As the 2025 fantasy football season looms for DiamondMIkeUSA, the outlook appears rather grim. Despite last year's promising performance, finishing strong in the 77th percentile, this season tells a different story. The team finds itself languishing at the very bottom of their division and in the worrying 2nd percentile overall. The roster is riddled with questionable choices, notably the reliance on Trey Benson as a starting running back, who is scarcely a top-tier option at RB44. While wide receivers Justin Jefferson, DK Metcalf, and Jaylen Waddle bring some hope with solid rankings, the team's decision-making in the draft seems to have squandered their potential gains. compensate. The team's reliance on a shaky stack bonus from Jefferson and McCarthy might not be enough to lift them from their dismal standing. With such daunting challenges and poor strategic choices, DiamondMIkeUSA faces an uphill battle and may struggle to recover their footing, let alone emulate last year's success.


