klindgren84 sits 12th in GTA San Andreas and projects in just the 16th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet does not offer much reason for optimism. The roster got Josh Allen at QB1, which is genuinely elite, and the Allen / D.J. Moore stack adds a real bonus, but after that the cupboard gets thin fast. The projected starters grade out at average across the board, and the weakest of them, Michael Pittman at WR44, is the kind of name that shows up in lineups when something has already gone wrong. What makes the situation harder to argue away is the draft profile: zero steals, zero true values, six minor reaches, and a major reach on Tyler Shough at QB20 burned in round six when the board almost certainly had better options sitting there. Shough was not worth that price, and those early investments in a QB2 are resources that never made it back into the roster. Allen is a foundation, but one elite quarterback cannot carry a squad this thin into contention.

caco4218 sits 11th in the GTA San Andreas division and in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the roster data makes it easy to understand why. The receiving corps is genuinely impressive on paper, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, George Pickens at WR10, and Chris Olave at WR11, all projected starters. But this is a positionless format, and a team can only start so many of its best players at once, which means the value of that receiving depth crashes hard against the ceiling set by the quarterback situation. Jordan Love projects as a QB17, Baker Mayfield as a QB18, and Tua Tagovailoa, reached two full rounds early, comes in at QB31. That is not a quarterback room, that is a fire drill. The draft offered no steals and no values, just 15 chalk picks and a pair of major reaches that have not yet shown any upside. With the weakest projected starter grading out at Worthy at WR49, caco4218 is not a team looking for the right move. It is a team that has run out of them.

There is no sugarcoating the math here: Lgsurfer sits 10th in the GTA San Andreas division and ranks in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to change the trajectory. Joe Burrow and Christian McCaffrey are genuine stars, but beyond that pair the roster grades out as firmly average, and the draft was mostly chalk with three major reaches that did real damage. Aaron Rodgers at QB29 cost a premium pick for a depth piece, Matthew Golden at WR52 was taken more than two rounds early, and Rashod Bateman at WR92 arrived nearly three rounds ahead of schedule. Those are not aggressive bets on upside, they are simply overpayments, and in a deep field they compound quickly. The projected starter group is functional but uninspiring, with Khalil Shakir at WR51 anchoring the bottom of the lineup. Burrow and McCaffrey give Lgsurfer a real floor, but a floor is not a ceiling, and there are no obvious moves left to manufacture one.

Mohacabu enters 2026 sitting at the 25th percentile of the field, ranked ninth in the GTA San Andreas division, and the roster grades out roughly as advertised. The top of the lineup has genuine appeal: Patrick Mahomes projects as QB12, Justin Jefferson as WR6, and Jonathan Taylor as RB4, and the Mahomes-Rashee Rice and Mahomes-Travis Kelce stacks give the team some ceiling on big weeks. But from there the drop-off is steep, and the draft did nothing to soften it. Across 20 picks, Mohacabu produced zero steals and zero values, drafting entirely to chalk or worse, including a 1.7-round reach on Kyren Williams and a 3.5-round reach on Sean Tucker, who projects as RB65. That is not asset accumulation, that is paying a premium for players who were already fully priced in. After a 2025 campaign that landed in the 27th percentile of scoring, the path forward required bold, sharp drafting. Mohacabu got neither, and the schedule will not care.

Release The Kraft-ken sits eighth in GTA San Andreas and in just the 26th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains why the ceiling feels so low. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with A.J. Brown (WR8), Nico Collins (WR9), Jameson Williams (WR21), and Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31) all projected to start, but the manager paid early for that luxury, reaching on Brown and Collins by nearly a round each and on Romeo Doubs (WR53) by over two rounds. Those draft slots are currency that never came back. Meanwhile, the projected weakness sits at the top of the running back group, where Chuba Hubbard (RB29) is the best the roster offers at that position, and the draft yielded four major reaches against just one steal across the whole board. Tucker Kraft (TE5) is a legitimate bright spot and fell over a round past his ADP, but one well-timed value pick is not enough to correct a draft that consistently traded future flexibility for names already off the board.

nickfurious21 is sitting seventh in the GTA San Andreas division and projected at just the 35th percentile of the field, and the roster makes it easy to understand why. The backfield is genuinely strong, with James Cook (RB5), Chase Brown (RB11), Javonte Williams (RB17), and Travis Etienne (RB18) all projecting as contributors, but that depth only carries a team so far when the receiving corps is nearly empty at the top. Christian Watson checks in at WR28, and after that the cupboard drops off a cliff to Malachi Fields (WR90) and Tory Horton (WR93). At quarterback, Drake Maye projects as a QB2 and gives the team a real ceiling, but Sam Darnold's situation is worth watching: with Kenneth Walker gone in Seattle, Darnold needs to become the engine of that offense rather than a passenger, and his fantasy production last season suggested he was very much the latter. The draft produced zero steals and thirteen chalk picks, meaning nickfurious21 arrived at this position fair and square. There is no overlooked gem waiting to be unlocked, just a roster that grades out as what it is.

wesleyffc is the kind of team that wins eight games or misses the playoffs entirely, and the difference lives in about three decisions. Puka Nacua at WR1 and Colston Loveland at TE3 give this roster a legitimate top-end that most managers in GTA San Andreas would trade for without blinking, and both were drafted with enough patience to qualify as values. The trouble is what happens when the lineup needs a third or fourth contributor. Malik Nabers at WR12 and Davante Adams at WR25 carry real weight there, but Jadarian Price at RB26 is the projected weakest starter and also the roster's most aggressive draft decision, taken 2.7 rounds ahead of his ADP. If Price delivers, wesleyffc has the depth to quietly climb into the top half of the division. If he doesn't, Nacua and Loveland are carrying a team that ranks 39th percentile in the field for a reason. Sitting sixth in the division right now is not a verdict, it's a warning. The margins are narrow, the ceiling is real, and this season will be decided somewhere in between.

