADP, a small but meaningful edge in a draft where small edges compound. The one exception to the steady hand is C.J. Stroud, reached 2.5 rounds early at a position where Pkehoe82 already carries Dak Prescott, the kind of deviation that doesn't sink a roster but does raise an eyebrow. Fifth in the Ryu division for now, but the floor here is high and the build earns its reputation.

ohJustSmile didn't try to be clever. They just kept winning picks. The clearest evidence is what they did in the middle and late rounds, where most managers are guessing: Courtland Sutton, projected WR37, fell nearly three rounds before this team scooped him up, and D'Andre Swift, a projected RB24, slid more than a round past his expected price. Neither move looks like a gamble in hindsight, just a manager who knew what things were worth and waited. That discipline compounds when you zoom out. The top of this roster, Brock Bowers at TE1, A.J. Brown at WR8, James Cook at RB5, carries genuine tournament weight, and the projected starters below them hold up. There are no dramatic stories here, no miraculous late-round finds to hang the season on. What you have instead is a team sitting in the 84th percentile of the field that got there through a draft where the ledger, almost uniformly, tilted in the right direction. Third in the division feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

stephensear didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. This team was built pick by pick, round by round, with the kind of patient consistency that leaves managers across the field wondering how they ended up on the wrong side of so many transactions. The foundation is genuinely elite: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a top-end punch that most managers would rebuild around, and Drake London slotting in at WR7 extends that tier into the receiver room. What makes the draft picture even cleaner is how stephensear collected value without having to force anything. Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 slid a round past his ADP. Jordyn Tyson at WR34 did the same. Colby Parkinson fell nearly two rounds before being scooped up at TE31. None of these were lottery tickets, just real players taken at favorable prices. The result is a team sitting second in the Ryu division and in the 90th percentile of the field, which is exactly where a draft this disciplined deserves to be.

Impressauve is not a team you pick apart, because there is very little to pick apart. Division-leading and sitting at the 96th percentile of the entire field, this roster was built the way championship rosters are supposed to be built: patiently, precisely, and with an eye for value that most managers can only aspire to. Eight players came off the board after their ADP, which means the draft room kept delivering gifts and Impressauve kept accepting them. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, taken at 2.06 when the board suggested he'd be gone by 2.01, is the kind of marginal edge that signals a manager paying attention. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 anchors the receiving corps. Omarion Hampton at RB9 and Kyren Williams at RB15 give this roster a depth of backfield talent that simply bends opponents. The one blemish, Jordan James reached nearly five rounds early, is a footnote on an otherwise meticulous sheet. A 69-percent win rate in 2025 tells you this organization knows how to close. The 2026 version looks even cleaner.