GayTigers finished last season at the 85th percentile in scoring, so there is a track record here, and the 2026 draft suggests the same confidence, occasionally shading into stubbornness. The board shows four major reaches and zero steals, which is a pretty specific philosophy: GayTigers wanted who they wanted, and they paid early to get them. The results are hard to argue with. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 anchor a receiving corps that is legitimately elite, and Justin Herbert at QB8 slid almost a full round past his ADP before GayTigers grabbed him like someone leaving a twenty on the table. The one reach worth watching is Jaylen Wright, taken nearly six and a half rounds before consensus, which is either visionary or expensive depending on how the season unfolds. Marvin Harrison Jr. carries real upside but also real uncertainty, with Jacoby Brissett now under center in Arizona and two consecutive seasons that have not matched his billing. The 67th percentile projection feels conservative for a roster this loaded at the top.

JayAtk29 didn't stumble into correlation, they built a cathedral to it. The twin stacks anchoring this roster, Dak Prescott paired with CeeDee Lamb and Jared Goff paired with Amon-Ra St. Brown, are not hedges or happy accidents but the entire architectural thesis. When Lamb runs a seam and Prescott delivers, JayAtk29 scores twice. When St. Brown turns a short route into a fifty-yard afternoon and Goff gets the credit, JayAtk29 scores twice. The ceiling here is genuinely stratospheric precisely because the scoring is multiplied, not diversified. What makes this construction credible rather than merely clever is the underlying player quality: Lamb at WR5 was somehow available at 2.03 well past his ADP of 1.11, and St. Brown at WR4 gives the Goff stack a WR1-caliber anchor. Tee Higgins at WR19 and Harold Fannin at TE6 add legitimate projected starter upside around the edges. The risk is baked in by design: if both stacks go quiet on the same week, the floor drops fast. But JayAtk29 clearly decided they'd rather chase the multiplier than play it safe, and in a field this competitive, that's probably the right bet.

adinrudd didn't win the draft with one splashy pick. They won it by being right over and over again. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a top-end that most managers in the GTA San Andreas division can't match, and Jayden Daniels at QB5 means the quarterback slot isn't a drain on value either. Beyond the headliners, the draft was a masterclass in not beating yourself, 18 chalk picks and one meaningful value in Jacory Croskey-Merritt, who slid a full round and a half past his ADP. The Brian Robinson reach at 2.4 rounds early is the one moment where adinrudd got ahead of the market, but one blemish on an otherwise disciplined sheet is hardly a verdict. The 2025 season landed in the 30th percentile, so there's a gap to close, but the roster sitting at 79th percentile entering 2026 suggests the lessons were absorbed. Third in the division is a reasonable floor, and the ceiling is worth watching.

StillNoShip did not win the Scott Fish Bowl draft with a single blockbuster moment. They won it pick by pick, round by round, in the quiet way that actually holds up over a season. The clearest example: Lamar Jackson, the QB3 in the field, was still sitting there at pick 2.10 when his ADP said he should have been gone. Jalen Hurts followed the same script, sliding to 5.03 against an ADP of 3.12. Neither felt like highway robbery at the time, which is precisely the point. That is what a well-calibrated draft looks like, not a heist, just a manager who kept finding the market slightly wrong and took advantage without overcorrecting into reaches anywhere on the board. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchor a backfield that gives this roster a load-bearing floor, and the Lamar Jackson and Mark Andrews stack adds a connected upside thread running through the lineup. Second in the GTA San Andreas division and sitting in the 91st percentile of the field, StillNoShip earned that quietly.

UDFA didn't win the draft with one flashy move. They won it by being right, repeatedly. Trey McBride arriving at TE2 value when he fell nearly a full round past his ADP is the clearest example, a near-elite tight end essentially handed over at a discount while the rest of the board moved on. Kenneth Walker III followed a similar pattern, slipping a full round before UDFA scooped him at RB10. Neither of those pickups required brilliance, just patience and the discipline not to overthink it. The rest of the roster fills out convincingly: Brock Bowers at TE1, a starting group of receivers anchored by DeVonta Smith at WR14 and Ladd McConkey at WR20, and Bo Nix providing a safe, high-volume floor at quarterback after leading the league in pass attempts and landing a new weapon in the form of Jaylen Waddle. Sitting first in the GTA San Andreas division and in the 93rd percentile of the field, UDFA looks exactly like what it is: a team that drafted without ego and came out ahead almost every time.
